# A1. Basis of Preparation of Interim Financial Statements

The interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and Paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements ("MMLR") of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2011. The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2011.

# PART B: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE MAIN MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

#### **B1.** Review of Performance

The Group's revenue for the first quarter of 2012 ("Q1 2012") is RM18.321 million, compared to RM18.362 million during the corresponding preceding quarter of 2011 ("Q1 2011"). The economic landscape in Europe continues to pose major challenges to the Group. The revenue from the Europe region decreased by 34% from RM5.653 million in Q1 2011 to RM3.706 million in Q1 2012 whereas the America region revenue managed to grow by 32% from RM5.109 million in Q1 2011 to RM6.722 million in Q1 2012. The Group registered a profit after tax for the period of RM0.984 million.

The Group reported revenue of RM18.321 million in Q1 2012, which represents an increase of 17.5% as compared to RM15.587 million for the fourth quarter of 2011 ("Q4 2011"). Despite registering higher revenue in Q1 2012 as compared to Q4 2011, the profit for the period was lower due to lower gross profit margin from contracted customers.

# **B3.** Prospects of the Group

The global outlook, in particular for the United States, looks more positive than initially expected. However, the Group is cautious that the ongoing debt crisis in Europe will continue to affect the Group's performance in Europe. The Group expects that the sales momentum from Asia Pacific and America region will continue to grow in the next few quarters of 2012, and be the main drivers of top-line growth for 2012.

The increase in minimum wages in Thailand by approximately 40% will post a challenge to the Group to maintain its gross profit margin. In this regard, the Group will continuously review and implement measures to mitigate the escalation in labour costs.

The Group has not provided any quarterly profit forecast for the period under review.
