# Selected Explanatory Notes to the Interim Financial Statements for the first quarter ended 30 June 2022

# A1 Accounting policies

The interim financial statements of the Group are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2021. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of Woodlandor Holdings Berhad ("Woodlandor" or the "Company") and its subsidiaries ("Group") since the year ended 30 June 2021.

#### **B1** Review of performance

The Group's revenue for the current financial quarter compared to preceding year corresponding quarter (Q4 2021) increased by RM0.618 million. The increase was mainly due to manufacturing segment.

# Manufacturing segment

Revenue from manufacturing segment increased from RM1.139 million to RM1.456 million over the corresponding quarter.

# Trading segment

Trading revenue increased from RM0.231 million to RM0.532 million over the corresponding quarter.

Overall, the Group registered a profit before tax of RM5.782 million for the current financial quarter as compared to loss before tax of RM2.155 million in preceding year corresponding quarter (Q4 2021). This was mainly due to increase of other income in current financial quarter.

# **B2** Comparison with the immediate preceding quarter's result

The Group posted a profit before tax of RM 5.782 million for the current financial quarter as compared to loss before tax of RM 1.144 million in the immediate preceding quarter. This was mainly attributable to the increase of other income in current financial quarter.

#### **B3 Prospect**

Global economic uncertainties is expected to continue throughout 2022 amid a resurgence of COVID-19 variants, global supply chain disruptions and foreign exchange fluctuation resulting in escalating cost challenges. The Government's implementation of the minimum wage policy effective 1 May 2022 has further impacted the financial result.

The Group views that business operation will continue to be very challenging in view of the uncertainties in the local and global economies. The Board will continue to be prudent in operations and investments, focus on efforts to enhance operational and cost efficiencies.
