B1 Review of the Performance of the Company and its Principal Subsidiaries

The Group achieved a turnover of RM197.7 million for the year todate, a slight decrease of 1% when compared to the turnover achieved for last year of RM198.9 million. During the quarter under review, the Group recorded revenue of RM98.1 million, a decrease of RM6.9 million or 7% (2Q 2009: RM105.0 million). The decrease in revenue was largely due to the reduced quantity in metric tonne sold despite rising average selling prices.

The significant improvement in profit before taxation for year todate of RM22.8 million (2009: RM1.8 million) was mainly due to the lower write down of inventories and better profit margin. Profit before taxation for the quarter ended 30 June 2010 at RM9.5 million showed an increase of RM2.3 million or 33% (2Q 2009: RM7.2 million).

B2 Material changes in profit before taxation for the quarter reported on compared with the immediate preceding quarter

While the Group's revenue for the current quarter of RM98.1 million was a slight decrease of RM1.5 million or 2% as compared to the preceding quarter (1Q 2010: RM99.6 million), profit before taxation of RM9.5 million was a decrease when compared to the preceding quarter by RM3.8 million or 29% (1Q 2010: RM13.3 million). This was mainly because of lower margin.

B3 Prospects for the current financial year

The second quarter of 2010 witnessed the expected increase in prices of iron ore without the underlying demand due to slow recovery of steel business conditions. Business activity is dependent on the domestic economy cycle impacted by Government's successful implementation of projects.

Export performances in the remaining 2010 continued to be satisfactory but subject to increased freight charges due to reduced export vessels' trips. Nonetheless, the Group remain committed to attain high productivity and optimum operational efficiency to consolidate market share and increase business competitiveness.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group expects moderate performance results for the remaining of 2010.
