UNAUDITED QUARTERLY REPORT FOR THE FOURTH QUARTER ENDED 30 JUNE 2019

A. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO THE MALAYSIAN FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARD 134

A1. Basis of Preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the MFRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting, paragraph 9.22 and Appendix 9B of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Malaysia").

A2. Changes in Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation adopted in the preparation of these interim financial statements are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for financial year ended 30 June 2018.

A2. Changes in Accounting Policies (CONT'D)

The adoption of the above accounting standard(s) and/or interpretation(s) (including the consequential amendments, if any) is expected to have no material impact on the financial statements of the Group upon their initial application except as follows:

(a) MFRS 9 (IFRS 9 issued by IASB in July 2014) replaces the guidance in MFRS 139 on the classification and measurement of financial assets and financial liabilities, impairment of financial assets and on hedge accounting.

Based on the assessments undertaken to date, the Group has determined the impact of its initial application of MFRS 9 as follows:-

Classification and Measurement

Loans and receivables financial assets are held to collect contractual cash flows and are expected to give rise to cash flows representing solely payments of principal and interest. The Group analysed the contractual cash flow characteristics of these instruments and concluded that they meet the criteria to be measured at amortised cost under MFRS 9. Therefore, the Group does not expect the standard to affect the measurement of its debt financial assets.

In addition, the Group expects to continue measuring at fair value all financial assets currently held at fair value.

Impairment of Financial Assets

MFRS 9 replaces the 'incurred loss' model in MFRS 139 with an 'expected credit loss' ("ECL") model.

During the current quarter ended 30 June 2019, the Group's revenue rose by RM116.535 million or 227% over the preceding year's corresponding quarter. Both CHUCTMM and MS posted an increase in revenue of RM85.476 million (or 426%) and RM30.172 million (or 407%) respectively because of increased in offshore activities and higher utilization rate for its marine vessels which included a diving support vessel (DSV) for underwater service. MPS revenues also increased by RM4.594 million (or 23%) derived from higher demand for its manpower supply to Refinery and Petrochemical Integrated Development (RAPID) and offshore technician contract.

The Group registered a pre-tax profit of RM11.283 million for the current quarter in tandem with the increased revenue as compared to a pre-tax loss of RM15.970 million recorded in the preceding year corresponding quarter having lower revenues posted and higher impairment costs from its vessel and a debtor.

The Group's revenue increased significantly by RM73.295 million (or 77%) as compared to the immediate preceding quarter. MPS's revenue contribution remains positive with an increase by RM1.691 million (or 7%) as demand for personnel under RAPID and offshore technicians contract remain active during the quarter. CHUCTMM and MS divisions also posted an increase in revenue of RM41.538 million (or 65%) and RM31.003 million (or 470%) respectively as there are major shut down services performed by CHUCTMM while the demand for vessels under the MS remain high during the quarter under review.



B2. Comparison with Immediate Preceding Quarter's Results (CONT'D)

Additionally, during the quarter under review MS division commenced activities under PAN Malaysia underwater services inspection contract utilizing DSV, remotely operated vehicle (ROV) and dive equipment. However, CIVIL revenue performances declined by RM0.938 million (or -61%) as there were no new projects win and near completion of existing projects.

In tandem with the increase in revenue, the group posted a pre-tax profit of RM11.283 million against RM2.841 million recorded in the immediate preceding quarter.

B3. Current Prospect

In spite of volatility in global oil price, the client's integrity facilities management is continuing and would provide sustained project activities and work orders for the Group.

The Group is diversifying its range of services to include sub-sea works particularly underwater inspection, repair & maintenance works and services (IRM) while enhancing its capacity building, internal capabilities and seek business opportunities for sustainable growth and profitability.

B4. Profit Forecast, Profit Guarantee and Internal Targets

The Group did not provide any profit forecast, profit guarantee and internal targets in any public document or any announcements made.
