The Group recorded revenue of RM17.23 million, representing a significant increase of revenue amounted to RM6.90 million or 66.79% from RM10.33 million as recorded in preceding year corresponding quarter. In tandem with the higher achievement of sales revenue, the Group recorded higher profit before tax of RM2.93 million compared to RM1.48 million as recorded in corresponding quarter last year. The significant improvement was mainly due to high orders loading by customers from Malaysia & China operating segments.

For the six months ended 31 December 2010, the group recorded revenue of RM32.85 million, representing significant increase of RM14.02 million or 77.45% from preceding year corresponding period. In tandem with the higher sales revenue recorded, the group posted a pre-tax profit of RM6.33 million as compared to pre-tax profit of RM1.95 million as recorded in preceding year corresponding period. The favourable performance was attributable to improved result reported from Malaysia & China operating segments

# 2. Comparison with preceding quarter's result

For the quarter under review, the Group recorded an increase in revenue by RM1.61 million or 10.32% from the preceding quarter. However, lower profit before tax of RM2.93 million was recorded as compared to profit before tax of RM3.40 million as reported in preceding quarter. The decrease was mainly attributed to loss in forex as result of appreciation of ringgit Malaysia and loss reported on the disposal of non-productive machinery amounted RM0.49 million.

### 3. Commentary on the prospects of the Group

Although the fluctuation in RM/USD exchange rate may affect the results for the remaining quarters, barring any unforeseen circumstances and assuming the current pace of business performance is sustainable, the Group expects a satisfactory level of performance for the coming quarters.
