PART A – EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FRS 134: INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENT.

1. Basis of preparation and Accounting Policies.

The Interim Financial Report of the Group is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements outlined in Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134: "Interim Financial Reporting" issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) and Paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (Bursa) Listing Requirements and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2012.

The Interim Financial Report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2012. It contains unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements and selected explanatory notes. These explanatory notes provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2012. The condensed consolidated interim financial report and notes thereon do not include all of the information requires for a full set of financial statements prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards (FRSs).

1.1. Significant Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies and method of computation adopted by the Group are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012, except for the adoption of the following new Financial Reporting Standards ("FRSs"), Amendments to FRSs and Interpretations by the Group. The significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this interim financial report are consistent with those in the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2012.

The above MFRSs, Amendments to MFRSs and Interpretations have no significant impact on the financial statements of the Group upon their initial application.

1.2. Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards.

On 19 November 2011, MASB issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS Framework") in conjunction with the MASB's plan to converge with International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS") in 2012. The MFRS Framework comprises Standards as issued by the International Accounting Standards Board ("IASB") that are effective on 1 January 2012 and new/revised Standards that will be effective after 1 January 2012.

The MFRS Framework is to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private entitles for annual financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 Agriculture and IC Interpretation 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate, including its parents, significant investor and venture (herein referred as "Transitioning Entities"). The adoption of the MFRS Framework by Transitioning Entities is deferred by another year and hence, will be mandatory only for annual financial period beginning on or after 1 January 2014.

The Group falls within the scope definition of Transitioning Entities and accordingly, will be required to prepare financial statements using the MFRS Framework in its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2014. In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Group will be required to restate the comparative financial statements to amounts reflecting the application of MFRS Framework. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, retrospectively, against opening retained earnings.

2. Auditors' Report On Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012 was not subject to any qualification.

3. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The business operations of the Group are generally affected negatively by the monsoon seasons and the major festive seasons namely Hari Raya Aidilfitri and Chinese New Year holidays. Such occasions not only undoubtedly limit our ability to undertake certain operational activities at our end; they do also, by and large, curtail demand from our customers, who are themselves also negatively impacted by these factors.

4. Unusual Items

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows.

5. Changes In Estimates of Amounts Reported Previously

There were no changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior interim periods of the current financial year or in prior financial years which may have a material effect on the current interim period.

6. Issuances and Repayments of Debt and Equity Securities

There were no issuances or repayments of debt and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellations, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares by the Company for the financial period ended 30 June 2013.

7. Dividends Paid

There were no dividends declared and paid by the Company for the financial period ended 30 June 2013.

(a). Three month period-Q2 2013 against Q2 2012.

For the three month period of Q2 2013, the Group registered a turnover of RM55.21 million as compared to RM72 million for Q2 2012, down RM16.79 million or 23%. The reduction was mainly attributed to the combined decline of RM23.66 million in the turnover recorded by all of the group's market segments except for Timber segment.

In tandem with the lower turnover, the group's pre-tax profit fell by RM3.97 million, i.e. from RM7.21 million to RM3.24 million. The major contributor to pre-tax profit was the Property Development segment which contributed RM1.20 million. The Manufacturing and Services & Treatment segments contributed RM854 thousand and RM890 thousand respectively.

(b). Year to date.

The Group registered total revenue of RM117 million for Q2 2013, RM20 million or 23% less than the RM137 million recorded in Q2 2012. Owing to the lower turnover and also to the high cost of sales and the related operational expenses, the Group posted a pre-tax profit of RM4.91 million for the current quarter against the previous corresponding quarter figure of RM9.83 million.

Timber Extraction

There was no logging activities carried out in the current quarter pending approval of logging license from the authorities.



Timber Trading

The turnover for this segment declined slightly by RM429 thousand. Demand from the Group's main market i.e. the E.U. remained low as most of the E.U. nations are still experiencing economic difficulties. Despite the lower turnover, operating cost remains unchanged, resulting in a pre-tax loss of RM25 thousand compared to a pre-tax profit of RM937 thousand for Q2 2012.

Manufacturing

The turnover for the manufacturing of timber and wood based products fell In line with lower demand from customers mainly from the E.U. nations. The manufacturing of industrial paper bags declined by RM1.52 million due to lower demand and increased competition from other manufacturers. Similar to the trading segment, operating cost (especially labor and fixed overheads) remained unchanged, hence the lower pre-profit of RM637 thousand.

Services & Treatment

The incoming timber for kiln drying services remained stable. However, shortage of labour to process the timber resulted in lower turnover, down slightly by RM154 thousand. Due to the 23% increase in average selling price which offset the 12% increase in operation cost, this segment was able to archive a higher pre-tax profit of RM1.69 million for the current quarter as compared to the RM553 thousand recorded in the previous corresponding quarter.

Property Development

The total turnover of RM19.59 million for the current quarter represents an additional 16% of the GDV for units sold as compared to RM31.76 million for the previous corresponding quarter which was 26% of the GDV. This segment has completed 95% of its current projects. In line with lower turnover, this segment posted a pre-tax profit of RM2.64 million, down by RM847 thousand or 24%.

The Group's turnover for Q2 2013 was RM55.21 million, compared to RM62.10 million for Q1 2013, down by RM6.89 million or 11%. Three of the group's market segments recorded a fall of RM9.49 million in their combined turnover. This was offset by an increase of RM2.60 million in the combined turnover for the Timber Trading and Manufacturing segments The Property Development segment recorded a significant RM7.54 million decrease in turnover as the progress in the construction has reached 95% completion.

Despite of lower turnover, the Group's pre-tax profit strengthened by RM1.53 million, i.e. from RM1.69 million for first quarter 2013 to RM3.22 million. Four of the group's market segments have shown improvement i.e. Timber Extraction segment reduced its pre-tax loss from RM61 thousand to RM44 thousand, Timber Trading and Manufacturing segments recorded a combined pre-tax profit of RM1.15 million as compared to a combined pre-tax losses of RM546 thousand and the pre-tax profit for Services & Treatment segment improved slightly by RM87 thousand. The improved profit of the four above mentioned segments was partially offset by lower combined pre-tax profit registered by the Property Development and Others segments.

17. Prospects for Current Financial Year

For reasons alluded to previously, group performance for the third quarter of year 2013 is projected to be lower than the second quarter of year 2013 as logs will be in short supply due to the onset of the monsoon season which is expected to impact negatively into the next quarter. In addition, demand is likely to be lower as overseas buyers; especially from the E.U. countries are unfortunately continuing to experience economic difficulties, some of them quite severely. As for the Property Development segment, the current project will be completing in the third quarter, hence, no profit will be contributed by this segment in the third quarter.
