A1. CORPORATE INFORMATION

PJBumi Berhad is a public limited liability company incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia, and is listed on Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements were approved by the board of directors on 29 August 2016.

A2. BASIS OF PREPARATION

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements, for the period ended 30 June 2016, have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the listing requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. These condensed consolidated interim financial statements also comply with IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the International Accounting Standards Board. They should also be read in conjunction with the financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2015 and the accompanying notes attached to the condensed consolidated interim financial statements.

Within the context of these condensed consolidated interim financial statements, the Group includes the Company and its subsidiaries as at and for the quarter ended 30 June 2016.

The carrying amounts of the current portion of borrowings are reasonable approximation of fair values due to the insignificant impact of discounting. The carrying amount of long term floating rate loans approximates their fair value as the loans will be re-priced to market interest rate on or near reporting date.

When measuring fair value of an asset or a liability, the Group uses observable market data as far as possible. Fair values are categorised into different levels in a fair value hierarchy based on the input used in valuation techniques as follows:

- Level 1 Quoted prices quoted prices (unadjusted) in active markets for identifiable assets or liabilities
- Level 2 inputs other than quoted prices included within Level 1 that are observable for the asset or liability, either directly(i.e. prices) or indirectly (i.e. derived from prices).
- Level 3 inputs for the asset or liability that are not based on observable market data (unobservable input).

For the quarter ended 30 June 2016, the Group has recorded revenue of RM1.962 million, which is approximately RM0.747 million or 61% higher as compared to previous year's corresponding period. The increase in revenue was mainly due to higher revenue generated from the manufacturing and construction sectors.

The Group recorded a pretax loss of RM0.775 million against RM0.924 million recorded in the previous year's corresponding period.

The Group recorded a pretax loss of RM0.775 million in the current quarter against RM0.820 million recorded in the preceding quarter.
