13. Review of Performance

The Group achieved total turnover of RM98.6 million for the current quarter ended 31 July 2015, a decrease of 21.9% or RM27.6 million from RM126.2 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter. The decrease in Group turnover for the current quarter was mainly due to the decrease in local and overseas market demand.

The profit before tax for current quarter under review was 85.5% lower than the preceding year corresponding quarter ended 31 July 2015. These were mainly due to decrease in revenue and profit margin.

14. Variation of results against preceding quarter

The Group's revenue has decreased by 28.3% from RM138 million preceding quarter to RM99 million in this quarter. The decrease in revenue is primarily due to decrease in both local and oversea market demand.

The Group registered a profit before taxation of RM1.6 million, a decrease of RM5.9 million as compared to the preceding quarter ended 30 April 2015, which was recorded at RM7.5 million. The decreased on the profit before tax for the current quarter under review was mainly due to allowance for diminution in value of inventories and decrease in revenue.

15. Prospects

Overall business environment remains challenging on both domestic and global market. The local steel industries are expected to face a squeeze in profit margin due to the weak domestic demand and steel prices and high raw material costs and volatility of foreign currency.

Thus, to meet the challenging ahead, the Group will continue to explore the possibility of producing new metal building materials products to penetrate into new market for local and overseas other than continue provide better service to customer.
