Notes to the Interim Financial Statements for the third quarter ended 31 December 2019

A1 Accounting Policies And Basis Of Preparation

The interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and Chapter 9 Part K of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements are unaudited and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 March 2019, which had been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS).

The accounting policies adopted for the interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted for the annual audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 March 2019 except for the adoption of new MFRSs, amendments and IC interpretations that are mandatory for the Group for the financial year beginning or after 1 April 2019.

On 1 April 2019, the following accounting standards, amendments and interpretations of the MFRS Framework were adopted by the Group.

MFRS 16 Leases

MFRS 16, Leases replaces the guidance in MFRS 117 Leases, IC Interpretation 4 Determining whether an Arrangement contains a Lease, IC Interpretation 115 Operating Leases - Incentives and IC Interpretation 127 Evaluating the Substance of Transactions Involving the Legal Form of a Lease

MFRS 16 introduces a single, on-balance sheet lease accounting model for lessees. A lessee recognises a right-of-use asset representing its obligations to make lease payments. There are recognition exemptions for short-term leases and leases of low-value items. Lessor accounting remains similar to the current standard which continues to be classified as finance or operating lease.

The Group applied MFRS 16 using modified restropective approach and measured the right-of-use assets equals to the lease liabilities as 1 April 2019 with no restatement of comparative information. A2 Seasonal and Cyclical Factors

Generally, the Group's operations will benefit from higher consumer spendings during festive seasons in Malaysia.

A3 Unusual Items due to Their Nature, Size or Incidence

There were no unusual items that may affect the amount stated in the interim financial statements during the financial period ended 31 December 2019.

A4 Change in Estimates

There were no changes in estimates that had any material effect for the financial period ended 31 December 2019.

A5 Issuances, Cancellations, Repurchases, Resale and Repayments of Debt and Equity Securities

There were no issuance, repurchases and repayment of debt and equity securities and share cancellations during the financial period ended 31 December 2019 except for the following:

Equity Securities

During the financial period under review, the Company had issued 122,625 new ordinary shares pursuant to conversions of 144,700 units of ICULS.

As at 31 December 2019, the number of ordinary shares were 297,146,444 shares. The number of outstanding ICULS stood at 7,152,861 units.

Debt Securities

During the financial period under review, Premier Auto Assets Berhad, a special purpose vehicle incorporated to facilitate the Asset-Backed Securitisation ("ABS") exercise of the Group, had issued RM105 million and RM40.5 million of Senior Medium Term Notes ("MTN") and Junior MTNs respectively. The Junior MTNs were subscribed by ELK-Desa Capital Sdn Bhd, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company.

A6 Dividend Paid

Pursuant to the shareholders' approval on 8 August 2019 for the single-tier final dividend of 3.50 sen per share in respect of the financial year ended 31 March 2019, the dividend amounting to RM10.40 million was paid to shareholders on 28 August 2018.

On 15 January 2020, the Company had paid a single-tier interim dividend of 3.50 sen per share for the financial year ending 31 March 2020 amounting to RM10.40 million.

The Group's revenue increased by 24% to RM38.65 million. The Group's profit before tax increased by 32% to RM13.25 million. The increase in revenue and profit before tax were mainly due to higher contribution from hire purchase segment for the quarter ended 31 December 2019.

Hire purchase receivables recorded a 32% growth year on year from RM456.06 million to RM601.69 million as at 31 December 2019. This was the key factor that led to the increase in hire puchase revenue for the current financial period.

In line with the Group's capital management strategy to leverage up, total bank borrowings increased by 81% mainly due to higher drawdown of block discounting facility and MTNs were issued during the current financial period to finance the increase of hire purchase receivables. Nevertheless, the Group's gearing remains at a low and manageable level of 0.68 times.

Revenue increased by 28% to RM27.64 million, mainly due to increase in hire purchase portfolio.

Impairment allowance increased by 23% to RM6.03 million. Credit loss charge (i.e. impairment allowance over average net hire purchase receivables) decreased slightly from 1.05% to 0.98%. The marginal decrease in credit loss charge was mainly due to the Group's concerted efforts in credit recovery and a larger hire purchase portfolio.

Other expenses decreased by 4% to RM5.92 million. Cost to income ratio remains at manageable level of 27%.

As a result of higher borrowings and debt securities, the finance cost increased by 218% to RM3.72 million.

The profit before tax increased by 32% to RM12.93 million mainly due to increase in hire purchase portfolio for the quarter ended 31 December 2019.

Revenue increased by 17% to RM11.01 million mainly due to the increase of local sales, which is in line with the Group's effort to focus its operations in the domestic market.

Impairment allowance increased by RM0.17 million to RM0.20 million mainly due to slower payment from furniture dealers. Other expenses reduced by 8% to RM2.91 million mainly due to lower operating expenses.

The segment recorded profit before tax of RM0.33 million mainly due to the higher sales for the quarter ended 31 December 2019.

Notes to the Interim Financial Statements for the third quarter ended 31 December 2019

YEAR-TO-DATE (FY2020 YTD vs FY2019 YTD)

The Group's revenue increased by 21% to RM110.47 million, due to higher contribution from both hire purchase and furniture segment.

The Group's profit before tax increased by 18% to RM38.34 million, mainly contributed by the hire purchase segment.

Hire Purchase Segment

Revenue increased by 24% from RM62.37 million to RM77.38 million, mainly due to increase in hire purchase portfolio.

Impairment allowance increased by 23% to RM15.14 million. Credit loss charge (i.e. impairment allowance over average net hire purchase receivables) marginally decreased from 2.85% to 2.75%. The improvement was mainly due to the Group's concerted efforts in credit recovery and a larger hire purchase portfolio.

Other expenses increased by 12% to RM19.02 million mainly due higher staff costs. Cost to income ratio remains at manageable level of 27%.

As a result of higher borrowings, the finance cost increased by 197% to RM8.28 million.

The profit before tax increased by 17% to RM37.19 million mainly due to increase in hire purchase portfolio for the nine (9) months period ended 31 December 2019.

Furniture Segment

Revenue increased by 16% to RM33.09 million mainly due to the increase of local sales, which is in line with the Group's effort to focus its operations in the domestic market.

Impairment allowance increased by RM0.08 million to RM0.43 million, mainly due to slower payment from furniture dealers. Other expenses reduced by 4% to RM8.92 million mainly due to lower operating expenses.

The segment recorded a higher profit before tax of RM1.17 million for the nine (9) months period ended 31 December 2019 mainly due to higher revenue.

The Group's profit before tax for the current quarter of RM13.25 million was higher as compared to RM12.82 million of the immediate preceding quarter mainly due to higher profit contribution from the hire purchase segment in the current quarter.

B3 Prospects and Outlook

Despite the uncertain global economic conditions ahead, the overall domestic macro-economic factors (i.e. labour market conditions, inflation outlook, cost of living) remain relatively stable.

Moving forward, the Group is also cognisant of the external headwinds pressuring the domestic economy. These include the potential impact from the recent Nova Corona virus outbreak and the uncertainties that stem from the on-going trade war between China and the US. While we are paying close attention to these developments, we believe that the Malaysian economy remains resilient and would be able to withstand the difficulties in the immediate to medium term. In view of this, the Group intends to maintain its strategic direction to grow its hire purchase portfolio dynamically while paying close attention to safeguarding the quality of its assets.

The Group will focus on its core business of second hand car hire purchase financing, which strategically operates in the underserved niche market, and continue to remain prudent in managing its credit risks.

The furniture trading business will continue to focus its operations in the domestic wholesale market.

Based on the Group's results to date, the Board is optimistic that the Group's performance for the financial year ending 31 March 2020 is expected to be better than financial year ended 31 March 2019 amidst a more challenging economic environment in the coming months.
