PART A: DISCLOSURE NOTES AS REQUIRED UNDER FRS 134 - INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with applicable disclosure provisions of paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 1342004: Interim Financial Reporting as issued by Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB").

The interim financial statements have also been prepared in accordance with the same accounting policies adopted for Annual Financial Statements for 2011.

The preparation of an interim financial statement in conformity with FRS 1342004: Interim Financial Reporting requires management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of accounting policies and reported amounts of assets and liabilities, income and expenses on a year-to-date basis. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The interim financial statements contain condensed consolidated financial statements and selected explanatory notes. The notes include an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since Annual Financial Statements for 2011.

Annual Financial Statements for the financial year ended 30 September 2011 are available from the Company's registered office.

2. Changes in Accounting Policies

The Group's audited consolidated financial statements for financial year ended 30 September 2011 were prepared in accordance with applicable approved accounting standards in Malaysia.

3. Auditors' Report on Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report on the Company's Annual Financial Statements for the financial year ended 30 September 2011 was not subjected to any qualification.

4. Comments about Seasonal and / or Cyclical Factors

The Group's business operations are not materially affected by any major seasonal or cyclical factors.

5. Unusual Items due to their Nature, Size or Incidence

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows during the current quarter and financial year-to-date.

6. Material Changes in Estimates

There were no material changes in estimates of amount reported in prior financial year that have a material effect on the current quarter and financial year-to-date.

7. Issuance and Repayment of Debt and Equity Securities

There were no issuance or repayment of debt and equity securities during the current quarter and financial year-to-date.

8. Dividend

For the financial year under review, the Company had paid on 18 April 2012 a final single tier dividend of 3.0% in respect of the financial year ended 30 September 2011 and had paid on 22 June 2012 an interim single tier dividend of 3.5% in respect of the financial year ended 30 September 2012.

The Board has recommended a final single tier dividend of 3.0% and subject to the approval of the shareholders at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting, will be paid at a date to be determined. Upon approval, together with the interim dividend of 3.5% which was paid earlier will bring the total dividend to 6.5% for financial year ended 30 September 2012.

PART B: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

16. Review of Performance

Revenue for fourth (4th) quarter financial year 2012 ("4Q12") increased marginally by 5.6% year-on-year to RM49.7 million. Year-to-date 2012 revenue rose by 34.6% to RM227.3 million from RM168.9 million in the preceding year mainly because the Group was successful in securing a few high valued projects during the year. The Group's 4Q12 earning was significantly higher due to an improvement in gross profit margin to 25.3% in 4Q12 from 6.8% in 4Q11. Lower provision for liquidated and ascertained damages of RM0.5 million versus RM3.8 million previously has also contributed to the Group's gross profit. These have resulted in the improvement in profit before taxation from RM0.9 million in 4Q11 to RM8.0 million this quarter. Likewise, profit after taxation was also higher at RM4.9 million (RM1.5 million in 4Q11). Overall, with a profit after taxation of RM8.8 million for the full year, the Group had managed to match at prior year's results despite a more competitive environment.

The performance of the Group's NDT division is in line with the industry.

17. Review of Current Quarter's Results against Preceding Quarter's Results

Revenue for 4Q12 decreased by 0.4% to RM49.7 million from RM49.9 million for 3Q12. However, the Group's 4Q12 earning was significantly higher due to an improvement in gross profit margin to 25.3% from 7.9% in 3Q12. The main reason for the sharp improvement in margin was due to the one-off compensation to client in 3Q12 arising from a cancellation of a contracted project which the Group would not be able to fulfill its specifications. Lower provision for liquidated and ascertained damages of RM0.5 million versus RM0.8 million previously has also improved the Group's gross profit. As a result, 4Q12 profit before taxation improved to RM8.0 million from RM1.5 million in 3Q12.

18. Prospects

Demand for process equipment remains weak and the industry is plagued with excess capacity. The Directors expect next year to remain challenging.

19. Variance of Actual and Forecast Profit

There was no profit forecast or profit guarantee announced during the current guarter and financial year-to-date.
