PART A: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FRS 134

1 Accounting Policies and Method of Computation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 134 Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2010.

The same accounting policies and methods of computation are followed in the interim financial statements as compared with the annual audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2010 except for the adoption of the following new/revised Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") effective for the financial year beginning 1 July 2010:

Consequential amendments were also made to various FRSs as a result of these new/revised FRSs.

Except for FRS 7, 101, 123, 127, 132, and 139, the others FRSs and IC Interpretations are not expected to be relevant to the operations of the Group. The adoption of these standards and interpretations will have no material impact on the financial statements of the Group in the period of initial application except for the following:

FRS 101 Presentation of Financial Statements (Revised in 2009)

FRS 101 introduces terminology changes (including revised titles for the financial statements) and changes in the format and content of the financial statements. In addition, the revised Standard requires the presentation of a third statement of financial position in the event that the entity has applied new accounting policies retrospectively. There is no impact on the Group's financial statements as this change in accounting policy affects only the presentation of the Group's financial statements.

FRS 139 Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement

The new standard establishes principles for recognising and measuring financial assets, financial liabilities and certain contracts to buy and sell non-financial items.

FRS 139 establishes principles for recognition and measuring of the Group's financial instruments. Financial instruments are recorded initially at fair value. Subsequent measurement of the financial instruments in the statement of financial position reflects the designation of the financial instruments. The effects arising from the adoption of this Standard has been accounted for by adjusting the opening balance of retained earnings as at 1 July 2010. The details of the changes in accounting policies and the effects arising from the adoption of FRS 139 are discussed below:

Financial assets

Financial assets are classified as financial assets at fair value through profit or loss, loans and receivables, held to maturity investments, available-for-sale (AFS) financial assets, or as derivatives designated as hedging instruments in an effective hedge, as appropriate.

The Group's financial assets include loans and receivables and AFS financial assets.

Non-current receivables, previously measured at invoiced amount and subject to impairment, are now classified as loans and receivables and measured at fair value plus transaction costs initially and subsequently, at amortised cost using the effective interest method.

When loans and receivables are impaired, the carrying amount of the asset is reduced and the amount of the loss is recognised in profit or loss. Impairment loss is measured as the difference between the asset's carrying amount and the present value of estimated future cash flows (excluding future credit losses that have not been incurred) discounted at the asset's original effective interest rate.

If, in a subsequent period, the amount of the impairment loss decreases and the decrease can be related objectively to an event occurring after the impairment was recognised (such as an improvement in the debtor's credit rating), the reversal of the previously recognised impairment loss is recognised in profit or loss.

Prior to 1 July 2010, AFS financial assets such as investments were accounted for at cost adjusted for amortisation of premium and accretion of discount less impairment or at the lower of cost and market value, determined on an aggregate basis. Under FRS 139, AFS financial asset is measured at fair value initially. Subsequent gains and losses arising from changes in fair value are recognised in other comprehensive income with the exception of impairment losses. When the investment is disposed off or is determined to be impaired, the cumulative gain or loss previously recognised in other comprehensive income and accumulated in the AFS reserve is reclassified to profit or loss.

Financial liabilities

Financial liabilities are classified as financial liabilities at fair value through profit or loss, loans and borrowings, or as derivatives designated as hedging instruments in an effective hedge, as appropriate.

The Group's financial liabilities include trade and other payables and loans and borrowings.

Impact on opening balances

In accordance with the transitional provisions for the first time adoption of FRS 139, the above changes are applied prospectively and the comparatives as at 30 June 2010 are not restated. Instead the changes have been accounted for by restating the opening balances as at 1 July 2010 in the consolidated statement of financial position. The effect of changes in the consolidated statement of financial position is as follows:

9 Revaluation of Property, Plant and Equipment and Investment Properties

The investment properties of the Group were revalued by an independent qualified valuer in December 2010 and the revaluation surplus of RM5.1 million is recognized as fair value gain on investment properties in the income statement. The revaluation of property, plant and equipment transferred to investment properties during the year with revaluation surplus of RM2.1 million is recognized as revaluation reserve in the statement of changes in equity in accordance with FRS 116.

Saved as disclosed above, the valuation of property, plant and equipment has been brought forward without any amendments from the annual financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2010.

10. Material Events Subsequent to the end of the Reporting Period

There were no material events subsequent to the current quarter ended 30 June 2011 up to the date of this report, which is likely to substantially affect the results of the operations of the Group.

11 Changes in the Composition of the Group

There were no material changes in the composition of the Group arising from business combinations, acquisition or disposal of subsidiary companies and long-term investments, restructurings and discontinued operations for the Group for the quarter under review

12 Contingent Liabilities

As at this reporting date, the Group does not have any contingent liabilities, other than:-

a) Legal claim of RM841,000 filed by a third party against a subsidiary company for alleged damages to a third party's building during the construction project.

PART B: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE MAIN MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

1 Review of Performance

The Group's revenue improved by 33.3% to RM462.4 million for the current financial year as compared to RM346.9 million reported in the previous financial year while pre-tax profit jumped 173.7% to RM98.0 million for the current financial year from RM35.8 million in the previous financial year. Revenue from property development division improved as compared to the previous financial year resulting from higher revenue recognition from advanced stages of construction of on-going projects and new projects launched during the year with good take up rates. Total revenue from construction and project management division also improved as compared to the previous financial year due to commencement of two new external contracts during the year. The improved Group's earnings was largely due to contributions from the Group's property division which achieved higher sales and better margins from its development projects and continuous cost savings and re-engineering exercise carried by the Group. The Group also recognized its full year share of results in Austin Heights Sdn Bhd, an associated company, amounting to RM4.1 million in the current financial year while share of losses in Inai Berkat Sdn Bhd ("IBSB"), an associated company acquired in August 2010, was RM3.6 million arising mainly from the effects of FRS 139 adopted by IBSB. The profit after tax jumped 228.1% to RM72.5 million for the current financial year from RM22.1 million in the previous financial year.

The Group's revenue improved by 95.2% to RM167.9 million for the current quarter as compared to RM86.0 million reported in the previous corresponding quarter while the Group achieved a pretax profit of RM33.3 million for the current quarter as compared to a pre-tax profit of RM10.5 million reported in the previous corresponding quarter. Revenue from property development division improved as compared to the previous corresponding quarter resulting from higher revenue recognition from advanced stages of construction of on-going and new projects launched during the year with good take up rates while total revenue from construction and project management division also improved as compared to the previous corresponding quarter due to recognition of income from commencement of two new external contracts during the year. The higher pre-tax profit achieved for the current quarter was mainly attributed to higher billings from property development division coupled with higher margins from its commercial projects. The cost savings arising from the continuous re-engineering exercise carried out by the Group also contributed to the improved margins of the Group.

2 Material Changes in the Quarterly Results Compared to the Results of the Preceding Quarter

Group revenue increased to RM167.9 million for the current quarter as compared to RM116.4 million for the immediate preceding quarter. The increase was mainly attributed to higher billings from property and construction and project management divisions. The Group recorded a pre-tax profit of RM33.3 million for the current quarter as compared to the pre-tax profit of RM38.6 million for the immediate preceding quarter. The lower pre-tax profit for the current quarter was mainly due to cost savings from re-engineering exercise which was substantially realised in the last quarter.

3 Prospects for the Financial Year Ending 30 June 2012

The outlook of the property market remains positive as can be seen from good take up rates for its launched projects. The on-going development projects of the Group namely, Amaya Maluri, V Square, Bukit Rimau Shops and The Grove together with on-going construction and project management contracts are expected to contribute positively to the earnings of the Group for the

financial year ending 30 June 2012. With the completion of the Company's Rights Issue of RM139,341,169 nominal value 7-year 6% Redeemable Convertible Secured Loan Stocks in early July 2011, the Group is expected to save interest costs arising from retirement of borrowings with higher interest rates and enhance its earnings through acquisitions of new lands in strategic growth areas such as Klang Valley, Penang and Johor for future development.
