# 17. Material Changes in Quarterly Results

The Group registered a profit before tax of RM2 9million for the current quarter, which is an increase of RM3.4million compared to a loss before tax of RM0.5million in the preceding quarter. The loss in the fourth quarter ended 31 December 2000 is mainly due to certain provisions made at the year end. There is no material factor affecting the profit before tax for the quarter ended 31 March 2001 of RM2.9million, a pretax profit margin of 21.5%. This is also in line with the profit before tax of RM2.5million registered in the preceding year corresponding quarter ended 31 March 2000 with a pretax profit margin of 21.6%.

### 18. Review of Performance

The profit margin for Engineering and Distribution has dropped 4.41% and 3.52% respectively in the first quarter as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter ended 31.3.2000. This is mainly due to the continuous price competition resulted from entry of new competitors who were previously involved only in the building and general construction business.

The profit margin for Manufacturing has increased by 8.73% in the first quarter as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter. This is resulted by the reduction of production cost through the Group relocation program for the labour intensive manufacturing activities.

In the opinion of the Board of Directors, no item transaction or event of a material and unusual nature has arisen which would affect substantially the results for the operation of the Group for the period from 31 March 2001 to the date of issue of this quarterly report.

### 19. Current Year Prospects

The acquisition of two subsidiaries in Indonesia involving in the manufacturing of the Group's products will help to reduce production cost through the Group's relocation program for the labour intensive manufacturing activities. This will compensate for reduction in profit margin of the Group's Engineering and Distribution Sectors resulting from price competition. As a result, the Directors anticipate that the performance for the year ending 31December 2001 will remain satisfactory.
