Quarterly Report on unaudited consolidated results for the first financial quarter ended 31 March 2021

Notes to the Interim Financial Report

1. Basis of preparation

The unaudited consolidated interim financial statements (Condensed Report) have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard ("MFRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standard Board ("MASB") and Paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. 1. Review of Performance

Comparison results of current quarter and previous corresponding quarter

The Group recorded revenue of RM139.88 million for the current quarter under review representing an increase of 69.6% over revenue of RM82.46 million of previous corresponding quarter.

The Group recorded profit before tax of RM6.05 million for the current quarter under review representing a decrease of 58.9% over profit before tax of RM14.71 million of previous corresponding quarter, mainly due to the one-off gain on disposal of land recorded in the previous corresponding quarter.

The performance of the business segments for the current quarter is described as below:

Investment Holdings Division Lower dividend income received from subsidiaries has caused this division recorded higher loss for the current quarter.

2) Trading and Service Division

The revenue in Trading and Service Division recorded an increase by 67.6% as compared to previous corresponding quarter. Local sales increased significantly by 119.2% was the main contributor to the Group's revenue due to strong demand in the local market. On the other hand, the overseas sales also increased moderately by 19.8% due to improving economic condition outside Malaysia.

Hence, the division's results increased significantly by 347.4% as compared to last corresponding quarter due to sales improvement and effective cost management.

3) Manufacturing Division

The revenue in Manufacturing Division has increased by 72.7% as compared to previous corresponding quarter which is mainly due to the increase in inter-companies sales.

The division reported a turnaround performance during the current quarter, swinging from loss to profit of RM1.35 million, as compared to previous corresponding period. This is mainly attributed to better sales mix and margin. The Company continue to focus on improving efficiency and productivity.

2. Variation of results against immediate preceding quarter

The Group recorded revenue of RM139.88 million for the current quarter under review, representing a marginal increase of 1.2% as compared to RM138.21 million in the immediate preceding quarter. Meanwhile, the Group recorded profit before tax of RM6.05 million, representing a decrease of 22.9% as compared to the preceding quarter's profit before tax of RM7.85 million.

3. Commentary on prospect

The Board expects the Group's will continue to perform well for the next quarter due to the new normal on work from home has generally brought strong demand for electrical kitchen and home appliances, coupled with our focus marketing strategy.

The Group will continue to embark on cost reduction and rationalisation exercises as well as improving operational efficiency and growing its regional business.
