NOTES TO THE UNAUDITED CONDENSED CONSOLIDATED INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

PART 1-Explanatory Notes Pursuant to FRS 134

A1. Turbo-Mech Berhad is a public limited liability company incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia, and is listed on Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements were approved by Board of Directors on 13 August 2012.

A2. Basis of Preparation

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements, for the period ended 30 June 2012, have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 *Interim Financial Reporting* and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. These condensed consolidated interim financial statements also comply with IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the International Accounting Standards Board. For the periods up to and including the year ended 31 December 2011, the Group prepared its financial statements in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS").

The consolidated financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2011 which were prepared under FRS are available upon request from the Company registered office at Lot 6.05, Level 6, KPMG Tower, 8 First Avenue, Bandar Utama, 47800 Petaling Jaya, Selangor Darul Ehsan.

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements are the Group's second MFRS condensed consolidated interim financial statements for part of the period covered by the Group's first MFRS annual financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2012. MFRS 1 First-Time Adoption of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS 1") has been applied.

The explanatory notes attached to these condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2011.

In preparing its opening MFRS Statement of Financial Position as at 1 January 2011 (which is also the date of transition), there are no adjustment required on the amounts previously reported in financial statements prepared in accordance with FRS. The transition from FRS to MFRS has not had a material impact on the statement of cash flows.



A3. Changes in Accounting Policies

The audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2011 were prepared in accordance with FRS. Except for certain differences, the requirements under FRS and MFRS are similar. The significant accounting policies adopted in preparing these condensed consolidated interim financial statements are consistent with those of the audited financial statement for the year ended 31 December 2011 except as discussed below:

Business combination

MFRS 1 provides the option to apply MFRS 3 Business Combinations, prospectively from the date of transition or from a specific date prior to the date of transition. This provides relief from full retrospective application of MFRS 3 which require restatement of all business combination prior to the date of transition. The Group elected to utilise the Business combinations exemption relief accorded by MFRS 1 on the formation of the Turbo-Mech Berhad Group that has been accounted for as a reorganisation of companies under common control using the pooling-of-interest method.

Acquisition before date of transition

The Group has elected to apply MFRS3 prospectively from the date of transition. In respect of acquisition prior to the date of transition,

- (i) The classification of former business combinations under FRS is maintained.
- (ii) There is no re-measurement of original fair values determined at the time of business combination.
- (iii) The carrying amount of goodwill recognised under FRS is not adjusted.

A4. Auditors report of preceding Annual Financial Statements

The audit report on the Group's financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2011 was not subject to any qualification.

A5. Seasonal or cyclical factors

The business operations of the Group are affected by the cycles of capital and repairs/maintenance programs implemented by major players in the oil, gas, and petrochemical sector.



A6. Unusual items due to nature of size or incidence

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cashflows of the Group during the financial guarter under review.

A7. Change in estimates

There were no changes in estimates that have had material effect on the results of the financial quarter under review.

A8. Carrying amount of revalued assets

The valuation of property, plant and equipment has been brought forward without amendment from the audited financial statements for the financial period 31 December 2011.

A9. Debt and equity security

The Group did not undertake any issuance and/or repayment of debt and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellations, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares for the current financial quarter under review.

A10. Dividends

A final tax exempt (single tier) dividend of 10.0% per share amounting to RM5.4 million in respect of financial year ended 31 December 2011 was approved by shareholders during the Annual General Meeting held on 25 May 2012 and subsequently paid on 18 June 2012.

A11. Segment information

Segment information are presented in respect of the Group's geographical segment, which is based on the company's management reporting structure where discrete Financial information is available and regularly review by the Chief Operation Decision Maker.

Transfer prices between the operating segments are on arm's length basis in a manner similar to transactions with third parties.

PART B – Explanatory Notes Pursuant to Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia

B1. Analysis of Performance

The group was segmented into different geographical regions, namely Malaysia, Singapore and the Others. The Singapore segment includes the results of Brunei, Vietnam and Thailand. Singapore segment has traditionally been the major contributor to the Group's revenue. In this quarter, its contribution of Group's cumulative revenue was at 83.3%, which is an increase of 1.8% as against the preceding year comparative.

The Malaysia segment contributed 8.9% to the Group's revenue in the current cumulative quarter, recorded a drop of about 6.8%. In the Others segment, the Philippines and Indonesia have recorded revenue improvements as compared to the preceding year comparatives. A worthy point to be noted was the Philippines' contribution to the Group's revenue for current cumulative quarter has significantly increased.

The current quarter revenue in comparing with the preceding year corresponding quarter has improved by RM2.153 million. This has help to reduce the drop in revenue when comparing the current cumulative quarter with the preceding cumulative quarter of RM23.941 million, amount to a drop of only RM0.152 million. The current quarter revenue of RM14.585 million was an improvement of 17.3% as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter. This improvement was attributed to increased sales of pumps derived from projects recognised in current quarter.

In the current quarter, the Group recorded a lower gross profit margin of 24.0% as compared to 32.2% in preceding year due to lower margin sales generated from the Singapore segment. However, despite this, the Group was still able to achieve a higher margin of 28.0% in the cumulative quarter, which was slightly below the preceding year comparative of 29.8%.

In the current cumulative quarter, other operating income was at RM0.255 million. This was an increase, as compared to the current and cumulative preceding year comparative. The difference can be explained by the increase in the realised foreign exchange gain attributable mainly from the Singapore segment.

The other operating expenses for current quarter have increased by RM0.115 million as compared to preceding year comparative. Similarly, the current cumulative quarter had increased by about the same amount. In general, this was due to the unrealised foreign exchange loss and depreciation. As regards the share of results in the associated companies, an improvement of RM0.110 million was achieved and had contributed to the bottom line.



As a result, the Group had recorded a current quarter profit of RM2.694 million, and this was RM0.334 million lower than the preceding year comparative. This result was about the same and consistent with the lower recorded net operating result in the cumulative period.

In current quarter, the recorded revenue had surged to RM14.585 million, an increase of RM5.381 million as compared to the preceding quarter. This improvement was mainly as a result of four fold increase in revenue recognised in sales of pumps derived from projects.

Profit before tax recorded for the quarter under review was RM3.110 million which was RM1.153 million higher as compared to preceding comparatives. The current quarter results gave a net profit margin of 21.3%, which was consistent with the preceding quarter. This was despite the fact that gross margin for the current quarter had dropped by 10.3% as this was mitigated by improvement in other operating income, lower operating expenses and a better contribution from share of results from the associated companies.

B3. Prospects

The demand for petrochemical industries products are influenced by the market economic conditions. As a supplier of pumps and compressors to both upstream as well as downstream of petrochemical industries, the demand for our products and services will inevitably be affected as well.

The Company will stay focused on maintenance and services in which we should expect a 2% to 5% volume growth in this area. This is based on Management's internal target and is not a forecast or projection and has not been reviewed by our external auditors.

B4. Notes on variance in actual profit and shortfall in profit guarantee

The Group has not issued any profit forecast or profit guarantee for the current financial quarter under review.
