NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

PART A - EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MALAYSIAN FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS 134 ("MFRS 134")

A1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The unaudited interim financial statements (Report) have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of MFRS 134: *Interim Financial Reporting* and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad for the Main Board. This Report also complies with IAS 34: *Interim Financial Reporting* issued by the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB).

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial period ended 31 December 2013. The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2013.

A12. MATERIAL EVENTS SUBSEQUENT TO THE END OF INTERIM PERIOD

In the opinion of the Board of Directors, there were no items, transactions or events of a material and unusual nature that have arisen since 31 March 2014 to the date of this announcement which would substantially affect the financial results of the Group for the three months ended 31 March 2014 that have not been reflected in the condensed financial statements except as discussed below:-

(i) On 20 February 2014, subject to shareholders and other relevant authorities' approval, the Board of Directors approved to undertake a bonus issue of 220,000,000 new ordinary shares of RM0.10 each in Prestariang Berhad ("Prestariang") on the basis of one (1) bonus share for every one (1) existing Prestariang share held.

Subsequently, the Company's shareholders have approved the said proposal in Extraordinary General Meeting held on 16 April 2014. The entitlement date for the bonus issue is was on 5 May 2014.

(ii) On 16 April 2014, the Board of Directors approved the proposal for the Company to increase its authorised share capital. The shareholders' approval will be obtained at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting of the Company which will be determined and announced later.

A13. CHANGES IN COMPOSITION OF THE GROUP

There were no other changes in the composition of the Group during the current financial quarter except as discussed below:-

On 13 February 2014, the Company acquired 2 ordinary shares of RM1 each representing 100% of the issued and paid-up share capital of Prestariang Technology Sdn. Bhd. ("PTSB") for a total cash consideration of RM2. Consequently, PTSB became a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company.

PTSB a wholly-owned subsidiary of Prestariang had on 27 March 2014 entered into a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") with YPJ Holdings Sdn. Bhd. ("YPJH"), an investment arm of the Johor Education Foundation, to set up Petroleum Academy Malaysia ("the Academy") in the state of Johor Darul Takzim.

A14. CONTINGENT LIABILITIES OR CONTINGENT ASSETS

There were no material contingent liabilities or contingent assets to be disclosed as at the date of this report.

A15. SIGNIFICANT RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The Group's revenue for the current quarter of RM20.6 million was 21% or RM5.6 million lower than the corresponding quarter last year of RM26.2 million. The reason was mainly due to lower number of training classes conducted by Academy segment. However, the software licenses delivered for Software & Services segment was higher.

Other revenue is dividend income received from an operating subsidiary company which is eliminated at the group level.

The Group's PBT for the current quarter of RM6.4 million was lower by RM2.6 million or 29% as compared to RM9.0 million in the corresponding quarter last year as a flow through of lower revenue.

The Group's revenue for the current quarter of RM20.6 million was 32% or RM9.8 million lower than the preceding quarter of RM30.4 million. The reason was mainly due to lower number of training classes conducted by Academy segment and lower demand of software licenses by Software & Services segment.

The Group recorded lower PBT for the current quarter of RM6.4 million, as compared to RM10.8 million in the preceding quarter. The decline in PBT was mainly due to flow through from lower revenue recognised as explained above.

B3. PROSPECTS

In year 2014, the Group expects to a stable performance based on the on-going business in hand.
