PART A – EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FRS 134: INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENT.

1. Basis of preparation and Accounting Policies.

The interim financial statements are unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements outlined in Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134: "Interim Financial Reporting" and Paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (Bursa) Main Market Listing Requirements.

The Interim Financial Report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2016. It contains unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements and selected explanatory notes. These explanatory notes provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2016. The condensed consolidated interim financial report and notes thereon do not include all of the information requires for a full set of financial statements prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards (FRSs).

1.1. Significant Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies and method of computation adopted by the Group are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2016, except for the adoption of the following new Financial Reporting Standards ("FRSs"), Amendments to FRSs and Interpretations by the Group. The significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this interim financial report are consistent with those in the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2016.

The following new and amended FRSs and IC Interpretations mandatory for annual financial periods:-

The initial application of the abovementioned accounting standards, amendments and interpretations to existing standards, where applicable, are not expected to have any material impacts to the financial statements of the Group and of the Company except as follows:

FRS 9 - Financial Instruments

In November 2014, MASB issued the final version of FRS 9 Financial Instruments which reflects all phases of the financial instruments project and replaces FRS 139 Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement for classification and measurement, impairment and hedge accounting. FRS 9 is effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018, with early application permitted. Retrospective application is required, but comparative information is not compulsory. The adoption of FRS 9 will have an effect on the classification and measurement of the Group's financial assets, but no impact on the classification and measurement of the Group's financial liabilities.

1.2. Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards.

In November 2011, MASB published the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ('MFRS') Framework applicable to all non-private entities with effect from 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 'Agriculture' and IC Interpretation 15 'Agreement for the Construction of Real Estate', including their parents, significant investors and ventures' (herein referred as "Transitioning Entities").

On 8 September 2015, MASB issued a statement confirming that the effective date of MFRS 15-Revenue from Contracts with Customers will be deferred to annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018, following the press release by the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB) confirming a one-year deferral of IFRS 15. As a result, the effective date for Transitioning Entities (TEs) to apply the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRSs) will also be deferred to annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018.

The Group falls within the scope definition of Transitioning Entities (TEs) and accordingly, will be required to prepare financial statements using the MFRS Framework in its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2018. In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Group will be required to restate the comparative financial statements to amounts reflecting the application of MFRS Framework. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, retrospectively, against opening retained earnings.

2. Auditors' Report On Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2016 was not subject to any qualification.

3. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The business operations of the Group are generally affected negatively by the monsoon seasons and the major festive seasons namely Hari Raya Aidilfitri and Chinese New Year holidays. Such occasions not only undoubtedly limit our ability to undertake certain operational activities at our end; they do also, by and large, curtail demand from our customers, who are themselves also negatively impacted by these factors.

4. Unusual Items

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows.

5. Changes In Estimates of Amounts Reported Previously

There were no changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior interim periods of the current financial year or in prior financial years which may have a material effect on the current interim period.

6. Issuances and Repayments of Debt and Equity Securities

There were no issuances or repayments of debt and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellations, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares by the Company for the financial period ended 31 December 2017.

7. Dividends Paid

There were dividends declared and paid by the Company for the financial period ended 31 December 2017. Single-tier dividend of RM0.0075 per ordinary share were declared on 8 January 2018 and paid on 12 February 2018.

For the current quarter, the Group registered revenue of RM66.76 million, RM319 thousand higher than RM66.44 million for Q4 2016. This improvement was mainly attributed to the RM866 thousand increase in the turnover for Timber Extraction segment, RM3.45 million for Manufacturing segment and also the increase of RM2.27 million in the Services & Treatment segment. This was offset by the total decrease of RM6.26 million in the turnover for Timber Trading segment and Property Development segment.

The group's pre-tax profit increased by RM2.70 million, i.e. from RM1.42 million to RM4.11 million. Most of the Group's market segments recorded higher pre-tax profit. The Timber Trading, Manufacturing and Services & Treatment segments combined increase of RM1.43 million in the pre-tax profit was reduced by Timber Extraction, Property Development and Others segments which recorded total decrease of RM782 thousand in pre-tax profit.

(b) Year to date.

The Group disclosed total revenue of RM286.52 million for the twelve-month period of 2017, more than RM278.50 million for 2016. The Timber Trading, Manufacturing and Services & Treatment segments total combined increase of RM16.23 in their turnover were partially offset by the total combined decline of RM8.20 million in the turnover for the Timber Extraction, Property Development and Others segments.

In line with the increase in turnover, the group's pre-tax profit improved by RM3.34 million mainly due to the increase in pre-tax profit of RM1.51 million for Manufacturing segment, RM372 thousand for Services & Treatment and RM4.75 million for Others segment.

Timber Extraction

A smaller area of 508 acres logged was carried out in the current quarter of 2017 compared to 765 acres logged in the previous corresponding quarter. In line with smaller area logged, revenue declined by RM963 thousand and similarly, pre-tax profit also declined by RM1.66 million.

Timber Trading

The turnover for this segment improved by RM1.25 million due to improvement in demand from USA and some of the E.U. nations. The volume of export grade treated rough sawn timber improved with the slight improvement in the average selling price. In line with the higher turnover, the pre-tax profit for this segment increased by RM25 thousand from a pre-tax profit of RM4.43 million in the previous corresponding quarter to RM4.46 million for the current quarter. This was mainly due to the higher in selling price of rough sawn timber and unrealized foreign exchange gain.

Manufacturing

Total turnover for this segment grew by RM10.22 million attributed to the improvement in the turnover for the manufacturing of timber and wood-based products and industrial paper bags which increased by RM9.38 and RM838 thousand respectively. Pre-tax profit for this market segment improved by RM1.51 million or 27%; from RM5.65 million in the previous corresponding quarter to RM7.16 million for the current quarter. The improvement in pre-tax profit was mainly attributed to higher profit registered by the manufacturing of industrial paper bags which increased by RM1.07 million, the result of higher profit margin. For the manufacturing of timber and wood-based products, the profit improved very slightly, owing to the increase in operating cost resulting from the higher cost of raw material consumed and the increase in finance cost.

Services & Treatment

The volume of incoming timber for kiln drying increased and the service charges rates also increased by 3% that resulted in the improvement of RM4.76 million in the gross turnover for this market segment. In line with the improvement in turnover, the pre-tax profit for this segment increased slightly, i.e. by RM372 thousand due to the increase in operation cost especially for the chemical for preservative treatment, fuel and electricity.

Property Development

No revenue was registered for the current quarter compared to RM7.21 million previously. It reported a pre-tax loss of RM2 thousand, compared to a pre-tax profit of RM1.66 million previously.

The Group's turnover for the current quarter under review was RM66.76 million, which was RM4.01 million or 6% less than the RM70.77 million registered in the preceding quarter. The Timber Trading and Manufacturing segments recorded a lower turnover except for the Timber Extraction, Services & Treatment and others segments. The Timber Trading and Manufacturing recorded combined decline of RM5.55 million

in their turnover. The combined increase of RM1.54 million recorded by the Manufacturing, Services & Treatment and others segments partially offset this.

In line with lower turnover, the Group posted a lower pre-tax profit of RM4.11 million for the current quarter against the preceding quarter figure of RM5.70 million.

17. Prospects for Current Financial Year

The International Monetary Fund ("IMF") in their latest publication of World Economic Outlook October 2017 projected that the global upswing in economic activity is strengthening. Global growth is projected to rise 3.6 percent in 2017 and 3.7 percent in 2018. Growth is projected to rise over this year and next year in emerging market and developing economies, supported by improved external factors-a benign global financial environment and a recovery in some advanced economies. The 2017 growth pickup is broadly based, with stronger activity in the United States and Canada, the euro zone and Japan. Prospects for medium-term growth are more subdued, however, as negative output gaps shrink and demographic and weak productivity will have a negative impact on potential growth. Overall, World Economic Outlook is generally positive but modest, with some meaningful changes for specific country groups and individual countries.

In view of the above, the Group will continue its efforts to strengthen the cost control strategies to mitigate the rising cost so as to maximize the Group's profits. For the Services & Treatment segment, to deal with the increase in transportation, fuel, machinery maintenance and labor cost, the Timber Kilning Association of Selangor has issued a circular to all members and the customers that new revised kiln drying and bundling charges are effective from 1 June 2017. For the manufacturing of industrial paper bags segment, the company plan to replace some old machinery with new more efficient machinery to improve the production capacity. Meanwhile, for the Property Development segment, the company is in the final stage of preparing the submission to relevant regulatory bodies for Development Approval to develop one (1) block of sixteen (16) storey building consisting of 82 units of condominium on Lot 1698, Mukim Kapar, Daerah Klang, Selangor. The Timber Trading segment still have outstanding orders for 6,386 tons of treated rough sawn timber worth RM31 million to be fulfilled in the first quarter of 2018.

- (ii) an issuance of up to 109,851,000 warrants ("Warrants") on the basis of one (1) Warrant for every two
 (2) Subdivided Shares, after the completion of the Proposed Share Split ("Proposed Free Warrants Issue");
- (iii) a private placement of up to ten percent (10%) of the Company's enlarged issued and paid-up share capital after the Proposed Share Split and Proposed Free Warrants Issue ("Proposed Private Placement"); and
- (iv) amendments to the Company's Memorandum and Articles of Association in order to facilitate the Proposed Share Split ("Proposed Amendments").

The Company further announced that the application in relation to the Proposed Share Split as well as the additional listing application for the Proposed Free Warrants Issue and Proposed Private Placement has been submitted to Bursa Securities on 29 April 2016. On 30 May 2016, the Company announced that Bursa Securities had approved the Proposed Share Split, the Proposed Free Warrants Issue and Proposed Private Placement.

The Proposed Share Split, the Proposed Free Warrants Issue, Proposed Private Placement and Proposed Amendments were approved by the shareholders at the Extraordinary General Meeting that was convened on 12 July 2016 at Bilik Petaling, Kelab Shah Alam, Shah Alam, Selangor.

On 29 July 2016, the Company announced the completion of the Proposed Share Split and as at 5.00 pm on 29 July 2016 ("Entitlement Date"), 109,851,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each in the Company have been subdivided into 219,702,000 ordinary shares of RM0.50 each. The Subdivided Shares were listed and quoted on the Main Market of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad with effect from 9.00 a.m. on 1 August 2016.

On 8 August 2016, the Company announced the completion of Proposed Free Warrants issue and the Warrants were listed and quoted on the Main Market of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad with effect from 9.00 a.m. on 8 August 2016.

Other than the above, the Proposed Private Placement has not been completed as at 20 February 2017. On 24 November 2016, the Company announced that Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad had, vide its letter dated 24 November 2016, resolved to grant the Company an extension of time of six (6) months until 25 May 2017. The company announced on 25 May 2017, that the deadline for the Company to implement the Private Placement has lapsed and the Company does not wish to seek further extension of time for the Private Placement. No shares have been issued or placed out by the Company pursuant to the Private Placement.
