B1 Review of the Performance of the Company and its Principal Subsidiaries

During the quarter under review, the Group recorded revenue of RM99.6 million, a slight increase of RM5.7 million or 6% (1Q 2009: RM93.9 million). The increase in revenue was due to the higher quantity sold resulting from more demand for steel products because of the stocking of products by customers.

Profit before taxation for the period ended 31 March 2010 increased by RM18.7 million (>100%) to RM13.3 million as compared with 1Q 2009 loss of RM5.4 million mainly due to the write back of inventories amounting to RM1.0 million as compared to a write down of RM10.1 million in 1Q 2009.

B2 Material changes in profit before taxation for the quarter reported on compared with the immediate preceding quarter

While the Group's revenue for the current quarter of RM99.6 million was a slight decrease of RM3.8 million or 4% as compared to the preceding quarter (4Q 2009 : RM103.4 million), profit before taxation of RM13.3 million was a significant increase when compared to the preceding quarter by RM5.6 million or 73% (4Q 2009 : RM7.7 million). This was because of the write back of inventories by RM1.0 million as compared to a write down of RM4.7 million for 4Q 2009.

B3 Prospects for the current financial year

Increases in iron ore prices had driven upward the regional steel prices strongly in 1Q 2010. Demand remains lacklustre and unless there is real demand improvement, pricing is expected to remain at or near current levels amidst slow recovery of steel business conditions.

On the back of business development initiatives, the Group achieved better exports sales in 1Q 2010. Export performances in the remaining 2010 are subject to the impact of economic recovery in America taking into account Europe's economic recovery as well as China's initiatives to curb rising property business conditions, thus slower growth of construction activities. However, the Group continues its commitment to achieving higher productivity and operational efficiency consistent with Group's objective of market share consolidation and increased business competitiveness.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group foresees satisfactory performance results in 2010.
