NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

A1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad Main Board Listing Requirements.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 October 2014.

The significant accounting policies adopted are consistent with those adopted for the annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31 October 2014. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to the understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 October 2014.

A2. SEASONAL OR CYCLICAL FACTORS

The principal business operations of the Group has historically shown moderate seasonality, where production and sales of furniture are generally lower in the beginning of the calendar year due to the local festive period as well as the summer holiday in the middle of the year.

A3. UNUSUAL ITEMS DUE TO THEIR NATURE, SIZE AND INCIDENCE

Save for the below, there were no unusual items of nature, size or incidence that affect the assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flow of the Group during the reporting period.

The Company had on 24 August 2015 announced that a fire incident has occurred at Poh Huat Furniture Industries Vietnam Joint-Stock Company's ("Poh Huat Vietnam") manufacturing facilities in the Province of Binh Duong, Vietnam ("Binh Duong Facilities")

The net book value of the damages including amongst others, ancillary structures, plant and machinery, work-in-progress furniture parts and completed furniture goods amounted to approximately USD2.37 million in total. Notwithstanding that, production and delivery interruption are minimal as the Group has put in place alternative manufacturing/ warehousing arrangements within Poh Huat Vietnam's manufacturing facilities in Binh Duong and Dong Nai as well as increase in Dong Nai facility's production shift from one (1) single 12-hour shift.

All the assets, materials and finished goods are fully insured. Poh Huat Vietnam is in the midst of working with the insurer and adjusters for the insurance compensation for losses arising from the incident, and that such insurance proceeds, upon receipt, will be utilised to off-set the relevant reconstruction and repair cost and assets impairment charges arising from the damaged fixed assets and stocks.

A4. MATERIAL CHANGES IN ESTIMATES

The Company has not issued any revenue or profit estimate, forecast or target.

A5. ISSUANCE, REPURCHASE AND CANCELLATION OF SHARES

The Company has not issued any shares, debts or convertible securities during the current financial period.

The Company has been authorised by shareholders to re-purchase its own shares.

The Company has not purchased any of its own shares during the financial quarter under review.

The total number of shares repurchased by the Company as at end of reporting period (31 July 2015) was 6,663,800 ordinary shares. All the repurchased shares are held as treasury shares and treated in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act 1965. None of the treasury shares were resold or cancelled during the reporting period. The repurchase transactions were financed by internally generated funds.

For the quarter ended 31 July 2015, the Group recorded a higher turnover of RM112.50 million compared to RM89.12 million recorded in the previous year's corresponding quarter ended 31 July 2014. Shipment from our Vietnamese operations was significant higher in line with the stronger recovery in the employment and housing market in the US against the lower shipment of furniture in the previous year's corresponding quarter which was affected by the anti-China riot. Shipment of furniture from the Malaysian operations was broadly the same as the Group continued with its focus on higher-value office furniture, particularly for the North America and Middle East markets.

During the quarter, the performance of both the Vietnamese and Malaysian subsidiaries improved substantially. The Vietnamese operations recorded a strong margin improvement amidst the stronger US Dollar and overall higher productivity which has resulted in better absorption of overheads. The profit before tax from the Vietnamese operation rose significantly to RM7.10 million against a profit of RM3.56 million previously. The Malaysian operations also continued to improve with a higher profit before tax of RM4.34 million due to its focus on higher value items and the better pricing brought about by the stronger US Dollar against the Ringgit.

During the quarter under review, the Group recorded foreign currency translation gain of RM3.40 million due mainly to the weakening of the Malaysian Ringgit against the Vietnamese Dong.

During the current quarter under review, the Group recorded higher turnover of RM112.50 million against the seasonal low turnover of RM96.16 million for the preceding quarter. The higher turnover is again attributable to the seasonally higher orders of furniture from US importers amidst improving business sentiments and consumer confidence in the US.

On a consolidated basis, the Group reported a significantly higher profit before tax of RM12.15 million against a profit before tax of RM5.33 million in the preceding quarter. The Group's operations in Vietnam again led the way with a profit before tax of RM7.10 million. The strengthening of margin is again attributable to the better overhead absorption from the higher level of production. The profitability of the Malaysian operations similarly improved due to the continued efforts to focus on operational efficiency and selling higher value items together with the rising US Dollar exchange rate.

B3. PROSPECT FOR THE CURRENT FINANCIAL YEAR

The US economy continued to gain strength with successive improvements in its key economic indicators including manufacturing outputs, employment and corporate earnings. These improvements, coupled with falling commodity prices and appreciation of the US Dollar translate to more disposal income and increase in purchasing power amongst US consumers.

U.S. furniture imports rose 8% last year, an encouraging boost for importers. More than 70% of the respondents to a factory survey done by Furniture Today in the US reported that orders for the year to date were up from a year earlier. A healthier economy is expected to double the rate of growth in U.S. furniture and bedding retail sales this year to 4%, pushing the industry past the USD100 billion mark. According to a recent survey of residential furniture manufacturers, year-to-date new orders were up 5% through April and year-to-date shipments were up 7% over the same period a year ago. There is a consensus amongst industry participants that demand for furniture in the US market will be sustained.

Notwithstanding the encouraging fundamentals and recent appreciation of the US Dollar, the Board remains mindful of the challenges in the global economic conditions. The concerns over the slowing growth of China and Europe have severely affected global financial markets and consumer confidence. China's recent move to devalue its currency has also added more deflationary pressures and weakened consumer confidence.

Amid this backdrop, the Group continues to adopt a collaborative approach with its long-term customers in terms of product development and manufacturing programmes and further emphasise on financial discipline when dealing with suppliers to ensure availability of resources at stable prices.

The financial and operational impact of the fire incident in Poh Huat Vietnam's Binh Duong Facilities as mentioned in Note A3 is expected to be minimal as the management has made the necessary arrangements within its own manufacturing facilities to overcome the disrupted operations.
