Explanatory Notes Pursuant to MFRS 134 For the period ended 30 June 2015

1. Basis of preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements, for the period ended 30 June 2015, have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. These condensed consolidated interim financial statements also comply with IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the International Accounting Standards Board.

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the Group audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2014.

The explanatory notes attached to the condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to gain an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the last financial year ended 31 December 2014.

16. Events after the reporting period

Proposed change of company name

On 27 July 2015, the Board of Directors of the Company announced that the Company is proposing to change its name from "Tune Ins Holdings Berhad" to "Tune Protect Group Berhad" ("Proposed Change of Name").

The Proposed Change of Name is to create a more distinct corporate identity for the Company to better reflect the dynamic and holistic business activities and branding of the Group.

Group/Consolidated

The Group's operating revenue increased by RM13.8 million from RM101.5 million in 2Q14 to RM115.3 million in 2Q15, mainly due to increase of RM13.7 million in gross earned premiums.

The increase of RM2.7 million or 17% in Group's profit before tax ("PBT"), from RM15.7 million in 2Q14 to RM18.4 million in 2Q15 was mainly due to the increases in pre-tax profits of RM4.9 million in general insurance and RM0.4 million in general reinsurance respectively, offset by higher management expenses.

General reinsurance

Operating revenue of this segment increased by RM4.4 million from RM27.0 million in 2Q14 to RM31.4 million in 2Q15 mainly due to increase of RM4.5 million in gross earned premiums ("GEP") (including inter-segment) of Malaysia and Middle East, offset by decrease in Indonesia.

The increase of RM0.4 million in segment profit was minimal.

General insurance

Operating revenue of this segment increased by RM12.2 million from RM86.4 million in 2Q14 to RM98.6 million in 2Q15, due to increase in GEP of RM12.3 million mainly from the fire, motor and travel class of businesses.

Profit of this segment increased by RM4.9 million, from RM3.1 million in 2Q14 to RM8.0 million in 2Q15 was mainly due to increase of RM6.5 million in net earned premiums of fire, motor, and travel class of businesses, offset by increase of RM1.5 million in management expenses mainly in staff costs (including ESOS expense).

The Group's operating revenue increased from RM215.5 million in YTD 2014 to RM226.5 million in YTD 2015. The increase of RM11.0 million was due to increase of RM9.5 million in GEP and RM1.5 million in investment income.

The decrease of RM2.1 million or 6% in Group's PBT, from RM37.8 million in YTD 2014 to RM35.7 million in YTD 2015 was mainly due to higher management expenses of RM6.0 million, offset by increase of RM0.8 million in pre-tax profits from general reinsurance and RM0.7 million in share of profit from associates in Thailand.

General reinsurance

Operating revenue of this segment increased from RM54.6 million in YTD 2014 to RM61.6 million in YTD 2015. The increase of RM7.0 million was mainly contributed by the growth in GEP from Malaysia, Middle East and Philippines, offset by deficit in Indonesia and China.

The increase of RM0.7 million in segment profit was minimal.

General insurance

There was an increase of RM8.6 million in operating revenue of this segment, from RM183.7 million in YTD 2014 to RM192.3 million in YTD 2015, which was mainly due to increase of RM8.4 million in GEP mainly from motor and fire class of businesses and increase of RM0.2 million in investment income.

There was a minimal decrease in RM0.1 million in profit of this segment.

Group/Consolidated

The Group's operating revenue increased from RM111.2 million in 1Q15 to RM115.2 million in 2Q15. The increase of RM4.0 million was due to increases of RM3.8 million in GEP and RM0.2 million in investment income.

Segment profit of the Group increased by RM1.1 million from RM17.3 million in 1Q15 to RM18.4 million in 2Q15, due to an increase of RM4.2 million in pre-tax profits in general insurance, offset by decrease of RM1.2 million in general reinsurance, higher management expenses of the Company of RM1.5 million and decrease of RM0.5 million in share of profits of associates in Thailand.

General reinsurance

There was an increase of RM1.2 million in operating revenue of this segment mainly contributed by increase in GEP of Malaysia in 2Q15.

Profit of this segment decreased by RM1.1 million mainly due to increase of RM1.4 million in management expenses for higher staff costs and marketing costs.

General insurance

Operating revenue of this segment increased from RM93.7 million in 1Q15 to RM98.6 million in 2Q15. The increase of RM4.9 million was mainly due to increase of RM3.8 million in GEP mainly in fire and motor class of businesses and RM1.1 million in investment income due to higher yield mainly from collective investment schemes.

The increase of RM4.2 million in segment profit was mainly due to increase in net earned premiums in fire and motor class of businesses arising from the reduction of cession under the Motor Quota Share arrangement.

18. Commentary on prospects

The Group is on track with its growth strategies across its core businesses. 1Q15 started the year with travel demand softness, coming off the trails of QZ8501 incident in late 4Q14. However, travel demand has since picked up in late 1Q15 and expected global travel has recorded a growth of 31.9% in GEP for 2Q15 over that of 2014.

TIMB, our general insurance entity, faced a temporary impact on short-term policies in 1Q15, and this had normalised during 2Q15 through a growth of 4.2% in GEP for 2Q15 over that of 1Q15. TIMB will also continue to focus on profitable portfolio lines with higher contribution to both top and bottom line for the Group.

Our Middle East joint venture has continued to post a strong profit in 2Q15, which has exceeded its full year profit in 2014. This joint venture is expected to continue to grow with the activation of offline agents and new distribution channels in the Middle East markets. Thailand affiliates are also expected to post higher profit contributions as their businesses grow in the coming months.

As part of the ASEAN expansion, the Group has embarked on its acquisition of a 50%+1 share stake in an Indonesian general insurer, which is pending regulatory approval. The acquisition is expected to be completed some time in the next three months. In addition, the Group also continues to strengthen its digital channel for broader consumer access.

Notwithstanding the recent political developments, economic situation and currency volatility in the region, we are confident that our second half performance will continue with a similar growth trend based on our current business pipeline and forward sales.

20. Status of corporate proposal

Investment in PT Asuransi Staco Mandiri ("ASM")

On 5 May 2015, the Company had executed a Conditional Binding Offer Letter to acquire 38,235 ordinary shares of IDR500,000 each or 31.82% of the issued and paid-up shares (or 23.33% of the enlarged share capital) from Dana Pensiun Bank Mandiri Dua, Yayasan Kesejahteraan Pensiun BDN, and Dana Pensiun Pertamina, for the purchase consideration of IDR26,764,500,000 or IDR700,000 per share and to subscribe the entirety of 43,707 newly issued shares in ASM for IDR30,594,900,000 or 26.67% of the enlarged share capital in ASM; and a Cooperation Agreement with PT Cahaya Putratama Abadi ("CPA") for CPA to assist TIH to become the holding company of ASM, to facilitate the acquisition process of ASM and for CPA to provide further assistance and business development services for the expansion of TIH's insurance business in Indonesia, for IDR25,500,000,000.

The acquisition and cooperation would enable TIH to own a total of 81,942 shares or 50% plus 1 share equity interest in ASM at a collective purchase consideration of IDR82,859,400,000 (equivalent to approximately RM22.79 million). The investment in ASM is subject to the approval of Bank Negara Malaysia and Otoritas Jasa Keuangan Indonesia ("OJK").

An application for approval with respect to the proposed investment and change in shareholding in ASM has also been submitted to the regulator, OJK by ASM.

On 4 August 2015, the Company announced that TIH is still in discussion and awaiting the necessary approvals from the regulators for TIH to proceed with the acquisition of 50% plus 1 share equity interest in ASM.

21. Material litigation

There were no material litigations at the date of this report.
