#### 1 Basis of Preparation

#### 16 Review of Performance

For the second quarter 2010, the Group's revenue improved by 24% to RM45.4 million as compared to RM36.7 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter. However, the Group's profit before tax only improved marginally to RM2.8 million as compared to RM2.7 million and this was mainly attributable to the higher paper material cost.

For the financial period ended 30 June 2010, the Group's revenue improved by 22% to RM84.5 million as compared to RM69.2 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding period. The Group's profit before tax was lower by RM1.8 million at RM3.3 million compared to RM5.2 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding period. The decrease in profit before tax was mainly attributable to the higher paper material cost and currency exchange losses incurred from the devaluation of the Vietnam Dong and strengthening of the Ringgit Malaysia.

# 17 Comparison with Immediate Preceding Quarter.

For the quarter ended 30 June 2010, the Group's revenue inproved by 16% to RM45.4 million as compared to RM39.1 million registered in the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 March 2010. The Group registered higher profit before taxation of RM2.2 million to RM2.8 million as compared to RM0.6 million in the immediate preceding quarter. The increase in profit before tax was mainly attributable to the higher revenue and the lower currency exchange losses.

#### 18 Current Year Prospects

The Board expects the performance of the Group for Year 2010 to be affected by the higher material cost and volatility of the Vietnam Dong.
