PART A – EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FRS 134, INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

1 Basis of preparation

The unaudited interim financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") and in compliance with Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 134, Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB), and should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2010.

The unaudited interim financial report contains condensed consolidated financial statements and selected explanatory notes which provide an explanation of the events and transactions that are significant to gain an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2010. The unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements and explanatory notes thereon do not include all of the information required for full set of financial statements to be prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards (FRSs).

2 Changes in accounting policies

PART B – EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

13 Review of performance

Group revenue for the nine months ended 30 September 2011 was RM395.154 million compared with RM348.948 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2010, an increase of 13.24%. The increase in revenue was mainly due to the increase in export volume of the group's products compared to the corresponding period in 2010. Group profit before taxation for the period ended 30 September 2011 was RM21.788 million, an increase of 52.49% over the RM14.288 million registered in the corresponding period in 2010. The increase in profit before tax was mainly due to the increase in revenue and better margin compared to the corresponding period in 2010.

For the three months third quarter ended 30 September 2011, Group revenue grew by 14.98% from RM123.787 million to RM142.325 million while profit before taxation increased by 77.38% from RM3.550 million to RM6.297 million as compared to the corresponding quarter in 2010. The increase in revenue was mainly due to the increase in export volume of the group's products compared to the corresponding period in 2010. The increase in profit before tax was mainly due to the increase in revenue and better margin compared to the corresponding period in 2010.

The revenue for the quarter ended 30 September 2011 increased by RM14.123 million or 11.02% and profit before taxation decreased by RM2.007 million or 24.17% for the current quarter as compared to the preceding quarter. The increase in revenue was mainly due to the higher demand for the group's plastic packaging products during the current quarter compared to the preceding quarter. The decrease in profit before taxation was mainly due to the unrealised loss on derivatives contracts with a negative impact of RM1.43 million from the Group's hedging activities as the USD and JPY strengthen unexpectedly against the RM.

15 Current year prospect

The Board of Directors is optimistic that for the financial year ending 2011, the Group will be able to achieve satisfactory performances for both its turnover and profitability.
