#### NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

#### 1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard ("MFRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting", International Accounting Standard ("IAS") 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" and Paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2018.

#### 2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the interim financial report are consistent with those applied in the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2018 except for the adoption of MFRSs and Amendments to MFRS Standards effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2019.

#### 3. AUDITORS' REPORT ON PRECEDING YEAR FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The auditors' report on the financial statements for the preceding financial year ended 31 December 2018 was unmodified and did not contain material uncertainty related to going concern.

#### 4. SEASONAL AND CYCLICAL FACTORS

The operations of the Group are generally not materially affected by any seasonal nor cyclical factors. However, festive periods and hot weather do affect positively the demand of bottled water products.

#### 5. UNUSUAL ITEMS AFFECTING ASSETS, LIABILITIES, EQUITY, NET INCOME OR CASH FLOWS

There were no material items of an unusual nature and amount for the current quarter and year-to-date ended 30 June 2019.

#### 6. MATERIAL CHANGES IN ESTIMATES

There were no material changes in the estimates used in the current quarter compared to those used in the previous financial year which have a material effect in the current quarter and financial year-to-date ended 30 June 2019.

#### 7. ISSUANCES, CANCELLATIONS, REPURCHASES, RESALE AND REPAYMENTS OF DEBT AND EQUITY SECURITIES

There were no issuance, no repayment of debt and equity securities and share buy-backs during the current quarter and year-to-date ended 30 June 2019.

The total number of the Company's ordinary shares in issue, net of treasury shares as at 30 June 2019 is 209,968,727.

As at 30 June 2019, the total shares held as treasury shares remained at 24,000 shares as none of the treasury shares were resold or cancelled during the current quarter and year-to-date ended 30 June 2019.

#### 8. DIVIDEND PAID

On 21 June 2019, the Company paid a first and final dividend of 3.5 sen per share, under the single tier system, amounting to RM7,348,905 in respect of the previous financial year ended 31 December 2018.

The Group recorded a revenue of RM94.8 million during the current quarter ended 30 June 2019, which is a 13% increase from the RM83.6 million recorded in the same quarter in previous year. The increase in revenue is mainly due to increase in quantity sold and better average selling prices of bottled water.

During the current quarter ended 30 June 2019, the Group's revenue from manufacturing segment of RM90.3 million represents an increase of 13% from RM79.9 million in the same quarter in previous year. Revenue from trading segment increased 19% from RM3.7 million to RM4.4 million in the current quarter ended 30 June 2019. The increase in manufacturing revenue is attributable to the increase in sales volume and better average selling prices. The increase in trading revenue is mainly due to higher sales volume.

The Group recorded a revenue of RM189.9 million during the financial year-to-date ended 30 June 2019, which is a 14% increase from the RM166.2 million recorded in the same period in previous year. The increase in revenue is due to increase in sales volume and better average selling prices.

During the financial year-to-date ended 30 June 2019, the Group's revenue from manufacturing segment of RM180.8 million represents an increase of 15% from RM157.6 million in the same period in previous year. Revenue from trading segment increased 6% from RM8.4 million to RM8.9 million in the financial year-to-date ended 30 June 2019. Both the increase in manufacturing and trading revenue is mainly due to the increase in sales volume and better average selling prices.

The investment revenue is derived from placement of excess funds as short term investment in money market funds. The reduction of investment revenue of 39% and 15% in the current quarter and in the financial year ended 30 June 2019, respectively is due to utilisation of excess funds to pay for acquisition of property, plant and equipment.

The increase in allowance for and write off of inventories in the current quarter and year-to-date ended 30 June 2019 is in line with the sales and production increase during the period.

The increase in property, plant and equipment written off for the current quarter and the year-to-date ended 30 June 2019 is due to writing off of obsolete plant and equipment which have been replaced with new ones to increase productivity and to reduce production and operations costs, which is in line with the Group's on-going expansion plan.

Loss on foreign exchange comprises realised and unrealised foreign currencies exchange differences arising from trade transactions. The major foreign currencies transacted by the Group in trade transactions are United States Dollar, Chinese Renminbi and Singapore Dollar.

The increase in cost of sales of 6% for the current quarter ended 30 June 2019 compared to the same quarter in previous year is in line with the increase in sales volume. Other operating expenses increased by 27% in the current quarter ended 30 June 2019 compared the same quarter in previous year mainly due to increase in selling and distribution expenses, which is in line with the increase in sales.

The increase in cost of sales of 10% for the financial year-to-date ended 30 June 2019 compared to the same period in previous year is in line with the increase in sales volume. Other operating expenses increased 24% compared with the same period last year mainly due increase in selling and distribution expenses, which is in line with the increase in sales.

The Group's manufacturing segment results increased 16% to RM11.3 million during the current quarter ended 30 June 2019 compared to the RM 9.7 million recorded in the same quarter in previous year. The increase is mainly due to higher sales volume, better average selling prices as well as lower manufacturing cost. Manufacturing results for the year-to-date ended 30 June 2019 has improved by 8% to RM21.3 million compared to the RM19.7 million achieved in the same period last year mainly due to better sales volume and average selling prices.

The Group's trading segment results has improved 18% to RM0.7 million loss during the current quarter ended 30 June 2019 from the RM0.9 million loss recorded in the same quarter in previous year. The improvement is mainly due to better sales performance and reduction in overhead costs of the China operations. Similarly, the 25% improvement from RM1.7 million loss to RM1.3 million loss in trading segment results in the year-to-date ended 30 June 2019 is due to improved sales performance and better costs management of the China operations.

The Group recorded a profit before tax of RM10.7 million during the current quarter ended 30 June 2019, representing a 14% increase from the RM9.4 million recorded in the same quarter last year mainly due to increase in sales revenue and lower manufacturing cost. The Group's profit before tax for the year-to-date ended 30 June 2019 increased 10% to RM20.7 million from RM 18.8 million in the same period last year mainly due to increase in sales revenue,

The Group recorded a revenue of RM94.8 million during the current quarter ended 30 June 2019, which is consistent with the RM95.1 million recorded in the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 March 2019.

The Group recorded a profit before tax of RM10.7 million during the current quarter ended 30 June 2019, representing a 7% increase from the RM10.0 million recorded in the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 March 2019 mainly due to the lower manufacturing cost.

#### 18. FUTURE PROSPECTS

The Group expects the consumer sentiment to remain at the suboptimal level and the market conditions to be challenging with intense competition among the many bottled water brands in the market. Packaging material cost is expected to be volatile and other operating costs will remain high in 2019.

We will continue with our marketing and sales efforts so as to improve our sales of bottled water in Malaysia and in Guangzhou, China. The construction of the automated warehouse at our Taiping mineral water plant is progressing well. We will continue to improve our internal efficiency and further strengthen our manufacturing capacity and capability with the enhancement of our processing facilities and the acquisition of high speed and fully automated production facility. With our strong branding and a comprehensive and increasing range of quality bottled water products catering to the various market segments, we are hopeful that the sales of our bottled water products will be sustainable in the domestic market. We are taking firm steps to further improve our business operations in China.

In addition, we are also focusing on exploring sustainable packaging alternatives for the medium to long term.

With effective campaigns and promotions, we are hopeful that our sales volume will continue to grow. While being mindful that the operating costs will remain high in 2019, the directors are cautiously optimistic that the Group will be able to generate a satisfactory performance in the financial year ending 31 December 2019.

The effective tax rate for the current quarter and financial year-to-date ended 30 June 2019 is higher than the statutory income tax rate of 24% mainly due to certain expenses are not allowable for tax purposes and unutilised tax losses of certain subsidiaries not recognised as deferred tax assets.
