A1 Accounting policies

The interim financial statements of the Group are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2018. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of Woodlandor Holdings Berhad ("Woodlandor" or the "Company") and its subsidiaries ("Group") since the year ended 31 December 2018.

B1 Review of performance

The Group's revenue for the current financial quarter compared to the previous corresponding quarter decreased by RM4.415 million. The decreased was mainly attributable to the Manufacturing segment.

Manufacturing segment

Revenue from manufacturing segment decreased from RM6.318 million to RM2.039 million over the corresponding quarter.

Trading segment

Revenue from trading segment decreased from RM0.384 million to RM0.248 million over the corresponding quarter.

Overall, the Group registered a loss before tax of RM0.782 million for the current financial quarter as compared to profit before tax of RM0.879 million in previous corresponding quarter. This was mainly due to lower sales volume.

B2 Comparison with the immediate preceding quarter's result

The Group posted a loss before tax of RM1.271 million for the current financial quarter as compared to profit before tax of RM0.467 million in the immediate preceding quarter. This was mainly attributable to lower sales volume for the current quarter.

B3 Prospect

The Group is expected to continue operating in a challenging economic environment. However, the Group will continue its effort to improve its efficiency and the Group's profitability.
