A. EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - MFRS 134

A1 Basis of Preparation and Accounting Policies

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements as set out in Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") No. 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

There was no material change in revenue of RM11.2 million for the current quarter as compared to RM11.4 million for the preceding year corresponding quarter. The marginally lower profit before taxation of RM2.2 million for the current quarter as compared to RM2.4 million for the preceding year corresponding quarter was mainly due to higher administrative expenses and selling & distribution costs.

For the current 9-month period todate, the Group registered revenue of RM33.1 million and profit before taxation of RM6.6 million as compared to revenue of RM25.0 million and profit before taxation of RM1.5 million respectively for the preceding year corresponding period todate. The higher revenue and improved result for the period to date were mainly attributable to higher sales volume as well as higher average selling prices for the Group's brick products. The higher average selling prices had resulted in improved margin for the Group.

The lower profit before taxation for the preceding year period to date was also partly due to the significant loss of sales as a result of the shutdown of the production plant for major repair in the second quarter of the period. The shutdown of the production plant had also resulted in certain fixed costs being consequently unabsorbed.

There was no material change in profit before taxation of RM2.2 million for the current quarter as compared to RM2.1 million for the immediate preceding quarter under review.

B3 Commentary on Prospects

Amid the robust performance of the economy, sentiment in the Malaysian residential property market continued to show resilience. The Group is hopeful that the uptick in housing project construction activities continue to support increasing demand for clay bricks and sustain healthy selling prices. On the costs side, the recent implementation of the targeted diesel subsidy in Peninsular Malaysia as well as the inclusion of the logistics services in the Sales and Service Tax (SST) regime have brought the impact of elevating our operational costs that would adversely affect the Group's bottom line. The imminent increase in minimum wage from RM1,500 to RM1,700 from February 2025 as announced during the Budget 2025 will bring further pressures on the margins of the Group's products in the coming financial year.

Given the aforementioned scenario, the Group will continue to focus on its strategy and effort to contain the production costs, optimise its operational efficiency and product quality in order to stay competitive in the industry.
