PART A: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FRS 134

A1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial statements, other than for financial instruments, have been prepared under the historical cost convention. Financial instruments have been fair valued in accordance to FRS 139 Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement.

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of FRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Main market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2011. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2011.

A2. Significant accounting policies

The significant accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2011, except for the adoption of the following new Financial Reporting Standards (FRSs), Amendments to FRSs and IC Interpretations which are applicable for the Group's financial period beginning 1 January 2012.

A2. Significant accounting policies (cont'd)

b) New Malaysian Financial Reporting Framework

On 19 November 2011, the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS Framework).

The MFRS Framework is to be applied by all Entities Other than Private Entities for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of the entities that are within the scope of MFRS141 Agriculture (MFRS 141) and IC Interpretation 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate (IC 15), including its parent, significant investor and venturer (Transitioning Entities). The adoption of MFRS Framework for Transitioning Entities will be allowed to defer for an additional one year and will only be mandatory for adoption for annual period beginning on or after 1 January 2014.

The Group falls within the scope definition of Transitioning Entities and accordingly, will be required to prepare financial statements using the MFRS Framework in its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2014.

The Group is currently assessing the implications and financial impact of the MFRS Framework.

A3. Auditors' Report on Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The Group's latest audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2011 were not subject to any qualification.

A4. Comments about seasonal or cyclical factors

The Group's performance is not affected by any seasonal or cyclical factors.

A5. Unusual items due to their nature, size or incidence

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows during the financial period.

A6. Debt and equity securities

There were no issuances, cancellation, repurchases, resales and repayments of debt and equity securities for the financial period ended 30 June 2012 except for the followings:

a) Full redemption and cancellation of Al-Bai Bithaman Ajil Notes ("ABBA Notes")

The ABBA Notes were issued by a subsidiary company, ESSB, to finance the planning, design construction and completion costs of 10,000 units of teachers' quarters for the Government of Malaysia. All ABBA Notes are secured by the assignment of the contract Concession Payments and the Project Escrow Account, and a negative pledge on all assets of ESSB. ESSB is a special purpose vehicle and these ABBA notes raised do not have any financial recourse to the Group. The ABBA notes have been fully redeemed for cancellation with the proceeds from the issuance of Sukuk Murabahah.

A6. Debt and equity securities (contd.)

b) Issuance of Sukuk Murabahah

Encorp Systembilt Sdn Bhd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Encorp Berhad, has on 18 May 2012, issued Sukuk Murabahah with a total nominal value of RM1,575 million to refinance all of the amount outstanding under ABBA Notes and to fund the Trustee' Reimbursement Account. The balance of the proceeds has been utilised for ESSB's general corporate purposes which shall include payments to defray expenses incurred in relation to the issuance of Sukuk Murabahah and a one-time dividend payment to its holding company, Encorp Construction & Infrastructure Sdn Bhd ("ECISB"). ECISB has flowed this amount up to Encorp Berhad in the form of dividends and repayment of inter-company loan. Encorp Berhad intends to utilise the amount received from ECISB for capital expenditure and/or working capital requirements for the current projects and/or future investments to be undertaken by Encorp and its subsidiaries .

The Sukuk Murabahah is secured by assignment of the contract Concession Payments and the Project Escrow Account, and a negative pledge on all assets of ESSB. ESSB is a special purpose vehicle and these Sukuk Murabahah raised do not have any financial recourse to the Group.

The principal redemption of the first tranche of the Sukuk Murabahah is in May 2013. The profit of the Sukuk Murabahah is payable half yearly.

c) Treasury shares

As at the date of this report, the total number of treasury shares held was 5,386,000.

A7. Dividend paid

The Board of Directors has on 23 May 2012, declared an interim single-tier dividend of 2 sen per ordinary share in respect of the financial year ending 31 December 2012. The dividend was paid on 4 July 2012 to the shareholders whose names appear in the Register of Members and Record of Depositors on 20 June 2012.

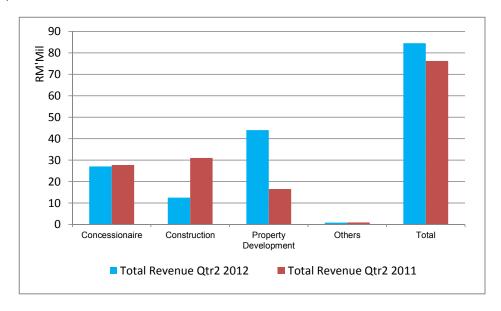
PART B: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MAIN MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA

B1. Performance review

a) Performance of the current quarter against the preceding year corresponding quarter (2Q12 vs. 2Q11).

The Group's revenue for the quarter ended 30 June 2012 (2Q12) increased by RM8.28 million to RM84.54 million as compared to RM76.26 in preceding year corresponding quarter ended 30 June 2011 (2Q11). The increase in turnover was mainly due to higher progressive recognition of development projects by the Property Division.

In line with the above, the Group recorded a profit before tax ("PBT") of RM3.63 million in 2Q12 as compared to RM0.48 million for 2Q11.



Property

Revenue for property development division increased by 166% to RM44.01 million in 2Q12 from RM16.53 million recorded in 2Q11. The PBT for the division increased from RM1.91 million to RM15.99 million recorded in 2Q12. The improvement is attributable to higher progressive recognition of all development projects and the cost saving of projects from the cost rationalisation exercise carried out by the management.

B1. Performance review (Cont'd)

a) Performance of the current quarter against the preceding year corresponding quarter (2Q12 vs. 2Q11) - (Cont'd)

Construction

Revenue for construction division decreased by 60% to RM12.54 million in 2Q12 from RM31 million recorded in 2Q11. This is mainly due to the completion of Sarawak School projects in 2011 and the on going project of double track is approaching completion of which the revenue is lower. Despite the reduction in revenue, the division recorded a profit before tax of RM0.86 million in 2Q12 as compared to loss of RM0.91 million recorded in 2Q11. The improvement is mainly due to the cost savings arising from cost rationalisation exercises.

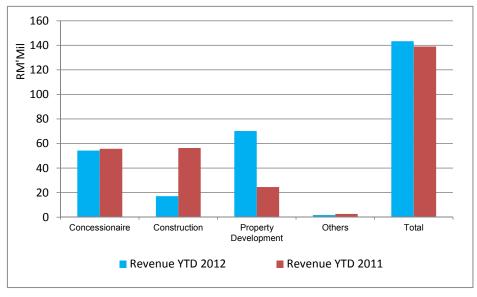
Concession

The concession division continue to provide constant stream of revenue of RM27.06 million in 2Q12 as compared to RM27.74 million in 2Q11. However, the segment has shown a loss of RM2.40 million in the current quarter as compared to a profit before tax of RM1.77 million mainly due to higher administrative and finance cost incurred for the issuance of Sukuk Murabahah and receivable written off.

b) Performance of the current financial period against the preceding year corresponding period (1H12 vs. 1H11).

For the current financial period, the Group recorded a marginal increase in revenue of RM143.32 million against RM139.07 million in the preceding year corresponding period. The increase was mainly due to higher workdone achieved by the Property Division. However the increase is offset by the reduction in Construction Division

In line with the above, the Group recorded a profit before tax ("PBT") of RM5.77 million in 1H12 as compared to RM0.13 million for 1HQ11.

B1. Performance review

b) Performance of the current financial period against the preceding year corresponding period (1H12 vs. 1H11) - (Cont'd)

Property

The division posted a substantial increase in revenue and profit before tax from RM24.57 million and RM1.31 million in the preceding year corresponding period to RM70.22 and RM21.64 million in the current period respectively. The improved performance is derived from new sales and higher progress of works in the current period and the cost saving of projects from the cost rationalisation exercise carried out by the management.

Construction

The decrease in revenue from RM56.30 million recorded in 1H11 to RM17.04 million in 1H12 is mainly due to the completion of Sarawak School projects in the preceding year corresponding period and the on going project of double track is approaching completion. Despite of the lower revenue, the division recorded a profit before tax of RM0.15 million in 1H12 as compared to RM0.67 million recorded in 1H11.

Concession

The concession division continue to provide constant stream of revenue of RM54.30 million in 6M12 as compared to RM55.64 million in 6M11. Meanwhile the profit before tax has decreased from RM7.76 million in 1H11 to RM1.66 million in 1H12 is mainly due to higher adminstrative and finance cost incurred for the issuance of Sukuk Murabahah and receivable written off.

B2. Comparison with Immediate Preceding Quarter

The Group recorded an increase in revenue by 44% to RM84.54 million as compared to RM58.79 million registered in the preceding quarter. The Group's PBT increased by RM1.48 million or 69% to RM3.63 million in 2Q12 as compared to the PBT of RM2.14 million in the immediate preceding quarter. The higher profit in current quarter was in line with the higher revenue at Property Division with higher margin.

B3. Commentary on prospects

The unstable global economic outlook due to the financial crisis in the Eurozone and the economic slowdown in most of the major economies as well as the tightening of lending conditions arising from new rules by Bank Negara. In line with the above, the Group expects to have moderate performance for the financial year from its on-going residential and commercial property development projects and construction projects.

The Group has implemented various measures to increase operational efficiencies and to look at innovative concepts to enhance its development and construction projects.

Upon the completion of the Proposed ESSB Sukuk Murabahah Issue as disclosed in Note B8, the Group generated net cash proceeds of RM93 million for the purpose of working capital of the Group. However, the issuance of the said Sukuk has resulted in additional finance cost and one-off issuance related expenses of RM6.7 million for the current quarter ended 30 June 2012. The impact for financial year ending 31 December 2012 is expected to be approximately RM16.9 million.

ESSB has mandated CIMB Investment bank Berhad, Hong Leong Investment Bank Berhad and Kenanga Investment Bank Berhad as the Joint Principal Advisers and Joint Lead Managers in respect of the Proposed ESSB Sukuk Murabahah Issue. RAM Rating Services Berhad has assigned a long-term preliminary rating of AA2 with a stable outlook to the Proposed ESSB Sukuk Murabahah Issue.

On 18 May 2012, the Company announced that the ESSB Sukuk Murabahah Issue has been completed with the issuance of RM1,575 million in nominal value of the Sukuk Murabahah.

At the same time, the Subsidiary is pursuing its counter claim against the Contractor. The hearing for the arbitration proceeding is completed. The parties are awaiting for the Arbitrator to deliver its decision.
