EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MALAYSIA FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS ("MFRS") 134, INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

A1. Corporate information

SIG Gases Berhad is a public limited liability company incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia, and is listed on Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements were approved by the Board of Directors on 12 November 2015.

A2. Basis of Preparation

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements, for the year ended 31 December 2014, have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2014. The explanatory notes attached to these condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2014.

A2.1 Significant accounting policies

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation adopted for the interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted for the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2014 except for the adoption of the following which are applicable to its financial statements and are relevant to its operations:

B1. Review Of Performance Of The Group

Current Quarter 3 months ended 30 September 2015 vs. Preceding year corresponding Quarter 3 months ended 30 September 2014

The current quarter registered a revenue of RM18.89M, up by RM2.43M or 14.77% as compared to the corresponding quarter. The increase in sales was mainly due to increase in project sales and liquid nitrogen during the quarter.

The gross profit of the Group for the current quarter was RM5.98M, an increase of RM0.63M or 11.78% over the corresponding quarter. The increase was largely contributed by the project sales. However, the gross profit margin decreased from 32.50% to 31.60% mainly due to lower margin from acetylene gases, refrigerants products and cylinder sales which fetched lower selling prices.

The Group's profit before tax was RM5.36M for the current quarter, an increase of RM4.07M as compared with RM1.29M recorded in the corresponding quarter. This was largely due to profit realised on disposal of Puchong property amounting to RM4.46M. The share of profit from associated company increased from RM0.15M to RM0.38M on the commissioning of the second phase facilities. The selling and administrative expenses increased by RM 1.20M, or 29.57 %, largely due to increase in staff benefits, ISO tank rental, realised and unrealised exchange loss due to the weakening of MYR against USD and SGD. The finance cost was down by RM0.14M or 21.43%, due to repayment of short term facilities and term loan with proceeds from sale of Puchong property.

The current quarter's Group's profit after tax was RM5.19M, which was RM2.28M higher than the corresponding quarter.

Current year to date 30 September 2015 vs. Preceding year to date 30 September 2014

The revenue of the Group for the period ended 30 September 2015 was RM55.79M , up by RM6.52M or 13.23% as compared to the same period in year 2014. The increase in revenue was mainly due to higher sales to fabrication and engineering sectors as well as project jobs secured during the current quarter.

The Gross Profit of the Group for the period ended 30 September 2015 was RM18.22M, an increase of RM2.34M or 14.74% as compared to the same period in year 2014.

The gross profit margin improved from 32.23% to 32.65%, mainly due to improvement in production unit cost and the implementation of productivity improvement programmes and higher margin generated on project jobs.

Profit Before Tax increased by RM5.42M as compared with the corresponding period in year 2014 mainly due to profit from sale of Puchong property and increase in share of profit from associate company from RM540,000 to RM937,000. The Group's Profit After Tax was RM7.66M, down by RM0.16M or 2.05%, largely due to realisation of profit on sale of Puchong land which was partially offset by absence of tax benefit of the reinvestment allowance credited in the corresponding period.

B2. Material Changes In The Quarterly Results Compared To The Results Of The Preceding Quarter

The revenue of the Group for the current quarter was down by RM1.73M or 10.60% as compared to that of the preceding quarter. The lower revenue was mainly due to lower project sales, argon, special gases and refrigerant.

The Gross profit was down by RM0.98M or 18.51% to RM5.98M, mainly due to lower gross profit margin as the result of lower selling price experienced during the quarter and lower project sales.

The Group's profit before taxation was RM5.36M, which is RM2.98M higher as compared to the preceding quarter largely contributed by profit from sale of Puchong property, higher share of profit from an associate company and lower finance cost which was offset partially by lower sales and margin.

As the result of the abovementioned, the Group's profit after tax increased from RM1.60M to RM5.19M.

B3. Current Year Prospects

As reported by Department of Statistics Malaysia, the Malaysian Gross Domestic Product (GDP) advanced by 4.90% year-on-year in the second quarter of 2015, moderating from a 5.60% expansion in the previous period. However, lower oil price and the significant weakening of MYR against US dollar and other currencies over the past year will have an impact on the economy The weakening of MYR may affect the cost of some of our imported materials and capital goods.

Malaysian overall industrial environment could be challenging for the rest of year 2015 and 2016 with the implementation of 6% GST, anticipated cutting back of capital expenditure in the oil and gas sector, the austerity measures by government, the inflationary consumer prices and the global economic uncertainty arising from the impending increase in the US interest rates and declining economic expansion in China.

Despite the challenging times ahead the management shall continue to deliver and implement costsavings measures and to improve productivity in all the operation areas. The management is also exploring asset lightening measures and to widen revenue base to improve efficiencies of its capital resources and to enhance return to the shareholders.

In conclusion, despite the uncertainty posed by the macroeconomic environment set out above, we believe that with our various cost-savings exercises, re-alignment of assets duly in place, and gradual increase in revenue from our completed expansion projects, we remain cautiously optimistic about our performance for the rest of 2015.

1. Proposed Two-Call Rights Issue

On 5 September 2014, the Company had announced on its proposed enounceable two-call rights issue of 37,500,000 new ordinary shares of RM0.50 each ("Shares") ("Rights Shares") on the basis of one (1) Rights Share for every four (4) existing Shares held on an entitlement date to be determined later, at an issue price of RM0.50 per Rights Share, of which the first call of RM0.36 per Rights Share is payable in cash and the second call of RM0.14 per Rights Share ("Second Call") is to be capitalised from the share premium reserve of SIG. On 20 October 2014, the Company announced that the Board of directors resolved that the Second Call be capitalised instead from the retained earnings reserve of SIG ("Proposed Two-Call Rights Issue").

On 21 October 2014, the Company had announced that Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") had vide its letter dated 20 October 2014, which was received on 21 October 2014, approved the listing of and quotation for the 37,500,000 Rights Shares on the Main Market of Bursa Securities, subject to the certain conditions as disclosed in the said announcement and in its circular to shareholders dated 26 October 2014.

On 13 November 2014, the shareholders of the Company had approved the Proposed Two-Call Rights Issue.

The Proposed Two-Call Rights Issue has been completed on 30 December 2014.
