On 4th July 2011, the Group, through Lipo Corporation Berhad, incorporated a wholly-owned subsidiary Univex Metal Tech. Co. Ltd., in China.

On 20^{th} July 2011, Kobay SCM (S) Pte. Ltd. ("KSS"), a 60% owned subsidiary of Kobay, acquired additional 40% equity interest in United Manufacturing Corporation Pte. Ltd. ("UMC") from an individual for a cash consideration of SGD4,000. Upon the acquisition, UMC has become a 100% owned subsidiary of KSS.

Polytool Automation Sdn. Bhd., a 85% owned subsidiary of Kobay, was voluntary wound up by the members on 9^{th} September 2011.

Paradigm Precision Components (Thailand) Ltd., a 100% owned subsidiary of Lipo Corporation Berhad, had been dissolved on 11th July 2011.

On 19^{th} September 2011, Kobay had acquired the remaining 40% equity interest in LD Global Sdn Bhd ("LD Global") from two individuals for a cash consideration of RM1/= each respectively. Upon the acquisition, LD Global has become a 100% owned subsidiary of Kobay. On the same date, Kobay had disposed off its entire 50% equity interest in L Dessert (\$) Pte. Ltd. for cash consideration of SGD1/=.

Save for the above, there were no changes in composition of the Group for current quarter.

B. Additional information required by the Listing Requirements of Bursa Securities

1. Review of performance

The Group recorded a revenue of RM23.59 million and profit before tax of RM1.97 million for the current quarter as compared to previous year corresponding quarter of RM30.47 million and RM4.35 million respectively. Revenue dropped by 22% mainly affected by lower sales reported by precision tooling and automation division and the disposal of a subsidiary on second quarter of FYE2011.

The Group's profit before tax dropped significantly by 55% due to lower sales reported by precision tooling and automation division and also low margin product mix for precision metal components division.

2 Comparison with preceding quarter's results

The Group reported revenue of RM23.59 million and profit before tax of RM1.97 million for the quarter as compared to last quarter's revenue of RM28.35 million and loss before tax of RM0.18 million.

Although profit before tax shown a positive results as compared to preceding quarter, the overall performance for the Group was unsatisfactory due to the adverse performance of Precision Tooling and Automation Division. Moreover, the loss reported for preceding quarter was due to allowance for non-performing loan receivable and inventories written down totaling RM2.75 million.

Commentary on the prospects of the Group

The Board anticipates that the Group's performance will be affected by the negative impact of the global economic downturn. The Group will implement prudent spending and a more aggressive business plan to address the under-performed automation and metal fabrication division.

4. Variance on forecast profit/profit guarantee

No profit forecast or profit guarantee was issued during the period.
