# NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS 31 JANUARY 2010

#### 1 BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements outlined in the Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 –"Interim Financial Reporting" issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and Paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (Bursa Securities Berhad ("Bursa") Listing Requirements. The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual audited financial statements for the year ended 30 April 2009. #### 15 SIGNIFICANT RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

#### 16 REVIEW OF PERFORMANCE

For the period ended 31 January 2010, the Group recorded a lower revenue of RM118.571 million (31 January 2009 – RM134.006 million) but with a higher pre-tax profit of RM25.681 million (31 January 2009 – RM16.223 million).

Despite the decrease in revenue, the Group's pre-tax profit increased by RM9.458 million, due to lower raw material cost and higher gains on disposal of quoted shares.

# 17 MATERIAL CHANGE IN THE PROFIT BEFORE TAX FOR THE CURRENT QUARTER AS COMPARED TO THE IMMEDIATE PRECEDING QUARTER

For the quarter ended 31 January 2010, the Group recorded a revenue of RM42.307 million, an increase of RM5.194 million compared to that of the preceding quarter of RM37.113 million, while the pre-tax profit was RM8.602 million, an increase of RM0.436 million, compared to RM8.166 million for the preceding quarter. The higher pre-tax profit was due mainly to the increase in revenue and lower operating costs.

#### **18 CURRENT YEAR PROSPECTS**

Although the global economy has shown signs of recovery, the Group's operating environment is expected to remain challenging and competitive. Nevertheless, the Board anticipates the performance of the Group to remain profitable. The Group will strive to ensure that it continues to achieve satisfactory results by implementing prudent measures, improving operational efficiency while remaining focused on product and service quality.
