1 Basis of Preparation

The interim financial report has been prepared in accordance with the applicable disclosure provisions of the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard (MFRS) 134, *Interim Financial Reporting*, issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements as at and for the year ended 31 December 2014 which were prepared in compliance with MFRS. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statement provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2014.

14 Review of performance

The Group's total revenue for the quarter under review increased by 30% or RM37.6 million to RM164.2 million as compared to RM126.6 million in the corresponding period of the preceding year. The Group reported a pretax loss of RM8.05 million as compared to pretax profit of RM0.17 million reported in the corresponding period of the previous year. The increase in revenue was due to improved demand to the Group's products before the implementation of GST on 1 April 2015. The losses in the current quarter was mainly due to depressed selling price since last year.

15 Variation of results against preceding quarter

For the quarter under review, the Group recorded a pretax loss of RM8.05 million as compared to pretax loss of RM17.8 million reported in the previous quarter. The losses reduced due to slightly improved sales margin on key products.

16 Prospects for the financial year ending 31 December 2015

(a) The Steel market conditions remain challenging and competitive. The Group continue to work on various trade measures with the relevant authorities to reduce cheap imports. We expect the situation will only improve in the later part of the year.
