A. Selected Explanatory Notes to the Interim Financial Statements as required under FRS 134

A.1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and Paragraph 9.22 of Bursa Malaysia Securities Listing Requirements, and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 30 June 2005.

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group in this interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted for the annual financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2005.

Certain comparative figures have been reclassified to conform with current year's presentation as follows: -

 Carrying values of certain land, previously under "Land Held For Property Development", were reclassified to "Property, Plant and Equipment".

A.2. Audit report of the Company for the preceding annual financial statements

There was no qualification on the report of the auditors on the annual financial statements of the Company for the immediate preceding financial year.

A.3. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

Seasonal or cyclical factors do not have any material impact on the Group's business operations.

A.4. Exceptional and Extraordinary Items

There were no exceptional and extraordinary items for the financial period under review.

A.5. Changes in Estimates

There were no material changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior interim periods of the current financial year or changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior financial years.

A.6. Debt and Equity Securities

There were no issuance and/or repayment of debt and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellations, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares for the current financial year to date.

A.7. Dividend Paid

The first and final ordinary dividend of 10% (10 sen) gross per ordinary share, less 28% income tax (7.20 sen per share net), amounting to RM6.510million in respect of preceding financial year ended 30 June 2005, approved by the members at the Annual General Meeting of the Company held on 17 November 2005, had been paid on 2 December 2005.

The valuations of property, plant and equipment have been brought forward without any amendments from the previous annual financial statements.

B. Additional Information required by the Bursa Malaysia Securities Listing Requirements in relation to the issuance of the Interim Financial Statements

B.1. Review of Performance of the Company and its Principal Subsidiaries

Although the Group registered a 9% and 4% rise in revenue compared with the corresponding quarter and previous financial year respectively, operating profit fell by 16% and 10%; principally attributable to drop in contribution margin experienced by both Property and Manufacturing Divisions respectively in the reporting quarter. Nevertheless, comparing year-to-year results, should adjustment be made for the non-recurrent net gain of RM4.549million, arising from compulsory acquisition of development land recognized in FY2005, the pre-tax profit was in fact higher marginally by 3%.

Property Division recorded a 10% and 12% increase in progressive billings compared with the corresponding quarter and financial year respectively, however, operating profit for the same comparable periods reported contraction of 10% and 2% respectively. Again, with adjustment made for the non-recurrent gain mentioned above, pre-tax profit for Property Division actually improved by 27%; principally attributable to tight budgetary control put in place enabling Property Division to maintain its overall performance.

In spite of sales of Manufacturing Division was marginally higher by 5% compared with the corresponding period, operating profit dropped by an alarming 29%. Consequently, the results for the reporting financial year paled compared with those of the previous 12 months, with turnover and profit before taxation decreased by 8% and 42% respectively. Although there was a slight increase in sales volume, stiffer competition had seen prices reduced significantly, while unfavourable movement in exchange rates had an adverse effect on both material costs and foreign currency translation upon receipt of sales proceeds.

Share of profit from the associated company, Brilliant Delta, was lower by 25% and 15% respectively compared with those of the corresponding and immediate preceding quarters, mainly due to lagging in progress billings as a result of its housing project entering advanced stage of development cycle. However, tremendous contributions from the first three quarters had ensured that the share of profit for the whole financial year was a remarkable 73% higher compared with that of the previous 12-months, predominantly attributable to sales of additional

B.2. Material Changes in the Quarterly Results as compared with the Preceding Quarter

Revenue and profit before taxation for the Group reported an increase of 19% and 21% respectively compared with the immediate preceding quarter, mainly due to favourable cost savings for those completed housing projects. Property Division reported significant improvement of 40% and 67% in billings and operating profit respectively; whereas in contrast, both revenue and pre-tax profit for Manufacturing were lowered by 9%, due to reduced margin resulting from increased production costs.

B.3. Prospects for the Current Financial Year

With the recent report of excessive stock of completed properties remained unsold for an extensive period in most part of the country, it is an alarming wake-up call for the property sector as a whole. The prospect of interest rates maintained at current level for the foreseeable future and spiral effect on material costs poses even greater challenge for housing developers. Nonetheless, OIB Group had prepared itself well with financial strength and sound business plan for the medium term in ensuring the Group is equipped to weather the rough time ahead. Therefore, the Board and management are confident that OIB Group would once again be able to produce profitable results for the financial year ending 30 June 2007.

B.4. Variance of Actual Profit from Forecast Profit

Not applicable. The Group has not given any profit forecast nor profit guarantee in respect of any corporate proposals.

FRS 112 "Income Taxes" does not permit the recognition of deferred tax asset arising from availability of certain tax reliefs. In addition, a subsidiary company of the Group has been granted pioneer status under the Promotion on Investments Act, 1986 commencing from 1 January 2005; hence, 100% of its statutory income is tax exempt. Consequently, the effective tax rate of the Group would be lower than the statutory rate during the pioneer status period. For the reporting quarter, approximately RM1.529million of reinvestment allowances and other double deduction reliefs available were utilized, while RM0.544million of chargeable business income was exempted from Income Tax for manufacturing operations.

B.6. Profits on Sale of Investments and/or Properties

There were no disposals of investments or properties outside the ordinary course of business of the Group for the current financial year to date.

B.7. Quoted Securities

There were no purchases or disposals of quoted securities for the current financial year to date. The Group did not have any investment in quoted securities as at the end of the reporting period.
