1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with applicable disclosure provisions of paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 1342004: Interim Financial Reporting as issued by Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB").

The interim financial statements have also been prepared in accordance with the same accounting policies adopted for Annual Financial Statements for 2010.

The preparation of an interim financial statement in conformity with FRS 1342004: Interim Financial Reporting requires management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of accounting policies and reported amounts of assets and liabilities, income and expenses on a year-to-date basis. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The interim financial statements contain condensed consolidated financial statements and selected explanatory notes. The notes include an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since Annual Financial Statements for 2010.

Annual Financial Statements for the financial year ended 30 September 2010 are available from the Company's registered office.

2. Changes in Accounting Policies

The Group's audited consolidated financial statements for financial year ended 30 September 2010 were prepared in accordance with applicable approved accounting standards in Malaysia.

3. Auditors' Report on Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report on the Company's Annual Financial Statements for the financial year ended 30 September 2010 was not subjected to any qualification.

PART B: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

16. Review of Performance

Third (3rd) quarter financial year 2011 ("3Q11") revenue rose by 81.2% year-on-year to RM61.7 million mainly due to timing of completion of a few high value orders. Gross profit margin improved from13.9% to 17.4% resulting from a write-back of provision for liquidated and ascertained damages of RM2.9 million in 3Q11 and the favourable product mix. The 3Q11 also incurred lower exchange loss of RM0.1 million compared to RM1.2 million during the same period last year. These contributed to the sharp rise in profit before taxation of RM7.5 million from RM0.5 million previously.

The performance of the Group's NDTS division is in line with the industry.

17. Review of Current Quarter's Results against Preceding Quarter's Results

Revenue for 3Q11 increased by 86.5% to RM61.7 million from RM33.1 million for 2Q11 and together with the write-back of provision for liquidated and ascertained damages and the favourable product mix accounted for the 64.9% increase in gross profit to RM10.7 million . The 3Q11 also incurred lower exchange loss of RM0.1 million compared to RM1.9 million in the previous quarter. These contributed to the rise in profit after taxation from RM1.3 million to RM5.4 million quarter-on-quarter.

18. Prospects

Demand for process equipment remains weak and the industry is plagued with excess capacity. The Directors expect the current year to be challenging.

19. Variance of Actual and Forecast Profit

There was no profit forecast or profit guarantee announced during the current guarter and financial year-to-date.
