8. Operating Segment Information

As in prior financial year, the Group operates solely in the direct selling industry and distribution of its products in Malaysia and Brunei. The results and total assets of the subsidiary in Negara Brunei Darussalam are insignificant to the Group. Accordingly, information on geographical and business segments of the Group's operations is not presented with the adoption of MFRS 8.

9. Events after the Interim Period

There was no material event subsequent to the current and financial period ended 30 June 2013 up to the date of this report.

B. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD MAIN MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENTS

1. Performance Review

The Group's sales revenue increased by 3.5% for the quarter ended 30 June 2013 and 8.5% for the six months ended 30 June 2013 as compared to the corresponding periods in the preceding year. The growth in sales revenue for the quarter was due to improved distributor productivity supported by sales and marketing programs. Growth for the six month period was attributable to purchases in advance of price increases effective 1 February 2013 and 1 April 2013, as well as the positive impact of the sales and marketing programs implemented during the period.

The Group's profit before tax decreased by 6.2% for the quarter ended 30 June 2013 and was flat for the six months ended 30 June 2013 as compared to the corresponding periods in the preceding year, mainly due to an increase in sales and marketing expenses.

2. Comparison with Preceding Quarter's Results

The Group's sales revenue decreased by 4.2% for the quarter under review as compared to the preceding quarter, in which distributor productivity had been driven by accelerated purchasing in advance of February and April price increases.

The Group's profit before tax increased by 3.0% as compared to the preceding quarter, due to decreased sales and marketing program expenses.

3. Commentary on Prospects for the Current Financial Year

Based on the year to date performance, the Group maintains its target of low single digit growth in sales revenue for the year.

The Board of Directors is of the opinion that this internal target is achievable based on current market conditions and currently available information. The target will be reviewed periodically by the Board of Directors and any subsequent changes will be conveyed to the market in accordance with Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad Main Market Listing Requirements.

The above is an internal management target and is not an estimate, forecast or projection. In addition, this internal target has not been reviewed by our external auditors.

4. Profit Forecast or Profit Guarantee

There was no profit forecast or profit guarantee issued by the Group.
