NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

A1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 134 (formerly known as MASB 26): Interim Financial Reporting and Paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Malaysia") and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 March 2009.

These explanatory notes provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 March 2009.

B1 Review of performance

The Group recorded a turnover of RM85.4 million for the quarter ended 31 December 2009 compared to RM39.9 million for the corresponding quarter of the previous financial year. The loss before taxation for the current quarter was RM0.4 million compared to a loss before tax of RM0.1 million for the corresponding quarter of the previous financial year.

The turnover of the current quarter under review is higher compared to the corresponding quarter of the previous financial year principally due to a significantly higher contribution from the Singapore subsidiary with an increased level of activity. The loss before taxation in the current quarter reflects a lower margin on contracts together with significantly higher operating costs largely offset by the improved contribution from an associated company.

B2 Material changes in the quarterly results compared to the results of the immediately preceding quarter

The Group recorded a turnover of RM85.4 million and a loss before taxation of RM0.4 million for the current quarter compared to a turnover of RM104.9 million and profit before taxation of RM0.2 million for the immediately preceding quarter.

The lower level of activity for the current quarter compared to the immediately preceding quarter reflects the financial closure of completed projects in the immediately preceding quarter. Lower other operating income, higher operating expenses and higher finance costs for the current quarter offset by the improved contribution from an associated company contributed to the loss before taxation compared to the profit before taxation for the immediately preceding quarter.

B3 Prospects

The management will continue to focus their efforts on securing new profitable projects domestically as well as from the Asean region. The market conditions are expected to be competitive and challenging as the economies in the region are still recovering from the financial turbulence and economic recession. The Group has recently secured a number of projects in Singapore and these projects will be completed over the next two years. For the current financial year ending 31 March 2010, the Group's profit will be impacted by delays in the award of projects in Malaysia. The Group is hopeful that these projects will be able to commence soon.

B11 Material Litigation

Save as disclosed below, there have been no changes in material litigation since the last audited financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2009. In the following cases, all of which have been previously reported, the case management has progressed as follows:-

a) In the action brought against one of the Company's subsidiaries, Kejuruteraan Bintai Kindenko Sdn Bhd, ("KBK"), by Malayan Banking Berhad ("MBB") as the fourth defendant of the suit for an amount of RM19,108,051.18, the matter has been fixed for case management on 10 March 2010. KBK remains confident that no liability will arise in respect of this suit.

In the action brought against KBK by Asie in relation to two maintenance bonds amounting to RM2.5 million, summary judgment has been granted but KBK has filed an appeal to the Court of Appeal, for which the hearing has not yet been fixed. KBK has a counterclaim against Asie and this has been fixed for case management on 29 July 2010. Trial will only be fixed after the parties have complied with all the case management directions.

B11 Material Litigation (Cont'd)

- b) In respect of a petition served on KBK by the five founder shareholders of Lereno Sdn Bhd ("LSB"), which alleges that KBK has, inter alia, acted unlawfully and has sought with others to take over LSB, but in respect of which the claim has not been quantified, the petition is fixed for case management on 31 March 2010.
- c) On 26 November 2009 the Company announced that summary judgment had been ordered to be entered against KBK in respect of two Kuala Lumpur High Court Civil Suits, amounting in aggregate to RM7.9 million, which had been brought by Ishi Power Sdn Bhd, a sub-contractor in respect of a contract. The case has now been resolved.

No interim dividend is being declared for the quarter under review (FY2009: Nil).
