1. Accounting Policies

Basis of Preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of FRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board and Part A of Appendix 9B of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad Listing Requirements.

In the case of a financial instrument not categorised as fair value through profit or loss, the financial instrument is initially recognised at its fair value plus transaction costs that are directly attributable to acquisition or issue of the financial instrument.

An embedded derivative is recognised separately from the host contract and accounted for as a derivative if, and only if, it is not closely related to the economic characteristics and risks of the host contract and the host contract is not categorised as fair value through profit or loss. In the event that the embedded derivative is recognised separately, the host contract is accounted for in accordance with the policy applicable to the nature of the host contract.

In accordance with FRS 139, the recognition, derecognition, measurement and hedge accounting requirements are applied prospectively from 1 January 2010. The effects of the measurement on 1 January 2010 of the financial assets and financial liabilities brought forward from the previous financial year are adjusted to the opening retained profits as stated in the statement of changes in equity.

2. Change of Financial Year End

On 27 April 2011, the Company announced an immediate change of its financial year end from 31 December to 30 June. The rationale for the change is as follows:-

- i) To better reflect the seasonal business performance of its overseas operations and financial position of the Group; and
- ii) To allow adequate time for significant transitional events (corporate and new business proposals) to be completed so as to better reflect the financial position of the Group.

Due to the change of financial year end, there are no comparative figures given for preceding year corresponding quarter in the current report.

3. Audit Report of Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2009 were not subject to any audit qualifications.

4. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

Turnover of the Group is normally higher during the festive seasons.

5. Exceptional and Extraordinary Item

There were no material exceptional and extraordinary items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flow for the current quarter and financial year-to-date.

6. Changes in Estimates

There was no material change in estimates of amounts reported in prior interim periods of the current financial year or prior financial year.

7. Issuances and Repayment of Debt and Equity Securities

There was no issuance and repayment of debt and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellations, shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares for the current financial year under review.

8. Dividend Paid

No dividend has been paid during the current quarter and financial year-to-date.

On 1 November 2010, the Company disposed of the following investment to Nurizen Holdings Sdn Bhd for a total cash consideration of Ringgit Malaysia One Thousand (RM1,000) only:

- 1,000,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each in Yikon Jewellery Industry Sdn. Bhd. ("YJI") representing 100% equity interest in the issued and paid-up share capital of YJI. Upon the completion of the disposal, YJI ceased to be a subsidiary of the Company; and
- 4,900 ordinary shares of HKD1.00 each in Yikon (H.K.) Limited ("YHK") representing 49% equity interest in the issued and paid-up share capital of YHK. Upon the completion of the disposal, YHK continues to be a 51% owned subsidiary of the Company.

On 1 December 2010, the Company acquired 2 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each in Forest Junction Sdn. Bhd ("FJSB") representing 100% equity interest in the issued and paid-up share capital of FJSB. FJSB remain dormant as at the end of this reporting period.

14. Related Party Transactions

There was no related party transaction in the financial year under review except the following:

- a) rental expenses paid by a subsidiary to the subsidiary's Director for the amount of RM 35,562; and
- b) rental income of RM 23,520 received by a subsidiary from a company in which a substantial shareholder has a substantial interest.

The Directors of the Company are of the opinion that these transactions were entered into in the ordinary course of business and the terms have been established on a negotiated basis.

15. Review of Performance of the Company and its Principal Subsidiaries

The Group recorded a turnover of RM 5.57 million for the current quarter, and accumulated a total turnover of RM 23.48 million for the 15-months period-to-date. The sales revenue from the China operation in the current quarter is 12% higher compared with corresponding quarter for year 2010, however, the average gold price between the two corresponding quarters rose by around 25%.

The Group showed a profit before tax of RM 89 thousand in the current quarter, and accumulated profit before tax of RM 5.96 million for the 15-months period-to-date. During the 15-months period under review, the Group recognised gain arising from divestment of 49% equity interest in a wholly-owned subsidiary in Hong Kong, namely Yikon (H.K.) Limited and disposal of 100% equity interest in a wholly-owned subsidiary in Malaysia, namely Yikon Jewellery Industry Sdn Bhd.

16. Comparison of the Current Quarter Results with the Immediate Preceding Quarter

The Group recorded a turnover of RM 5.57 million in the current quarter, an increase of 17.6% as compared to the immediate preceding quarter of RM 4.73 million. This was due to increased sales revenue by Yikoni Gold (ShenZhen) Pte. Ltd. during the Chinese Spring Festival holiday period. During the reporting period, the average gold price had increased 1% compared with the immediate preceding quarter.

The Group recorded a profit before tax of RM 89 thousand in the current quarter compared to the RM 5.83 million profit before tax in the preceding quarter. For the preceding quarter, the Company disposed 100% equity interest in its wholly-owned subsidiary in Malaysia, namely Yikon Jewellery Industry Sdn Bhd and divested 49% equity interest in its wholly-owned subsidiary in Hong Kong, namely Yikon (H.K.) Limited. The disposal and divestment produced a gain of RM4.8 million.

17. Current Year Prospects

The retail market for gold and jewellery in China offers good growth prospects due to increasing affluence and consumption. Demand for pure-gold items is expected to be constrained by the current high gold prices and margins will remain low due to excessive competition.

17. Current Year Prospects (Continue)

The Group's performance will be dependent on the availability of additional working capital, expansion of retail outlets, brand promotion and sale of jewellery items with better margins. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group expects another satisfactory performance.

18. Profit Forecast

Not applicable as no profit forecast was published.
