#### A. Selected explanatory notes pursuant to FRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting

#### **Accounting Policies A1.**

The interim condensed financial statements are prepared in compliance with FRS 134, "Interim Financial Reporting" and Appendix B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim condensed financial statements have been prepared based on accounting policies and methods of computation which are consistent with those adopted in the preparation of the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2009.

#### B1. Review Of The Performance Of The Company And Its Principal Subsidiaries

The Group's turnover for the period ended 30 September 2010 has increased by 16% to RM164.073 million from RM141.785 million for the corresponding period ended 30 September 2009. The increase in turnover is mainly due to higher selling prices of poultry products.

The Group registered a pretax profit of RM21.699 million as compared to a pretax profit of RM5.580 million in the corresponding period last year. The pretax profit is due to higher selling prices of poultry products in the current quarter.

#### B2. Comparison With The Preceding Quarter's Results

For the quarter ended 30 September 2010, the Group registered a pretax profit of RM21.699 million as compared to a pretax profit of RM11.107 million for the preceding quarter ended 30 June 2010. The Group's higher profit for the period was due to higher prices of poultry products during the quarter.

As for the prospect of the Group for the current year, the Board of Directors remain optimistic that the demand for eggs and broiler products will sustain considering that they are the primary sources of protein of all community.
