A1 Basis Of Preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 Interim Financial Reporting and Chapter 9 Part K of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

A3 Audit Report For Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The audit report for the Group's annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2006 was not subject to any qualifications.

A4 Seasonal Or Cyclical Factors

The Group's operations are generally not affected by any seasonal or cyclical factors.

A5 Unusual Items

There were no unusual items that affected the assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows in the current quarter under review.

A6 Changes in Estimates

The Group makes assumptions concerning the future and other sources of estimation uncertainty at the balance sheet date during its review for impairment of goodwill.

The key assumptions and other key sources of estimation uncertainty mentioned above that have a significant risk of causing a material adjustment to the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities within the current financial period are in respect of those made during the review of impairment of goodwill. The Group determines whether goodwill is impaired on an annual basis. Estimating the value in use requires the Group to make an estimate of the expected future cashflows from the cash-generating units and also to choose a suitable discount rate in order to calculate the present value of those cashflows. The carrying amount of goodwill as at 30 September 2007 was RM438.1 million.

There were no changes in estimates that have had a material effect in the results for the quarter under review.

A7 Debt And Equity Securities

During the current quarter, the Company repurchased 1,000 of its issued ordinary shares from the open market at an average price of RM1.10 per share. The total consideration paid for the repurchase including transaction costs was RM1,114 and this was financed by internally generated funds. The shares repurchased are being held as treasury shares in accordance with Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965.

Save as disclosed above, there were no issuances, cancellations, share buy-backs, resale of shares bought back and repayment of debt and debt equity securities during the quarter under review.

B BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD LISTING REQUIREMENTS

B1 Review Of Performance

For the 3 months ended 30 September 2007, the Group achieved a higher revenue of RM117.9 million compared to RM109.7 million recorded in the corresponding quarter in FY 2006. The increase in revenue is largely attributable by the improved offshore support vessels division contribution.

Group profit for the current quarter decreased by RM11.6 million or 44% compared to the corresponding quarter last year to RM26.2 million. The lower profit is mainly due to lower Gross Profit margin of 22.0% in the current quarter as compared to 27.2% in corresponding period last year mainly due to increased docking and bunker expenses.

In July 2006, the Group divested its jewellery business to Habib Holding Sdn Bhd. In accordance with FRS 5, the revenue and profit before tax for the financial year 2006 of the jewellery business is separately disclosed in Note A13.

B2 Comparison Of The Current Quarter Results Against Preceding Quarter

The revenue of the Group for the current quarter against the preceding quarter is comparable. However, Gross Profit Margin in the current quarter of 22.0% is lower than the preceding quarter of 25.4%. The lower Gross Profit Margin is mainly due to the higher bunker costs in current quarter compared to the preceding quarter.

The Profit after tax and minority interest for the current quarter, increased by RM4.0 million i.e 37% to RM14.7 million as compared to RM10.7 million recorded in the preceding quarter largely due to higher share of profit from associated companies. The associated company recorded a higher gain on disposal of vessels in this quarter as compared to preceding quarter.

B3 Current Year Prospects

The Group will continue to be active in two core businesses, which are the marine logistics services and offshore support vessels services targeting the South East Asia and Middle East regions.

The Marine Logistics division continues to deliver steady cash flows. Our contract with the coal producer should ensure we receive our share of carriage of their transport requirement for the year in review.

The Malaysian & Indonesian operations have recorded good performances to date. The Indonesian subsidiary, PT Rig Tenders Indonesia Tbk has recently entered into a conditional ship building contract for 2 Accommodation Barges expected to be delivered by end 2008 which is expected to enhance contribution of the Offshore Support Vessels division going forward. The said ship building transaction is subject to the approval of the shareholders of PT Rig Tenders.

The termination date of the agreement is August 31, 2011.
 - ii) On December 6, 2006, the Group entered into an interest swap transaction agreement with a bank to fix its floating interest rate at 4.95%p.a.The effective date of the swap transaction is on February 28, 2007 with a notional amount of RM51.75 million (which is denominated in US Dollar, equivalent to USD15 million). The termination date of the agreement is August 31, 2011.

 - ii) On October 1, 2007, the Group entered into an interest swap transaction agreement with a bank to fix its floating interest rate at 4.56%p.a. The effective date of the swap transaction is on 02 October with a notional amount of RM44.05 million (which is denominated in US Dollar, equivalent to USD12.880 million). The termination date of the agreement is November 27, 2009
