PART A: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MFRS 134

1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

This interim financial statements of the Group have been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard (MFRS) 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2017.

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2017, except for the adoption of the MFRS framework and the following amendments and annual improvements to MFRSs and IC Interpretation for annual financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018.

Amendments to MFRS 1: Annual Improvements to MFRS Standards 2014 - 2016 Cycle

Amendments to MFRS 2: Classification and Measurement of Share-based Payment Transactions

MFRS 9: Financial Instruments

MFRS 15: Revenue from Contracts with Customers, Clarifications to MFRS 15 Amendments to MFRS 128: Annual Improvements to MFRS Standards 2014 - 2016 Cycle

Amendments to MFRS 140: Transfer to Investment Properties

IC Interpretation 22: Foreign Currency Transactions and Advance Consideration

The financial statements of the Group for the financial period ended 30 September 2018 are the first set of financial statements prepared in accordance with the MFRS framework. The date of transition to the MFRS framework was on 1 January 2017.

The Group has consistently applied the same accounting policies in its opening MFRS statement of financial position as at 1 January 2017 and throughout all comparable interim periods presented, as if these policies had always been in effect. Comparative information in these interim financial statements have been restated to give effect to these changes and the financial impact on transition from Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") to MFRS as disclosed as follows:

(a) Property, plant and equipment - deemed cost exemption

Under the FRS framework, the Group measured its freehold and leasehold land and buildings at fair value. The last valuation for these properties was carried out in 2015. Upon transition to the MFRS framework, the Group has elected to apply the optional exemption to use that previous revaluation as deemed cost under the MFRS framework. The revaluation reserve of RM187,859,059 as of 31 December 2016 and 2017 will be reclassified to retained earnings.

(b) Biological assets

Under the FRS framework, the cost of biological assets of the Group which consist of tea leaves and oil palm fresh fruit bunches are not segregated from the cost of the plantation development expenditure and the cost of the freehold land on which the tea tree and oil palm crops are planted respectively. Upon transition to the MFRS framework, the Group will segregate the costs of tea leaves and oil palm fresh fruit bunches from their bearer plants, and measure the bearer plants at cost less accumulated depreciation and accumulated impairment losses, while the tea leaves and oil palm fresh fruit bunches at their respective fair values less costs to sell.



(c) MFRS 15 Revenue from Contracts with Customers

Upon adoption of MFRS 15, the Group recognises the revenue from contracts with customers when or as the Group transfers goods or services to a customer, measured at the amount to which the Group expects to be entitled, according to the term and condition stipulated in the contracts with customers. Depending on whether certain criteria are met, revenue is recognised over time, in a manner that depicts the Group's performance; or at a point in time, when control of the goods or services is transferred to the customers.

The Group currently recognises prompt payment discounts as a reduction in sales, on an incurred basis. On application of MFRS 15, the Group estimates the expected amount of prompt payment discounts as a variable consideration in determining the transaction price of sales, irrespective of whether the discounts have been given.

The Group is entitled to reimbursements from their suppliers for certain discounts given to customers. Such reimbursements are currently recognised as a reduction in cost of goods sold as on when such claims are made. On application of MFRS 15, such claims are recognised in revenue.

8. DIVIDEND PAID

The first and final dividend of 4.5 sen per share under the single tier system for the financial year ended 31 December 2017 amounted to RM8,622,193 has been paid on 17 July 2018.

PART B: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MAIN MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

14. REVIEW OF PERFORMANCE

Current quarter vs. preceding year corresponding quarter

Despite achieving marginally increase in revenue by 1.1% in this quarter, the Group recorded a lower profit before tax of RM13.37 million as compared to RM15.81 million a year ago. All divisions except trading division achieved lower profit before tax than the preceding year. Profit contribution from associated company, SB was also lower by 15.3% to RM2.18 million.

Manufacturing division

Manufacturing division registered a lower revenue of RM58.75 million in this quarter as compared to RM75.99 million a year ago. The drop in revenue was attributable to lower sales of cooking oils, bulk oils, palm kernel and aerosol cans. The selling price of palm based products was also lower as a result of substantial drop in crude palm oil price. Correspondingly, the division's profit before tax dropped by 37.3% from RM7.61 million a year ago to RM4.77 million.

Trading division

Trading division continued to perform better with profit before tax increased by 23.4% from RM5.21 million a year ago to RM6.43 million on the back of 9.5% increase in revenue. The better performance was contributed by higher sales of energy drinks, bottled water, Campbells', Ribena, Sunplus and Kizz products offsetting the drop in sales of cooking oils. The sales of our newly launched instant noodles "Red Chef" was also encouraging in this quarter.

Plantation division

The plantation division incurred a higher loss before tax of RM0.75 million in this quarter as compared to RM0.10 million a year ago. Both the tea and oil palm plantations still incurred losses in this quarter as the tea plantation sales volume is still insufficient to cover its plantation cost while our Perak State oil palm plantations were affected by lower selling price and production of fresh fruit bunches ("FFB"). Higher expenses incurred for the new oil palm plantation in Sabah also impacted on its bottom line.

Current year to-date vs. preceding year to-date

The Group registered a marginally increase in revenue of RM838.96 million for the period ended 30 September 2018 as compared to RM834.66 million a year ago. Correspondingly, the Group's profit before tax increased by 4.3% to RM35.30 million. The better performance was mainly contributed by trading division. Profit contribution from SB was also marginally higher by 3.3% from RM5.83 million to RM6.02 million.

Manufacturing division

The manufacturing division's revenue for the current period dropped by 15.0% from RM217.50 million a year ago to RM184.92 million. The lower revenue was mainly due to decrease in selling price of palm based products as a result of substantial drop in crude palm oil price. The sales volume of palm based products was also lower than last year. Although the palm oil refinery performed much better this year with improvement in its profit margin and the palm oil mill managed to narrow down its losses through improvement in its oil extraction rate ("OER") and palm kernel recovery rate, the division's profit before tax was lower than the preceding year by 15.3% from RM15.71 million to RM13.30 million mainly due to profit margin compression faced by the aerosol can business arising from difficulty in passing on the full cost of increase to its customers.



Trading division

The trading division achieved a sales growth of 6.0% in the current period through higher sales of energy drinks, bottled water, Campbells', Munchy's, Sunplus and Kizz products offsetting the drop in sales of cooking oils. Correspondingly, the division's profit before tax increased by 43.7% from RM11.60 million to RM16.67 million.

Plantation division

The plantation division recorded a higher loss before tax of RM2.19 million in the current period as compared to RM0.96 million a year ago. Both the oil palm and tea plantations were still unable to turnaround. The higher losses was mainly due to higher expenses incurred for the new oil palm plantation in Sabah coupled with lower selling price and production of FFB achieved by our Perak State oil palm plantations. The tea plantation current sales volume is still insufficient to cover its plantation cost.

15. MATERIAL CHANGES IN THE QUARTERLY RESULTS COMPARED TO THE RESULTS OF THE PRECEDING QUARTER

The Group registered a higher revenue of RM293.95 million in this quarter as compared to RM268.25 million in the preceding quarter. The increase in revenue was driven by higher sales of beverages, cooking oils, Campbells', Sunplus and Kizz products. Correspondingly, the Group's profit before tax increased by 29.3% from RM10.34 million to RM13.37 million. With the improvement in its OER, the palm oil mill also managed to contribute to the Group's profitability in this quarter.

16. CURRENT YEAR PROSPECTS

The Board foresees that the domestic market conditions to remain challenging as consumers turned cautious and selective on their spending after the end of the Goods and Services Tax holiday and the implementation of the Sales and Service Tax effective 1 September 2018. Amid the tough market conditions coupled with intensifying competition, our trading division will continue to focus on expanding its existing brands market share leveraging on its strong distribution networks and innovative consumer trade campaigns to drive growth. Our joint venture entity, YLTC Sdn Bhd has been successfully appointed by Shell Malaysia Trading Sdn Bhd as their contractor for provision of supply chain services for Shell convenience retail outlets in Peninsular Malaysia effective 1 October 2018. This will provide us the opportunity to tap on other business segments to enhance our sales growth.

With the tightening of quality inspection on FFB supplies and selection of FFB suppliers, the palm oil mill managed to turnaround in this quarter with much better OER. The mill is also sourcing for better FFB supplies to increase its production. Judging by the positive outcome, the Board expects the performance of the mill to improve.
