E. EXPLANATORY NOTES

(Amounts in RM million unless otherwise stated)

1) BASIS OF PREPARATION

These unaudited condensed interim financial statements of the Group have been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements as set out in Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting", International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS") 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" and paragraph 9.22 and Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad, and should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the year ended 31 August 2013.

Within the context of these financial statements, the Group comprises the Company and its subsidiaries and the Group's interest in associates and jointly controlled entities as at 31 August 2013. The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 August 2013.

2) AUDIT QUALIFICATION

The annual audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 August 2013 were not subject to any qualification.

3) CHANGES IN ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies applied are consistent with those adopted for the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 August 2013 except for the adoption of new standards, amendments to standards and IC interpretations that are mandatory for the Group for financial year beginning 1 September 2013.

New standards, amendments to standards and IC interpretations that are applicable to the Group effective 1 September 2013

- MFRS 10 "Consolidated Financial Statements"

 Amendments to MFRS 10, 11 and 12 "Consolidated Financial Statements, Joint Arrangements and Disclosure of Interests in Other Entities: Transition Guidance"

Except for Amendments to MFRS 10 and MFRS 116, the adoption of the revised standards and amendments to standards did not have any significant impact to the unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements upon their initial application.

MFRS 10 "Consolidated Financial Statements"

MFRS 10 changes the definition of control and establishes control as the basis for determining which entities are consolidated in the consolidated financial statements. The Group controls an entity when the Group has power over an entity, is exposed to, or has rights to, variable returns from its involvement with the entity and has the ability to affect these returns through its power over the entity.

Based on the preliminary assessment performed, the Group assessed that adoption of MFRS 10 did not result in any change in the consolidation status of its subsidiaries as at 30 November 2013.



Amendments to MFRS 116 "Property, Plant and Equipment"

Amendments to MFRS 116 clarifies that items such as spare parts, stand-by equipment and servicing equipment shall be recognised as property, plant and equipment when they meet the definition of property, plant and equipment. Previously, MFRS 116 states that spare parts, stand-by equipment and servicing equipment are usually carried as inventory and recognised in profit and loss as consumed.

Upon adoption of Amendments to MFRS 116, the Group has performed an assessment on over 99% of its inventory balances. This has resulted in the retrospective reclassification of spare parts, stand-by equipment and servicing equipment previously accounted for under inventories to property, plant and equipment.

The full assessment on the remaining balances will be completed before the financial year end and the Group expects the impact to not be material.

There were no changes in the estimates of the amounts reported in the previous financial year that have a material effect on the results of the current reporting period.



7) DEBT AND EQUITY SECURITIES

There were no issuance, cancellation, repurchases, resales and repayments of debt and equity securities during the period under review.

8) DIVIDENDS

There was no dividend paid during the quarter.

The Board of Directors has not recommended any dividend for the quarter ended 30 November 2013.

9) SEGMENTAL REPORTING

Segmental reporting is not presented as the Group is principally engaged in the generation, transmission, distribution and sales of electricity and the provision of other related services, which are substantially within a single business segment. The Group operates primarily in Malaysia.

10) VALUATION OF PROPERTY, PLANT & EQUIPMENT

The Group does not adopt a revaluation policy on its Property, Plant and Equipment.

11) MATERIAL EVENTS SUBSEQUENT TO THE END OF THE REPORTING PERIOD

There were no material events subsequent to the end of the reporting period.

12) CHANGES IN THE COMPOSITION OF THE GROUP

There was no material change to the composition of the Group during the reporting period.

15) REVIEW OF PERFORMANCE

Performance of the current first quarter (three months) FY2014 against the corresponding first quarter (three months) FY2013:

The quarter recorded sales of electricity of RM9,077.5 million against RM8,806.2 million for the same period last financial year. The improvement was mainly from sales of electricity in the Peninsula and Sabah, which recorded an increase of 3.3% and 1.6% respectively. The units sold also registered a growth of 2.6% in the Peninsula and 1.4% in Sabah as compared to the corresponding quarter.

For the quarter under review, the Group reported a 13.4% lower operating profit of RM1,522.9 million as compared to the corresponding quarter of RM1,757.8 million due to higher operating expenses incurred during the quarter.

Profit attributable to the Owners of the Company for the quarter under review was RM1,734.9 million as compared to RM1,415.5 million recorded in the corresponding first quarter last financial year, an increase of RM319.4 million or 22.6%. The higher profit is due to significant movement in taxation, being the result of reinvestment allowance incentive of RM201.7 million and the reversal of deferred taxation of RM188.7 million to reflect the change in the taxation rate from 25% to 24%.

The current quarter recorded a lower translation gain of RM252.7 million as compared to RM397.4 million reported in the first quarter of FY2013 due to the weakening of the Ringgit against the Japanese Yen.

16) MATERIAL CHANGES IN THE QUARTERLY RESULTS COMPARED TO THE PRECEDING QUARTER

Performance of the current quarter (1^{st} Quarter FY2014) against the preceding quarter (4^{th} Quarter FY2013):

The Group reported a lower total sales of electricity of RM9,077.5 million for the current quarter as compared to RM9,430.9 million in the preceding quarter, a decrease of RM353.4 million or 3.7%. The decrease was mainly contributed by the sales of electricity in Peninsular Malaysia and Sabah of 3.7% and 1.7% respectively.

A lower operating expenses of RM8,130.4 million as compared to RM8,855.1 million was recorded during the quarter under review. Additionally, the Group also reported a foreign currency translation gain of RM252.7 million as compared to a loss of RM617.1 million recorded in the last quarter. These had significantly contributed to the higher profit attributable to owners of the Company, from RM219.4 million (in Q4 FY2013) to RM1,734.9 million (in Q1 FY2014).

17) PROSPECTS

The Malaysian Institute of Economic Research (MIER) projected a better growth outlook for 2014 of between 5.0 - 5.5%, whilst maintaining its 2013 growth forecast of 4.8%. With the implementation of the Incentive Based Regulation (IBR), it is anticipated that the fuel cost risks are mitigated, therefore leading to better earnings predictability for TNB.

Based on the above, The Board of Directors continue to view the prospects of the Group for the Financial Year 2014 to remain positive.

For the reporting period ended 30 November 2013, the Group recorded a negative 7.2% effective tax rate, which is much lower than the statutory tax rate of 25.0%. The lower effective tax rate is mainly due to the utilisation of reinvestment allowance incentive during the current quarter and also due to reversal of deferred tax provision to reflect the reduction of corporate income tax rate from 25% to 24% as announced in the Budget 2014.
