## **13.** Review of Performance

The Group achieved total turnover of RM128.4 million for the current quarter ended 31 January 2015, an increase of 10.0% or RM11.7 million from RM116.7 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter. The increase in Group turnover for the current quarter was mainly due to the increase in overseas market demand.

The profit before tax for current quarter under review was 53.2% higher than the preceding year corresponding quarter ended 31 January 2014. These were mainly due to increase in sales and unrealised gain on foreign exchange.

# 14. Variation of results against preceding quarter

The Group's revenue has increased by 6.0% from RM121.1 million preceding quarter to RM128.4 million in this quarter. The increase in revenue is primarily due to increase in both local and oversea market demand.

The Group registered a profit before taxation of RM9.7 million, an increase of RM1.8 million as compared to the preceding quarter ended 31 October 2014, which was recorded at RM7.9 million. The increased on the profit before tax for the current quarter under review was mainly due to increase in unrealised gain on foreign exchange besides reducing in diminution in value of stock.

# 15. Prospects

Overall business environment remains challenging on both domestic and global market. The local steel industries are expected to face a squeeze in profit margin due to the weak domestic demand and steel prices and high raw material costs and volatility of foreign currency.

Thus, to meet the challenging ahead, the Group will continue to explore the possibility of producing new metal building materials products to penetrate into new market for local and overseas other than continue provide better service to customer.
