7. INFORMATION ON THE GROUP

7.1 INCORPORATION AND BUSINESS

D'nonce Technology was incorporated in Malaysia as a public limited company on 20 January 2000 pursuant to the Companies Act, 1965. It became the investment holding company of the D'nonce Group following the completion of the Acquisitions.


The Group was founded in 1989 and commenced business as a Penang-based trading company principally involved in the sales and distribution of specialised tapes and packaging materials for use in the electronics industry. Fueled by the growth of the electronics industry in Malaysia, the business expanded rapidly. Today, the Sales & Distribution division has offices in Penang, Kuala Lumpur, Johor, Kelantan and has a sales representative office in the Philippines catering to approximately 490 customers.

In 1991, recognising the increasing demand for custom engineered, cost effective and environmentally efficient packaging designs for use in the electronics industry, AV was incorporated to facilitate the Group's venture into Design & Conversion activities. Since then, the Group has set up one (1) factory each in Prai, Penang, Kuala Lumpur and Johor Bahru to service approximately 236 customers in the northern, central and southern region of Peninsular Malaysia.

In December 1997, the Group further diversifies its principal activities to include the provision of contract manufacturing services for the assembly of HSA, HGA and coil winding through AV Industries. Today, AV Industries's contract manufacturing services include PCBA, FCBA and OEM product assemblies. Currently, AV Industries operates from its two (2) plants in Prai which are equipped with clean room facilities and with a combined built up area of 70,396 sq. ft.. It has also rented a plant in Baling, Kedah with a built up area of 2,709 sq. ft..

In November 1998, Khazanah acquired a 30% equity interest in D'nonce (M). The Directors view Khazanah's involvement in the Group as an endorsement of its efforts to be a key player in the supporting sub-sectors of the electronics industry. As such, the Group works closely with Khazanah towards achieving its goal of becoming a world class producer and supplier to the electronics industry.

The existing group structure of the D'nonce Group is as follows:



7.2 RESTRUCTURING AND LISTING SCHEME

In conjunction with and as an integral part of the listing of and quotation for the entire issued and paid-up ordinary shares of D'nonce Technology on the Second Board of the KLSE, the Company undertook a restructuring exercise as follows:-

(a) Acquisition of D'nonce (M)

On 11 October 2000, D'nonce Technology entered into a Shares Sale Agreement with the shareholders of D'nonce (M) for the acquisition of 100% equity interest in D'nonce (M) comprising 7,000,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each for a total purchase consideration of RM27,062,723, satisfied by the issuance of 23,062,723 new ordinary shares of RM1.00 each in D'nonce Technology at an issue price of approximately RM1.17 per Share as follows:

(b) Acquisition of D'nonce (M) Subsidiaries

On 19 October 2000, D'nonce Technology entered into a Shares Sale Agreement with D'nonce (M) to acquire from D'nonce (M), the entire equity interest of D'nonce (M) in AV Industries, AV, D'nonce Electronics, AV Innovation, AV (KL), D'nonce (KL), AV (JB), D'nonce (Johore) and D'nonce (Kelantan) for a total cash consideration of RM4,374,000, satisfied via inter-company balances between D'nonce Technology and D'nonce (M). The purchase consideration of RM4,374,000 was arrived at based on the carrying values of D'nonce (M)'s cost of investment in the respective companies as at 31st August 1999 as follows:-

D'nonce Technology undertook rights issue of 6,937,275 new Shares at an issue price of RM1.00 each on the basis of approximately 10 new Shares for every 33 existing Shares held after the Acquisition of D'nonce (M) and the Acquisition of D'nonce (M) Subsidiaries.

The Rights Issue was completed on 6 December 2000.

(d) Public and Special Issues

Public and Special Issues of 10,000,000 new ordinary shares of RM1.00 each of D'nonce Technology at an issue price of RM2.00 per Share, will be allocated to the following parties:-

7.4.2 Group Business

The business activities of the Group may be broadly categorised into the following:

(a) Contract Manufacturing

The Group's involvement in Contract Manufacturing started in December 1997 with the hookup assembly of actuator arm to FCBA for Read-Rite. Read-Rite is a subsidiary of Read-Rite Corporation, a company incorporated in US, one of the world's leading independent manufacturers of magnetic read/write heads, HSAs and HGAs for disk drives and tape drives. Subsequently, the Group was awarded the contract by Read-Rite to provide HSA services to one of its customers, Iomega Corp, a company incorporated in US, a leading manufacturer of smart, portable storage solutions, including drives and disks. Since then, the Group's Contract Manufacturing activities have grown rapidly. Its customer base now includes manufacturers in disk drive, audio, electronics toy cars and hygienic industry. For the financial year ended 31 August 2000, Contract Manufacturing contributed approximately 58% and 47% to the Group's turnover and PAT respectively.

(b) Design & Conversion

AV was established in Penang in 1991 to meet the increasing demand by the electronics industry for customised, cost effective and environmentally efficient packaging designs. Through AV, the Group designs and converts advanced packaging materials, such as specialised paper, special chemically treated rubber and foams, insulation and interleafing materials. Since then, the Group has established operations in Kuala Lumpur and Johore Bahru to supply to its customers in other parts of Peninsular Malaysia. Today, Design & Conversion has approximately 236 customers who are predominantly in the electronics industry. For the financial year ended 31 August 2000, Design & Conversion contributed approximately 13% and 34% to the Group's turnover and PAT respectively.

(c) Sales & Distribution

D'nonce (M) was incepted in 1989 as a trading company, specialising in the supply of specialised tapes used in electronic and electrical products. Sales & Distribution of the Group has since grown rapidly. Today, the Group's sales offices in Penang, Kuala Lumpur, Johore Bahru, Kota Bharu and sales representative office in Philippines offer a wide range of products, particularly clean room consumables, electronic components, tapes and packaging materials to approximately 490 customers who are predominantly in the electronics industry. For the financial year ended 31 August 2000, Sales & Distribution contributed approximately 29% and 19% to the Group's turnover and PAT respectively.

7.4.3 Products and Services

(a) Contract Manufacturing

The Group provides the following contract manufacturing services:

- Coil winding for sliders
- Head Gimbal Assembly (HGA)
- Head Stack Assembly (HSA)
- Surface Mount Technology (SMT) component placement
- Printed Circuit Board Assembly (PCBA)
- Flexible Circuit Board Assembly (FCBA)
- OEM product assemblies and manufacturing
- Assembly and test of wire harnesses

(b) **Design & Conversion**

The major categories of packaging products the Group designs and converts are as follows:



(a) Contract Manufacturing of HSA and HGA


The assembly of HSA and HGA requires clean room environment and facilities. AV Industries currently has a floor space of 20,396 sq. ft. of Class 10K clean room facility with Class 100 laminar flowhood which is located at Plot 425, Tingkat Perusahaan 6A Free Trade Zone, Prai, Penang. It is also equipped with conductive floor tiles, air ionizing systems, ESD safe chairs, stainless steel workbenches and ESD monitoring systems to minimise potential ESD damage to read/write heads, particularly those utilising MR and GMR technology.




The production process for PCBA and FCBA is as follows:

The production process of audio box build sub-assembly is as follows:





The production process of audio box build final assembly is as follows:



7.4.6 Market Position and Competition

To the best of the Directors' knowledge, there is no independent statistic on the Group's market share in each of its respective businesses.

(a) Contract Manufacturing

The contract manufacturing industry in Malaysia comprises of companies catering to a wide range of products and components such as semiconductors, disk drives, PCBAs and FCBAs. Some of these companies cater to specific industries, such as, the semiconductor and disk drive industries, whilst those in manufacturing of PCBAs and FCBAs may have customers from a wider range of industries. The Directors believe that barriers to entry into the contract manufacturing industry are high due to, inter alia, high investment cost, skilled labour force, technical know-how and stringent pre-qualification process.

AV Industries offers HSA and HGA services to customers in Malaysia. The Directors believe that the Group has a competitive edge over its foreign competitors over the customers which are located in Malaysia.

With its new plant in Prai, the Group also offers contract manufacturing services for PCBA and FCBA, as well as OEM product assemblies to its customers. Presently, the Group is servicing customers in the disk drive, audio, toy cars and hygienic industries and will eventually expand its customer base to other industries. Today, amongst others, its major customers are Read-Rite, Sony and Nikko.

The Directors believe that the Group's competitive strengths are as follows:

• Track record

Despite being a relatively new player in the contract manufacturing sector, the Group has in a short time demonstrated its ability to offer high quality contract manufacturing services through the provision of timely product delivery, low turnaround time, high production yield and stringent quality control. In particular, the Group has acquired the necessary technical know-how and expertise to offer contract manufacturing services for HSA, HGA, PCBA and FCBA.

• A team of experienced and skilled labour force

The Group has recruited a team of experienced and skilled labour force, largely from Read-Rite, following the relocation of its manufacturing operations. With this team, the Group has the necessary technical expertise and experience to compete with potential competitors.

(b) Design & Conversion

To the best of their knowledge, the Directors believe there is only a limited number of companies in Malaysia involved in design and conversion of advanced packaging materials for the electronics industry. The Directors believe that it will be difficult for new players to enter the market as customers increasingly prefer to deal with established integrated suppliers manufacturing a wide range of products. Furthermore, there is also the requirement for technical skills to achieve high quality controls in the conversion and assembly processes.

The Directors believe that the Group's competitive strengths are as follows:

• Bulk purchases

To-date, the Group has approximately 236 Design & Conversion customers. This enables the Group to purchase its raw materials in bulk, thus achieving greater economies of scale which in turn enables the Group to price its products more competitively.

• Integrated supplier

The Group continues to be an integrated supplier thus providing customers the ability to reduce the number of suppliers, therefore enabling cost savings to its customers.

• Customer support and services

The Group has decentralised its operations across Peninsular Malaysia with factories in Penang, Kuala Lumpur and Johore Bahru. These factories are strategically located in close proximity to its major customers to provide better customer support and services, particularly to those who have implemented just-in-time (JIT) production systems.

(c) Sales & Distribution

The Directors believe that there are a limited number of companies in Malaysia which carry a similar range of products as the Group. The Directors believe that new players will find it difficult to penetrate the market as customers are continuously reducing their approved vendors list, preferring to deal with established suppliers with a wide range of products. In addition, it will be increasingly difficult for new entrants to obtain distributorships for established and/or quality products.

The Directors believe that the Group's competitive strengths are as follows:

• Wide distribution networks

The Group has decentralised its operations across Peninsular Malaysia with sales offices in Penang, Kuala Lumpur, Johore Bahru, Kota Bharu and a sales representative office in Philippines to be closer to its customers. This is to provide better customer support and services, particularly to those who have implemented just-in-time (JIT) production systems.

• Wide product range

It is the Group's strategy to carry a wide range of products to enable it to penetrate the various sub-sectors of the electronics industry. Currently, the Group distributes to approximately 234 products predominantly for the electronics industry. The Directors believe that this is a competitive advantage for D'nonce Group as customers, particularly MNCs, increasingly prefer to deal with fewer suppliers who are able to meet all or most of their material requirements.

7.4.7 Marketing, Distribution and Sales

Each of the Group's major business activities has its own respective marketing team.

(a) Contract Manufacturing

The marketing effort is spearheaded by an Executive Director who has been instrumental in the establishment of this business activity. Assisting him is a general manager and a senior manager, each has more than ten (10) years of working experience in the electronics industry. They are supported by a team of qualified and experienced technical personnel.

Sales and marketing efforts are targeted at those companies, particularly MNCs, who are already outsourcing or looking to outsource their manufacturing activities. The strategy is to promote the Group not just as a contract manufacturer but also as a supplier of their packaging and material requirements i.e. a 'one-stop' supplier.

(b) **Design & Conversion**

Currently, the sales and marketing efforts for Design & Conversion is spearheaded by an Executive Director. He is assisted by a senior marketing manager with many years of marketing experience. Each of its operations in Penang, Kuala Lumpur and Johore Bahru has its own respective marketing team, comprising of four (4) to six (6) marketing executives oversee by the respective directors in the subsidiary companies. They promote and market D'nonce Group as a solutions provider and product enhancer to its customers.

7. INFORMATION ON THE GROUP (cont'd)

In recent years, the Design & Conversion activities have been expanded from Penang to Kuala Lumpur and Johore Bahru. This strategy allows the Group to reduce costs (in particular logistics cost) and better source its existing and new customers, particularly those who have implemented just-in-time (JIT) production systems.

(c) Sales & Distribution

Sales and marketing efforts are carried out by approximately 20 marketing managers and executives, from its network of offices throughout Peninsular Malaysia. The team in the Penang office handles the sales and marketing for the northern region of Peninsular Malaysia, namely Kedah, Perlis, Penang and Perak whilst the team in Kuala Lumpur services customers in the central region namely Selangor, Federal Territory, Negeri Sembilan and Melaka. Customers in Johore and Singapore are being serviced by the team in Johore Bahru. Finally, the team in Kota Bharu services customers in the Eastern corridor of Peninsular Malaysia, namely Kelantan, Trengganu and Pahang. The Group also has a sales representative office in Philippines to service its overseas customer base.

The Group promotes and positions itself as a strong and progressive distributor by supplying a wide range of good quality products with strong technical support and services for all its customers. Furthermore, the Group has, over the years, developed good business relationships with its customers.

7.4.8 New Business Activities

The Group has recently set up a new factory in Penang to provide contract manufacturing services for PCBA, FCBA and OEM product assemblies. Initially, the Group targeted customers in the disk drive industry, promoting itself as a 'one-stop' supplier to its existing customers. However, PCBAs and FCBAs are also widely used in cellular phones, PCs, audio products etc, and the Group will progressively secure customers in some of these industries.

7.4.9 Major Customers

Since its inception in 1989, the Group's businesses have grown rapidly. Today, it has a clientele base of approximately 732, predominantly in the electronics industry. Its customers, both local and MNCs with their operational set-up in Malaysia, demand very high qualification standards from their suppliers.

(a) Contract Manufacturing

When the Group first ventured into Contract Manufacturing in December 1997, it has only Read-Rite as its customer. As at14 February 2001, its customer base has expanded to six (6). For the financial year ended 31 August 2000, Read-Rite and Sony contributed up to 41% and 0.5% respectively of the Group's turnover. The Directors are of the view that dependence on a few key customers is a common feature in the Contract Manufacturing sector, particularly for new entrants. Nonetheless, the Group is actively seeking to reduce its dependence on these customers. Looking forward, the Group is to further increase their customer base for the financial year ending 31 August 2001.

(b) **Design & Conversion**

As at 14 February 2001, the Group has approximately 236 Design & Conversion customers. No single customer contributed more than 5% to Group's turnover for the financial year ended 31 August 2000. The Directors do not foresee that they will account for more than 5% of the Group's turnover for the financial year ending 31 August 2001.

(c) Sales & Distribution

As at 14 February 2001, the Group has approximately 490 Sales & Distribution customers. No single customer contributed more than 5% to the Group's turnover for the financial year ended 31 August 2000. The Directors do not foresee that they will account for more than 5% of the Group's turnover for the financial year ending 31 August 2001.

7.4.10 Major Suppliers

The Group has over 439 local and overseas suppliers. The Group's policy is to constantly evaluating and sourcing for new sources of materials/products and to expand its existing product range. This has enabled the Group to negotiate for more favourable and competitive terms for the purchases.

(a) Contract Manufacturing

The Group sources its components such as HGA, FCBA, actuator coil and body, bearing, target sensor, housing and terminal, insulated wire, comb and tray from suppliers in China, Thailand, Philippines, Taiwan, Japan and Malaysia.

In addition to being a customer, Read-Rite is also a major supplier (of HGAs) to AV Industries, accounting for approximately 22% of the Group's purchases for the financial year ended 31 August 2000. In contract manufacturing sector, it is common for customers to specify suppliers from which contract manufacturers must purchase components from, and in instances where such supplies could not be obtained from the specified suppliers, the customers would assist in the sourcing of the components to ensure timely delivery of the contract.

(b) **Design & Conversion**

The Group sources its raw materials such as, interleaf kraft paper, silver saver paper, insulation form, anti-static foam, normal foam, conductive rubber, carrier base paper, paper reel and lead frame interleafing from suppliers in Singapore, USA, Norway, Holland, Taiwan, Japan, Indonesia and Malaysia. For the financial year ended 31 August 2000, no single supplier accounted for more than 5% of the Group's purchases. The Directors do not foresee that any single supplier will amount for more than 5% of the Group's purchases for the financial year ending 31 August 2001.

(c) Sales & Distribution

The Group sources its products from various suppliers in Taiwan, Japan, USA and Singapore. For the financial year ended 31 August 2000, no single supplier accounted for more than 5% of the Group's purchases. The Directors do not foresee that any single supplier will account for more than 5% of the Group's purchases for the financial year ending 31 August 2001.

7.4.14 R&D Capabilities

R&D is a combined effort between the Group and its customers. The Group's technical team, comprising production engineers, process engineers, product quality engineers and supplies quality engineers are often sent to customers' office sites to discuss and brain-storm the development of new products and improvement/modification of existing products or production process. With these efforts, the Group has and will continue to increase its production yields, product quality and plant efficiencies for Contract Manufacturing. In view of its size and nature of business operation, it is not cost-benefit for the Group to maintain a separate R&D set-up. As such, the Group does not have a separate team of R&D staffs nor it has separate facilities solely for purpose of R&D activities.

However, since R&D is one of the important area for the Group's Contract Manufacturing division, D'nonce Technology will continue to carry out R&D activities to keep up with changing needs and requirement of its clients.

For the past two (2) years, approximately RM83,000 or 2.2% of Contract Manufacturing's PBT were for the purpose of R&D. Baring unforeseen circumstance, D'nonce Technology is expected to invest at least RM107,000 or 2% of its Contract Manufacturing's PAT for the financial year ended 31 August 2001 in testing equipment, material and operational research as well as human resources to further improve its operational efficiency and productivity. This trend is expected to continue in the future.

7.4.15 Interruption to Operations

The Group did not experience any interruptions in its businesses, which may have had a significant effect on its operations during the past twelve (12) months from the date of this Prospectus.

7.9.7 Service Agreements

D'nonce Technology had entered into separate service agreements, on 22 December 2000 with Goh Hong Lim, Law Kim Choon, Lim Teik Hoe, Chan Seng Sun and Chin Yam Sin. Amongst other benefits, the abovementioned Directors shall be paid monthly salary ranging from RM12,500 to RM20,000 by the Company with an annual increment of at least twelve percent (12%) of their respective last drawn salary.

Business transactions (if any) conducted between D'nonce Technology and other investee companies of Khazanah are on an arm's length basis and on commercial terms.

Save as disclosed below, Hwang-DBS acting as Adviser to D'nonce Technology hereby confirms that there are no existing or potential conflicts of interest in its capacity as the adviser for the Public Issue.

On 4 December 2000, HDM Venture Capital Sdn Bhd ("HDM Venture") extended a loan of RM1,200,000 to Mr Goh Hong Lim, Managing Director and Major Shareholder of D'nonce Technology to partly subscribe for his entitlement of the Rights Issue. HDM Venture is a wholly owned subsidiary of Hwang-DBS (Malaysia) Berhad, which in turn owns 100% equity in Hwang-DBS.
