1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with FRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting and Chapter 9 part 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Malaysia").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2011.

1. BASIS OF PREPARATION (CONT'D)

Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS FRAMEWORK)

On 19 November 2011, the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS Framework).

The MFRS Framework is to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private Entities for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 Agriculture and IC Interpretation 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate (IC 15), including its parent, significant investor and venturer (herein called Transitioning Entities").

Transitioning Entities were allowed to defer adoption of the new MFRS Framework for 2 years such that adoption of the MFRS Framework by Transitioning Entities will be mandatory for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2014.

The Group falls within the scope definition of Transitioning Entities and has opted to defer adoption of the new MFRS Framework. Accordingly, the Group will be required to prepare financial statements using the MFRS Framework in its financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2014. In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Group will be required to restate the comparative financial statements to amounts reflecting the application of MFRS Framework. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, retrospectively, against opening retained profits.

2. AUDIT QUALIFICATION OF PRECEDING AUDITED ANNUAL REPORT

There were no audit qualifications in the Group's preceding audited annual report.

3. SEASONAL OR CYCLICAL FACTORS

The Group's operations are not materially affected by any seasonal or cyclical events.

14. REVIEW OF PERFORMANCE

For the current quarter under review, the Group registered revenue of RM44.91 million and loss before tax of RM1.54 million respectively. In comparison, revenue and profit before tax of RM42.73 million and RM4.21 million respectively were recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter. The marginal increase in the Group's revenue was contributed by the Property Development segment.

Year-on-year, the Group's revenue and profit before tax improved by RM21.12 million (19.2%) and RM3.39 million (46.1%) respectively. The better performance as compared to the preceding year's corresponding period was mainly due to better performance from the Group's Property Development segment.

The performances of the respective segments of the Group are as follows:

(a) Property Development

Revenue from sale of development properties of RM20.71 was registered in the current quarter as compared to RM23.39 million revenue recorded in the coresponding quarter of the preceding year. The revenue recorded was lower mainly due to lower progressive billings recognised from C2 Retail Streetmall (double-storey shops) compared to that recognised in the preceding year's corresponding quarter as its development was nearing completion in the current quarter.

On year-to-date basis, the Property Development segment posted higher revenue of RM66.12 million as compared to RM46.94 million recorded in the previous period. Similarly, profit before tax of RM14.86 million recorded was higher compared to RM6.54 million recorded in the previous period. The better results generated was mainly due to higher progressive billings and profits being recognised from Bayu Residence Phases 1 and 2 (townhouses & apartments) and Nilai Springs Heights, Blocks 6-10 (double-storey superlink houses).

(b) Education

The Education segment posted revenue of RM12.05 million in the current quarter which is at par with that recorded in the same quarter of the preceding year. With additional staff cost incurred by Nilai University arising from recruitment of new academic and administrative staff, higher marketing and promotion expenses and professional fees incurred, the Education segment registered a pre-tax loss of RM3.18 million for the quarter as compared to a pre-tax loss of RM0.53 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter.

Likewise, year-to-date revenue of RM41.39 million was at par with that recorded in the same period of last year. However, a pre-tax loss of RM2.13 million was recorded as compared to a profit before tax of RM4.62 million recorded in the same period of last year. This unfavourable result was due to same reasons as mentioned in the aforesaid paragraph.

(c) Hotel & Leisure

The Hotel and Leisure segment posted higher revenue of RM5.42 million in the current quarter as compared to RM4.90 million recorded in the same period of the preceding year, reflecting an increase of RM0.41 million or 8.4%. Pre-tax loss of RM0.12 million was recorded compared to a pre-tax loss of RM0.39 milion recorded in the same period of the preceding year. The better performance was primarily contributed from the hotel operation arising from higher occupancy rate recorded, higher average room rate charged and better sales from the Food and Beverage division.

On year-to-date basis, the Hotel and Leisure segment posted higher revenue of RM17.04 million compared to RM14.75 million recorded in the same period of last year, reflecting an increase of RM1.99 million or 13.5%. Profit before tax of RM0.38 million was generated compared to a pre-tax loss of RM1.37 million recorded in the same period of last year. The better YTD performance was attributed from hotel operation for the same reasons mentioned in the aforesaid paragraph.

15. MATERIAL CHANGES IN THE PROFIT BEFORE TAXATION FOR THE QUARTER COMPARED TO THE IMMEDIATE PRECEDING QUARTER

The Group recorded a pre-tax loss of RM1.55 million for the quarter under review as compared to a pre-tax profit of RM9.48 million registered in the immediate preceding quarter. The unfavourable results generated was primarily due to pre-tax loss being recorded under the Education segment and lower progressive billings recognised from Anggerik Court (apartments) and C2 Retail Streetmall (double-storey shops) in the current quarter.

20. STATUS OF CORPORATE PROPOSALS

On 20 February 2012, Nilai Resources Group Berhad ("the Company") received an offer letter from Akarmas Sdn Bhd and Tan Sri Dato' Dr. Gan Kong Seng being the non-entitled shareholders of the Company, proposing the privatisation of the Company via a selective capital reduction and repayment exercise (the Proposed SCR) pursuant to Section 64 of the Companies Act, 1965.

Under the Proposed SCR, a cash consideration of RM1.50 for each ordinary share held in the Company has been proposed to all entitled shareholders while the entitlements of the non-entitled shareholders shall be waived. Upon its completion, the non-entitled shareholders will collectively own the entire issued and paid up share capital of the Company.

The proposed SCR is conditional on the following being obtained:

- (i) The consent of the Securities Commission Malaysia for the contents and the issuance of the Circular, the Explanatory Statement and the Independent Advice Letter in relation to the Proposed SCR, which was obtained on 6 July 2012;
- (ii) The approval of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad for the Circular, which was obtained on 11 July 2012;
- (iii) The approval of the shareholders of the Company for the Proposed SCR, which was obtained at an Extraordinary General Meeting held on 8 August 2012;
- (iv) The grant of an order by the High Court of Malaya confirming the Proposed SCR, which was obtained on 1 October 2012.

As at 14 November 2012, all the above mentioned consent, approvals and grant had been obtained.

The entitlement date, being the date on which the names of the entitled shareholders must be registered in the Company's Record Of Depositors, had been determined to be on 29 November 2012 which is within the original estimated time frame (end November 2012) as stated in the Company's circular to shareholders in relation to the Proposed SCR dated 17 July 2012. The capital repayment is expected to be made within ten (10) days from the entitlement date.
