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#### NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

#### 1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of FRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad Main Market Listing Requirement.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2010. # 14. Review of Performance of the Group

For the current quarter under review, the Group recorded revenue of RM101.4 million and pre-tax loss of RM5.6 million, as compared to revenue of RM180.0 million and pre-tax loss of RM14.6 million in the corresponding quarter.

The lower revenue recorded were attributable to lower progress billings recorded at the Construction Division as existing works achieved considerable completion progress and lower utilisation for the Manufacturing Division.

# 15. Variation of Results Against Preceding Quarter

The Group recorded revenue of RM101.4 million in the current quarter as compared to RM133.9 million in the immediate preceding quarter, representing a decrease of 24%. The decrease was mainly attributable to lower progress billings at its Construction Division.

The Group recorded a pre-tax loss of RM5.6 million as compared to a pre-tax profit of RM2.7 million in the immediate preceding quarter mainly due to the crystallisation of the Performance Bond for the "Projek Jalan Raya Simpang Pulai-Lojing-Gua Musang" of RM14.1 million by the Government of Malaysia in the current quarter. Subsequent to this, the management is currently exploring ways to recover back this bond.

#### 16. Current Year Prospects

The Group near term prospects remained challenging given the competitive landscape of the operating environment. The slower than expected roll—out of domestic infrastructure projects by the government has result in management undertaken a comprehensive review of the group overall bidding strategy. The ongoing review, however is not likely to have an immediate effect on the group performance in the near term. The Group therefore expects it performance in current year to register a gradual improvement.

# 17. Profit Forecast or Profit Guarantee

# 23. Material Litigation

MTD Construction Sdn Bhd ("MTDC") a wholly-owned subsidiary of MTD ACPI Engineering Berhad's ("MTDACPI"), had on 15 March 2011, received a judgment from the High Court in relation to its application to restrain the Government of Malaysia ("GOM") from making a demand for a retention bond amounting to RM14,100,000.00 pursuant to a Bank Guarantee ("Retention Bond") and receive payment from HSBC for the said retention bond, and to restrain HSBC from releasing the money until the final disposal of the matter ("Judgment"). The Retention Bond was demanded by the GOM on the grounds of breach of contract by MTDC in respect of the "Projek Jalan raya Simpang Pulai-Lojing-Gua Musang ke Kuala Berang, Pakej 2 (dari Pos Selim, Perak Darul Ridzuan ke Ladang Blue Valley, Kampung Raja, Cameron Highlands, Pahang Darul Makmur)". The application for the injunction was heard on 18 February 2011. The Learned Judge dismissed the application for the injunction with cost. An application for an injunction pending the hearing of the appeal was also dismissed by the Learned Judge.
