PART A - EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FRS 134: INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENT.

1. Basis of preparation and Accounting Policies.

The interim financial statements are unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements outlined in Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134: "Interim Financial Reporting" and Paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (Bursa) Main Market Listing Requirements.

The Interim Financial Report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2018. It contains unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements and selected explanatory notes. These explanatory notes provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2018. The condensed consolidated interim financial report and notes thereon do not include all of the information required for a full set of financial statements prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards (FRSs).

1.1. Significant Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies and method of computation adopted by the Group are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2018, except for the adoption of the following new Financial Reporting Standards ("FRSs"), Amendments to FRSs and Interpretations by the Group. The significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this interim financial report are consistent with those in the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2018.

The initial application of the accounting standards, amendments or interpretations are not expected to have any material financial impacts to the current period and prior period financial statements of the Group and the Company except as mentioned below:

MFRS 16 Leases

MFRS 16 replaces the guidance in MFRS 117, 'Leases', IC Interpretation 4, 'Determining Whether an Arrangement Contains a Lease', IC Interpretation 115, 'Operating Leases – Incentives' and IC Interpretation 127, 'Evaluating the Substance of Transactions Involving the Legal Form of a Lease'.

MFRS 16 introduces a single, on-balance sheet lease accounting model for lessees. A lessee recognises a right-of-use asset representing its right to use the underlying asset and a lease liability representing its obligations to make lease payments. There are recognition exemptions for short-term leases of 12 months or less and leases of low-value items. Lessor accounting remains similar to the current standard which continues to be classified as finance or operating lease.

The Directors of the Company acknowledge that the application of MFRS 16 will affect how leases are being reported and disclosed in the financial statements of the Group and of the Company. The Group and the Company is currently assessing the financial impact that may arise from the adoption of MFRS 16 on the required effective date.

2. Auditors' Report On Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2018 was not subject to any qualification.

3. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The business operations of the Group are generally affected negatively by the monsoon seasons and the major festive seasons namely Hari Raya Aidilfitri and Chinese New Year holidays. Such occasions not only undoubtedly limit our ability to undertake certain operational activities at our end; they do also, by and large, curtail demand from our customers, who are themselves also negatively impacted by these factors.

4. Unusual Items

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows.



5. Changes In Estimates of Amounts Reported Previously

There were no changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior interim periods of the current financial year or in prior financial years which may have a material effect on the current interim period.

6. Issuances and Repayments of Debt and Equity Securities

There were no issuances or repayments of debt and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellations, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares by the Company for the financial period ended 30 September 2019.

7. Dividends Paid

There were dividends declared and paid by the Company for the financial period ended 30 September 2019. Single-tier dividend of RM0.0115 per ordinary share were declared on 20 September 2019 and paid on 30 October 2019.

(a). Three months period-Q3 2019.

For the current quarter, the Group registered revenue of RM63.29 million, slightly higher than RM62.94 million for Q3 2018. This increase was mainly attributed to the RM1.16 million total combined increases in turnover for the Timber Trading, Manufacturing, Services & Treatment and Others market segments. This was partially offset by the decrease of RM804 thousand in the turnover for Timber Extraction market segment.

The group's pre-tax profit decreased by RM1.96 million, i.e. from RM4.72 million to RM2.76 million. All of the Group's market segments recorded lower pre-tax profit except for Timber Extraction segment which recorded total increase of RM49 thousand in pre-tax profit.

(b). Year to date.

The Group disclosed total revenue of RM200.01 million for the current 9 months period ended 30 September 2019, RM7.13 million or 3.4% less than the RM207.14 million recorded in the corresponding 9 months period ended 30 September 2018. This drop was mainly attributed to the combined RM9.98 million decrease in Timber Extraction, Timber Trading and Services & Treatment



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segments. This was partially offset by the total increase of RM2.86 million in the turnover for Manufacturing and Others segments.

The group's pre-tax profit decreased by RM5.53 million mainly due to the decrease in pre-tax profit of RM731 thousand for the Timber Extraction segment, RM2.70 million for the Manufacturing segment and RM1.45 million for the Services & Treatment segment.

Timber Extraction

No logging was carried out in the current 9 months period ended 30 September 2019 compared to 439 acres logged in the corresponding 9 months period ended 30 September 2018. As such, no revenue was recorded for this segment. It incurred a pre-tax profit RM58 thousand due to other income.

Timber Trading

The turnover for this segment decreased by RM8.14 million. However, the pre-tax profit for this segment increased by RM12 thousand from a pre-tax profit of RM2.47 million in the corresponding 9 months period ended 30 September 2018 to RM2.48 million for the current 9 months period ended 30 September 2019 due to gain in foreign exchange.

Manufacturing

Total turnover for this segment increased by RM2.85 million mainly attributed to the increase in the turnover for the manufacturing of industrial paper bags which increased by RM6.63 million due to higher demand from food and chemical related industries, while the turnover for manufacturing of timber and wood based products decreased by RM3.79 million. Pre-tax profit for this market segment decreased by RM2.7 million or 50%; from RM5.37 million in the corresponding 9 months period ended 30 September 2018 to RM2.67 million for the current 9 months period ended 30 September 2019. The drop in pre-tax profit was mainly attributed to lower profit registered by the manufacturing of industrial paper bags which decreased by RM945 thousand as a result of higher cost of sales, depreciation and finance cost. As for the manufacturing of timber and wood based products, profit decreased by RM1.76 million due to higher cost of sales.

Services & Treatment

The volume of timber for kiln drying increased by 15% but service charges rates decreased by 12% that resulted in a decrease of RM195 thousand in the gross turnover for this market segment. In line with the drop in turnover, the pre-tax profit for this segment decreased slightly, i.e. by RM1.45 million due to the increase in operation cost mainly relating to other factory overhead, repair and maintenance of machinery.

Property Development

There were no revenue registered for the current 9 months period ended 30 September 2019 similar to the corresponding 9 months period ended 30 September 2018. It reported a pre-tax loss of RM47 thousand due to lower other income received, compared to a pre-tax loss of RM35 thousand previously.

The Group's turnover for the current quarter under review was RM63.29 million, which was RM1.67 million or 2.7% more than the RM61.62 million registered in the preceding quarter. The Timber Trading and Services & Treatment segments recorded higher growth in their turnover except for the Manufacturing and Others segment. The Timber Trading and Manufacturing recorded combined increase of RM1.73 million in their turnover. This was offset by the combined decrease of RM54 thousand recorded by the Manufacturing and Others segments.

The Group posted a higher pre-tax profit of RM2.76 million for the current quarter against the preceding quarter figure of RM2.36 million. This RM400 thousand difference was the major contributors to the RM516 thousand increase in pre-tax profit for the current quarter was the Timber Extraction and Timber Trading segments.

17. Prospects for Current Financial Year

The International Monetary Fund ("IMF") in their latest publication of World Economic Outlook(WEO) Update October 2019 projected that global growth is forecast at 3.0 percent for 2019, its lowest level since 2008–09 and a 0.3 percentage point downgrade from the April 2019 World Economic Outlook. Growth is projected to pick up to 3.4 percent in 2020 (a 0.2 percentage point downward revision compared with April), reflecting primarily a projected improvement in economic performance in a number of emerging markets in Latin America, the Middle East, and emerging and developing Europe that are under macroeconomic strain. Yet, with uncertainty about prospects for several of these countries, a projected slowdown in China and the United States, and prominent downside risks, a much more subdued pace of global activity could well materialize.

In view of the above, the Group will continue efforts to strengthen the cost control strategies and will also enhance its operation and marketing strategies in order to achieve higher production efficiency and to maximize profit margins.
