PART A - EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FRS 134: INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENT.

1. Basis of preparation and Accounting Policies.

The Interim Financial Report of the Group is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements outlined in Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134: "Interim Financial Reporting" issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) and Paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (Bursa) Listing Requirements and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2011.

The Interim Financial Report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2011. It contains unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements and selected explanatory notes. These explanatory notes provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2011. The condensed consolidated interim financial report and notes thereon do not include all of the information requires for a full set of financial statements prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards (FRS).

1.1. Significant Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies and method of computation adopted by the Group are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2011, except for the adoption of the following new Financial Reporting Standards ("FRSs"), Amendments to FRSs and Interpretations by the Group. 1.2. Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards.

On 19 November 2011, MASB issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS Framework") in conjunction with the MASB's plan to converge with International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS") in 2012. The MFRS Framework comprises Standards as issued by the International Accounting Standards Board ("IASB") that are effective on 1 January 2012 and new/revised Standards that will be effective after 1 January 2012.

The MFRS Framework is to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private entitles for annual financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 Agriculture and IC Interpretation 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate, including its parents, significant investor and venture (herein referred as "Transitioning Entities"). The adoption of the MFRS Framework by Transitioning Entities is deferred by another year and hence, will be mandatory only for annual financial period beginning on or after 1 January 2014.

2. Auditors' Report On Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2011 was not subject to any qualification.

3. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The business operations of the Group are generally affected negatively by the monsoon seasons and the major festive seasons namely Hari Raya Aidilfitri and Chinese New Year holidays. Such occasions not only undoubtedly limit our ability to undertake certain operational activities at our end; they do also, by and large, curtail demand from our customers, who are themselves also negatively impacted by these factors.

4. Unusual Items

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows.

5. Changes In Estimates of Amounts Reported Previously

There were no changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior interim periods of the current financial year or in prior financial years which may have a material effect on the current interim period.

The Group's turnover for Q3 2012 was RM72.21 million compared to RM57.65 million for Q3 2011, up RM14.56 million or 24%. The enhancement was mainly attributed to the combined growth of RM28.20 million in the turnover recorded by three of the group's market segments. The Property Development segment was the major contributor to the growth in turnover with an increase of RM25.29 million and the balance was from the Timber Extraction and Services & Treatment segments. This improvement was partially offset by a RM13.64 million reduction in the combined turnover for two of the group's market segments viz. Timber Trading and Manufacturing.

In tandem with higher turnover, the group's pre-tax profit expanded from a pre-tax loss of RM1.54 million to a pre-tax profit of RM4.70 million, enhanced by RM6.24 million. For the three months of Q3 2011, the pre-tax profit of the Services & Treatment segment was inclusive of profits from sale of two properties to the Property Development segment and after eliminating the inter-company profit of RM12.36 million, the actual results for the segment was a pre-tax loss of RM3.56 million. Thus, the RM1.02 million registered in Q3 2012, was actually a RM4.58 million positive turnaround for our services & treatment segment. The Property Development, Timber Extraction and Others segments contributed RM2.76 million, RM0.65 million and RM0.19 million respectively. The total combined improvement of RM7.99 million in the pre-tax profit was offset by the combined losses of RM1.94 million registered by the Manufacturing and Timber Trading segments.

(b). Year to date.

The Group registered total revenue of RM209 million for the nine months ending 30 September 2012, i.e. RM36 million or 21% more than the RM173 million recorded in the previous corresponding period. The turnover recorded by three of the group's market segments viz. Timber Extraction, Services & Treatment and the new Property Development segment improved by RM62.83 million. The revenue for Property Development segment was based on additional 46% of the Gross



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Development Value for units sold. In line with improved demand for sawn timber from domestic buyers, the incoming timber for kiln drying process also increased, hence the higher turnover for Services & Treatment. As for the Timber Extraction segment, the escalation in its turnover was due to larger area logged and slight increase in logs price.

However the increase in turnover by the three abovementioned segments was partially offset by the RM26.38 million decline in turnover of our Manufacturing segment and Timber Trading segment which experienced difficulties in obtaining supply of raw materials (i.e. logs) due to the continuous raining season and lower demand from the European buyers as some nations within the E.U. continue to encounter economic difficulties.

It should be noted that of the RM62.83 million improvement recorded by the three major revenue contributing segments, RM57.05 million came from our new Property Development segment. Hence, the increase recorded by our long established Timber Extraction and Services & Treatment segments combined was only RM5.78 million for the period under review which, under prevailing economic conditions, was considered acceptable.

The Group registered a pre-tax profit of RM14.53 million for the nine months ending 30 September 2012, a significant improvement in percentage terms when compared to the pre-tax profit of RM2.99 million achieved in the preceding year corresponding period. However, had the RM6.22 million profit contributed by the new Property Development segment and RM2.25 million improvement in profit from the Timber Extraction segment not being taken into account, the picture would not be as attractive. This notwithstanding, operations for the period under review remained profitable.

The Group's turnover for Q3 2012 remained relatively unchanged from that of Q2 2012 at RM72 million. Whilst three of the group's market segments viz. Timber Trading, Services & Treatment, and Property Development recorded an increase of RM8.09 million in their combined turnover, this improvement was significantly offset by a fall of RM7.88 million in the combined turnover of the Manufacturing and Timber Extraction segments. The Timber Trading segment contributed a significant RM5.65 million increase in turnover, while the turnover of the Manufacturing segment shrunk by RM5.704 million.



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The similar level of turnover notwithstanding, the Group's pre-tax profit weakened by RM2.51 million, i.e. from RM7.21 million for second quarter 2012 to RM4.70 million. Due mainly to rising costs, most of the group's market segments recorded a pre-tax loss with the exception of the Service & Treatment and Property Development segments which registered a combined improvement in pre-tax profit of RM700 thousand.

17. Prospects for Current Financial Year

For reasons alluded to previously, group performance for the fourth quarter of year 2012 is projected to be lower than the third quarter of year 2012 as logs will be in short supply due to the onset of the monsoon season which is expected to impact negatively into the next quarter. In addition, demand is likely to be lower as overseas buyers, especially from the Euro-Zone countries, are unfortunately continuing to experience economic difficulties, some of them quite severely.
