PART A - EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FRS 134: INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENT.

1. Basis of preparation and Accounting Policies.

The interim financial statements are unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements outlined in Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134: "Interim Financial Reporting" and Paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (Bursa) Main Market Listing Requirements.

The Interim Financial Report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2014. It contains unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements and selected explanatory notes. These explanatory notes provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2014. The condensed consolidated interim financial report and notes thereon do not include all of the information requires for a full set of financial statements prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards (FRSs).

1.1. Significant Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies and method of computation adopted by the Group are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2014, except for the adoption of the following new Financial Reporting Standards ("FRSs"), Amendments to FRSs and Interpretations by the Group. The significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this interim financial report are consistent with those in the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2014.

1.2. Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards.

In November 2011, MASB published the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ('MFRS') Framework applicable to all non-private entities with effect from 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 'Agriculture' and IC Interpretation 15 'Agreement for the Construction of Real Estate', including their parents, significant investors and ventures' (herein referred as "Transitioning Entities"). Transitioning Entities were given an option to apply the MFRS Framework effective from 1 January 2013.

On 30 June 2012, MASB decided to allow Transitioning Entities to defer the adoption of MFRS Framework for another year. However, on 7 August 2013, MASB further extended the effective date for the adoption of MFRS Framework by Transitioning Entities to 1 January 2015. Pursuant to the MASB Notice issued on 2 September 2014 entitled 'Amendment to the effective date and applicability of the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards', entities that have in the alternative chosen to apply FRSs shall comply with MFRSs for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2017. Therefore, the Group as a Transitioning Entity will apply the MFRS Framework for the annual period beginning on 1 January 2017. As a result, the FRSs and amendments to FRS those are effective for annual period beginning on or after 1 January 2017 are not applicable to the Group.

The Group falls within the scope definition of Transitioning Entities and accordingly, will be required to prepare financial statements using the MFRS Framework in its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2017. In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Group will be required to restate the comparative financial statements to amounts reflecting the application of MFRS Framework. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, retrospectively, against opening retained earnings.

2. Auditors' Report On Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2014 was not subject to any qualification.

3. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The business operations of the Group are generally affected negatively by the monsoon seasons and the major festive seasons namely Hari Raya Aidilfitri and Chinese New Year holidays. Such occasions not only undoubtedly limit our ability to undertake certain operational activities at our end; they do also, by and large, curtail demand from our customers, who are themselves also negatively impacted by these factors.



4. Unusual Items

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows.

5. Changes In Estimates of Amounts Reported Previously

There were no changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior interim periods of the current financial year or in prior financial years which may have a material effect on the current interim period.

6. Issuances and Repayments of Debt and Equity Securities

There were no issuances or repayments of debt and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellations, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares by the Company for the financial period ended 31 March 2015.

7. Dividends Paid

There were no dividends declared and paid by the Company for the financial period ended 31 March 2015.

The Group registered total revenue of RM75.23 million for Q1 2015, an improvement of RM22.74 million or 43% from the RM52.49 million recorded in Q1 2014. All of the group's market segments recorded a comfortable growth in their turnover mainly due to better demand for timber products. In tandem with the higher turnover, the Group posted a superior pre-tax profit of RM14.87 million for the current quarter against the previous corresponding quarter figure of RM1.04 million. The major contributor to the significant improvement in turnover and pre-tax profit for the current quarter was the Timber Extraction segment, which saw its turnover and pre-tax profit increased by RM7.86 million and RM6.84 million respectively.

Timber Extraction

A total of 1,520 acres were logged in the current quarter generating a pre-tax profit of RM6.84 million compared to a pre-tax loss of RM53 thousand registered in the previous corresponding quarter.

Timber Trading

The turnover for this segment improved by RM5.36 million or 18%, mainly attributed to improved demand from the Group's main market i.e. the EU as some of its constituent countries enjoyed good recovery in their economy. Corresponding to the higher turnover coupled with well controlled operating cost, this segment disclosed a pre-tax profit of RM2.54 million compared to a pre-tax loss of RM53 thousand in the previous corresponding quarter.



Manufacturing

Total turnover for this segment grew by RM5.06 million or 30%. The turnover for the timber and wood-based products increased by RM5.16 million while the industrial paper bags division posted a small decline of RM101 thousand. This market segment posted a pre-tax profit of RM2.22 million mainly attributed to a better profit margin due to similar reasons mentioned in the proceeding segment i.e. higher average selling price and unchanged operating cost.

Services & Treatment

Whilst the volume of incoming timber for kiln drying increased by 5,101 tons, the volume of preservative treatment declined by 549 tons. Due to a slight increase in the rate for kiln drying services charged, this segment recorded a turnover of RM8.07 million, up RM1.97 million compared to RM6.09 million for the previous corresponding quarter. Accordingly, this segment was able to register a higher pre-tax profit of RM3.08 million for the current quarter compared to much lower RM675 thousand achieved for the previous corresponding quarter.

Property Development

This segment launched a new residential development project in Q3 2014; the project is located in Meru, Klang with Gross Development Value (GDV) of RM19.53million. For the current quarter, this segment recognized 12.7% GDV or RM2.48 million as turnover. It reported a low pre-tax profit of RM143 thousand, compared to a pre-tax loss of RM8 thousand previously.

The Group's turnover for the current quarter under review was RM75.23 million, which was RM10.21 million or 16% more than the RM65.02 million registered in the preceding quarter. The market segments which showed improvement have a combined growth of RM17.85 million. This improvement was, however, partially offset by the results of Manufacturing, Property Development, and Others segments which fell a total of RM7.64 million.



(Incorporated in Malaysia)

With greater turnover, the Group's pre-tax profit escalated by RM12.54 million or 540%, from a pre-tax profit of RM2.33 million for the preceding quarter to RM14.87 million for the current quarter under review. The entire group's market segments enjoyed increases in their pre-tax profit with the Timber Extraction segment being the major contributor achieving an increase of RM5.95 million.

17. Prospects for Current Financial Year

The group performance for the second quarter of year 2015 is projected to be slightly lower than the first quarter of year 2015. The group anticipates reduced logging activities in the next quarter due to stringent conditions imposed by the authorities in the issuance of logging licenses. As for the Manufacturing and Trading segments, it is anticipated that demand for timber products will continue to improve. The percentage billing for the property development project is expected to improve as the project progresses.
