A1. Corporate information

SIG Gases Berhad is a public limited liability company incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia, and is listed on Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements were approved by the Board of Directors on 18 November 2019.

A2. Basis of Preparation

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements, for the quarter ended 30 June 2019 have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2018. The explanatory notes attached to these condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2018.

A2.1 Significant accounting policies

The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the previous financial year, except as follows:

A2.1 Significant accounting policies (cont'd)

The adoption of the above standards and interpretations do not have significant financial impact to the Group's consolidated financial statements for the current quarter, except as discussed below:

MFRS 16 Leases

MFRS 16 supersedes MFRS 117 Leases, IFRIC 4 Determining whether an Arrangement contains a Lease, SIC-15 Operating Leases-Incentives and SIC-27 Evaluating the Substance of Transactions Involving the Legal Form of a Lease. The standard sets out the principles for the recognition, measurement, presentation and disclosure of leases and requires lessees to account for most leases under a single on-balance sheet model

Lessor accounting under MFRS 16 is substantially unchanged from MFRS 117. Lessors will continue to classify leases as either operating or finance leases using similar principles as in MFRS 117. Therefore, MFRS 16 did not have an impact for leases where the Group is the lessor.

The Group adopted MFRS 16 using the modified retrospective method of adoption with the date of initial application of 1 January 2019. Under this method, the standard is applied retrospectively with the cumulative effect of initially applying the standard recognised at the date of initial application. The Group elected to use the transition practical expedient allowing the standard to be applied only to contracts that were previously identified as leases applying MFRS 17 and IFRIC 4 at the date of initial application. The Group also elected to use the recognition exemptions for lease contracts that, at the commencement date, have a lease term of 12 months or less and do not contain a purchase option ('short-term leases'), and lease contracts for which the underlying asset is of low value ('low-value assets'). The Group also elected to recognise a right-of-use asset at the date of initial application at an amount equal to the lease liability, adjusted by the amount of any prepaid or accrued lease payments relating to that lease recognised in the statement of financial position immediately before the date of initial application. A3. Auditor's report on preceding annual financial statements

There was no qualification to the audited financial statements of the Company for the financial year ended 31 December 2018.

A4. Seasonal or cyclical factors

The business operations of the Group were not significantly affected by any seasonal or cyclical factors.

A5. Items of unusual nature

As disclosed in Note A13, SIGGAS received an offer letter dated 25 March 2019 from Air Liquide Malaysia Sdn Bhd ("ALM") to acquire 23,000,000 ordinary shares in Southern Industrial Gas Sdn Bhd ("SIGSB"), representing 100% equity interest therein (including the 40% minority shareholding owned and held by SIGSB in Iwatani-SIG Industrial Gases Sdn Bhd) from SIGGAS for a purchase consideration of RM226,586,000.

On 28 March 2019, SIGGAS accepted the offer from ALM subject to further negotiation of the terms and conditions of the Sale & Purchase Agreement. Further announcement(s) would be made upon the execution of the Sale and Purchase Agreement pursuant to the offer, detailing the terms, effects and all relevant disclosures in relation to the offer as required under the Main Market Listing Requirements.

SIGGAS entered into a Sale and Purchase Agreement with ALM in relation to the Proposed Disposal on 14 June 2019. As such, assets and liabilities of SIGSB were classified as held for sale and presented as separate items in the statements of financial position. On 25th October 2019, the Company in an Extraordinary General Meeting approved the proposed disposal and on 31st October 2019, the proposed disposal was completed as per announcement dated 31st October 2019. The results from discontinued operations are presented as a separate item in the statements of comprehensive income. The financial result of discontinued operation is disclosed in Note A18.

Except for the item disclosed above, there were no significant unusual items affecting the assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flow for the financial period ended 30 September 2019.

A6. Material changes in estimates

There were no changes in estimates that have had a material effect on the current quarter results.

A7. Changes in debt and equity securities

There were no issuance, cancellation, repurchase, resale and repayment of debt for the financial period-todate.

A8. Dividend paid

On 21 June 2019, the Shareholders approved a final tax exempt (single-tier) dividend of 1.00% in respect of the financial year ended 31 December 2019 on 187,500,000 ordinary shares, amounting to a dividend payable of RM937,500 (0.5 sen per ordinary share) which was paid on 26 July 2019.

The shareholders at an EGM held on 25th October 2019 have approved the proposed disposal, proposed payment of a special dividend of RM0.557 per share on special dividend payment date which is to be determined later and a proposed capital reduction by way of cash distribution of RM0.40 for each SIGGAS shares held on the cash distribution entitlement date which is to be determined later.

The proposed disposal was completed on 31st October 2019 as announced on 31st October 2019.

B1. Review Of Performance Of The Group

Current Quarter 3 months ended 30 September 2019 vs. Preceding year corresponding Quarter 3 months ended 30 September 2018 (Please refer to Note A 18 for Financial Result)

Revenue for the quarter was RM20.31M, 5.58% lower as compared to the corresponding quarter of RM 21.51M. This was largely attributed to lower refrigerant sales with the completion of project jobs.

The Group's gross profit for the current quarter was RM5.47M, up by RM0.88M or 19.17% as compared to the corresponding quarter of RM 4.59M. The increase in gross profit was due to the adoption of MFRS 5 of the accounting standards, which requires no depreciation provision for the current quarter.

During the quarter, the Group posted a profit after tax of RM2.56M as compared to RM1.18M of the corresponding period. The higher profit after tax was mainly due to the explanation above.

Current year to date 30 September 2019 vs. Preceding year to date 30 September 2018(Please refer to Note A 18 for Financial Result)

The Group's revenue for the period ended 30 September 2019 was RM58.05M, down by RM0.98M or 1.66% as compared to the corresponding period in year 2018. The decrease in revenue was mainly due to lower demand for refrigerant products by RM3.86M with reduced project jobs in the construction and engineering sector.

The Group's gross profit for the period was RM13.32M, down by RM0.04M or 0.30% as compared to the same period in year 2018. The gross profit decreased due to lower compressed gases sales volume with slow down in activities in manufacturing sector together with tight competition for new business and an increase in calcium carbide cost and direct labour costs.

Profit before tax was RM3.17M, down by RM1.38M as compared with the corresponding period in year 2018. This was largely due to lower sales and increase in operating costs, such as decrease in other non-operating income by RM0.56M, higher administrative cost, manpower cost, and foreign exchange loss. The finance cost also increased by RM0.36M due to increase in utilisation of trade facilities and new term loan drawdown. The share of profit from an associate company was down from RM1.52M to RM1.19M.

B2. Material Changes In The Quarterly Results Compared To The Results Of The Preceding Quarter(Please refer to Note A 18 for Financial Result)

The Group's revenue at RM20.31M, was up by RM0.81M or 4.15% as compared to that of the preceding quarter of RM19.50M. This was partially attributed to higher sales of liquid Nitrogen and export sales of Nitrous oxide.

Gross profit was up by RM1.22M or 8.28% to RM5.47M due to the adoption of MFRS 5 of the accounting standards which requires no depreciation provision for the current quarter.

The Group posted a profit before tax of RM2.56M, as compared to the preceding quarter's profit before tax of RM0.20M. This was due to the above gross profit explanation.

The share of profit from the associate company was RM0.55M, up by RM0.44M mainly due to the unscheduled shut down of the plant for maintenance in previous quarter resulting in lower liquid sales.

B3. Current Year Prospects

Malaysian overall industrial environment is expected to remain challenging in 2019. There are numerous domestic and international economic issues that may have significant impact on the Malaysian economy. This includes the volatile market situation in the oil and gas sector and the cutting back of subsidies on essential goods by the Malaysian government. The global political and economic uncertainty due to the trade war between China and USA, the protectionist policy adopted by Trump's administration, the uncertainty in the global economic development, the heightened tension in the Middle East and others are likely to have an impact on the global economy.

As disclosed in A13 of the Report, the Board of Directors had accepted the offer from ALM. It was approved by the shareholders at the EGM on 25 October 2018 to dispose of the entire share capital of Southern Industrial Gas Sdn Bhd, a wholly owned subsidiary of SIG Gases Berhad and including 40 % shareholding held in Iwatani-SIG. The proposed disposal was approved by the shareholders on 25th October 2019. The disposal was completed on 31st October 2019. As such, the Group is now, as directed by Bursa Malaysia, classified under PN 16, a Cash Company with no material business activities. The Management is actively seeking to acquire a new business. The future prospect of the Company is dependent on whether the Company is able to successfully acquire a new business to retain its listing status.
