1 Basis of Preparation

The interim financial report has been prepared in accordance with the applicable disclosure provisions of the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard (MFRS) 134, *Interim Financial Reporting*, issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements as at and for the year ended 31 December 2014 which were prepared in compliance with MFRS. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statement provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2014.

2 Changes in Accounting Framework

During the financial period, the Group recognized derivative gain of RM 8.05 million arising from the fair valuation of forward foreign exchange contracts, and unrealized loss of RM7.63 million on foreign currency payables.

The derivative gain has been included in other income, whereas the unrealized forex loss was included in the administrative expenses.

Save as disclosed above, there were no items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cash flows that are unusual because of their nature, size and incidence.

Nature and amount of changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior interim periods of the current financial year, which give a material effect in the current interim period

There were no changes in estimates that have had material effect in the current quarter's results.

14 Review of performance

The Group's total revenue for the quarter under review decreased by 17% or RM21.9 million to RM110.2 million as compared to RM132.1 million in the corresponding period of the preceding year. The Group reported a pretax loss of RM4.5 million as compared to pretax loss of RM10.2 million reported in the corresponding period of the previous year. The decrease in revenue was due to weaker market and lower demand of the Group's products. The losses in the current quarter was mainly due to depressed selling price since last year.

15 Variation of results against preceding quarter

For the quarter under review, the Group recorded a pretax loss of RM4.5 million as compared to pretax loss of RM2.4 million reported in the previous quarter. The increased

in losses was due to depreciation of ringgit against the US Dollars which resulted in a higher cost of raw materials incurred in the quarter under review.

16 Prospects for the financial year ending 31 December 2015

- (a) The Steel market conditions remain challenging and competitive with the weakening of ringgit. This condition is expected to remain uncertain.
- (b) There were no announcements or disclosures published in a public document of any revenue or profit estimate, forecast, projection or internal targets as at the date of this announcement.
