NOTES TO THE CONDENSED CONSOLIDATED INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

Part A - Explanatory Notes Pursuant To MFRS 134

1. Basis of Preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements ("Report") have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

This Report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2019. The explanatory notes attached to this Report provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2019.

2. Significant Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2019, except for the adoption of the following Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRSs"), Amendments to MFRSs and IC Interpretations.

On 3 June 2020, the Company had announced that it has issued 60,000,000 new ordinary share pursuant to a Private Placement at an issue price of RM0.0955 per Placement share.

On 10 June 2020, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, AE Multi Industries Sdn. Bhd. had entered into the Heads of Agreement with Palm Pro Engineering Sdn. Bhd. to carry on the milling and processing of oil palm fresh fruit bunches and trading of crude palm oil and palm kernel via establishing and forming a company under the Companies Act 2016.

Comparison with Previous Year Corresponding Quarter

For the current quarter ended 31 March 2020 the Group's revenue has increased from RM14.163 million to RM17.642 million, representing an increase of 24.56 % as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter. This was mainly due to increase in revenue of the new project under AE Resources Development Sdn Bhd ('AERD"), wholly-owned subsidiary of AEM the total revenue for the project is 2.58 million which contribute to 18.21 % increase in the total revenue. The nature of business is related to design and construction of palm oil mill with biogas plant system, polishing plant and composting plant in Sabah.

The Group posted a loss before taxation of RM0.604 million compared to the preceding year's corresponding quarter of RM0.154 million which was mainly due to the corporate exercise expenses of 0.464 million and adjustment of RM0.244 million to the finance cost according to MFRS 16, if not for the adjustment required under MFRS 16 the Group would have posted loss before taxation of RM0.36 million.

During the current quarter under review, the Group reported total revenue of RM17.642 million, which is 2.82% higher than the immediate preceding quarter of RM17.158 million. This was mainly due to increased of revenue from the new project under its wholly owned subsidiary AERD. The revenue of the new project is 2.58 million which is 14.62 percent of the total revenue for financial ended 31 March 2020. However, the sales for the current printed circuit board business has dropped by 12.25 % due to the Covid-19 pandemic

The Group posted a loss before taxation of RM0.604 million as compared to the immediate preceding quarter's profit before taxation of RM0.374 million. This quarter loss before taxation of RM0.604 million was arrived that of after taking the adjustment of RM0.244 million to the finance cost into the consideration according to MFRS 16 and corporate exercise expenses of RM0.464 million.

3. Prospects

The Group expects positive growth from the new business venture and remain stable for the current printed circuit board business which is affected by the Covid-19 pandemic.

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Therefore, the Group is cautiously optimistic that the performance for year 2020 will be positive and challenging.
