PART A

EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MALAYSIAN FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS 134: INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING ("MFRS 134")

A1. Basis of Preparation

The unaudited condensed interim financial statements for the second quarter ended 30 June 2017 have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 *Interim Financial Reporting* and with IAS 34 *Interim Financial Reporting*, and the applicable disclosure provisions on paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities"), and should be read in conjunction with the annual audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2016.

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements are prepared under historical cost convention, which are in compliance with MFRSs and the requirements of the Companies Act 2016 in Malaysia. These are the Group's second set of condensed interim financial statements prepared in accordance with MFRSs, which are also in line with International Financial Reporting Standards as issued by International Accounting Standards Board.

A2. Changes in Accounting Policies

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group for these unaudited condensed interim financial statements are consistent with those in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2016.

EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF THE BURSA SECURITIES

B1. Review of Group Performance

a) Current Year Quarter compared with Preceding Year Corresponding Quarter

The Group recorded a revenue of RM123.41 million and profit before tax of RM8.74 million for the second quarter as compared to preceding year corresponding quarter of RM115.36 million and profit before tax of RM12.53 million respectively. The revenue increased by RM8.05 million and the profit before tax decreased by RM3.79 million respectively as compared to the second quarter of the preceding year.

For the tin manufacturing segment, revenue increased by RM1.21 million from RM23.57 million to RM24.78 million mainly due to higher sales in the edible oil tin industry and printing services. Profit before tax increased by RM1.41 million to RM4.13 million for the current quarter as compared to RM2.72 million in the preceding year corresponding quarter, mainly due to higher sales and better margin from the printing services in the current quarter.

For the F&B segment, revenue increased by RM6.85 million from RM91.78 million to RM98.63 million mainly due to higher sales from both milk powder and dairy products segments. The profit before tax decreased by RM5.22 million from RM10.32 million to RM5.1 million for the current quarter under review mainly due to allowance for doubtful debts in the current quarter. Also, there was a higher foreign exchange gain on trade settlement that contributed to higher profit in the preceding year corresponding quarter.

b) Current Year-To-Date compared with Preceding Year-To-Date

The Group has recorded a revenue of RM225.98 million and profit before tax of RM22.2 million for the 6 months' ended 30 June 2017 as compared to preceding year-to-date of RM206.94 million and RM18.47 million respectively. The Group's revenue increased by RM19.04 million and the profit before tax increased by RM3.73 million respectively as compared to preceding year-to-date.

For the tin manufacturing segment, revenue increased by RM3.25 million from RM45.51 million to RM48.76 million mainly due to higher sales in the edible oil tin industry and printing services. Profit before tax increased by RM3.87 million from RM6.45 million to RM10.32 million mainly due to one-time gain on disposal of machinery in the current year under review.

For the F&B segment, revenue increased by RM15.79 million from RM161.43 million to RM177.22 million mainly due to higher sales from milk powder segment. The profit before tax decreased slightly by RM30 thousand from RM12.93 million to RM12.9 million mainly due to allowance for doubtful debts in the current year under review.

B2. Variation of Results against Preceding Quarter

For the current quarter under review, the Group's profits before tax decreased by RM4.72 million to RM8.74 million as compared to profit before tax of RM13.46 million in the preceding quarter ended 31 March 2017.

a) Tin Manufacturing Industry

Profit before tax decreased by RM2.14 million from RM6.27 million in the previous quarter as compared to the current quarter's profit before tax of RM4.13 million. The profit in previous quarter is higher mainly due to one-time gain on disposal of machinery as compared to current quarter under review.

b) F&B Industry

Profit before tax decreased by RM2.7 million from RM7.8 million in the previous quarter as compared to the current quarter's profit before tax of RM5.1 million mainly due to allowance for doubtful debts in the current quarter.

B3. Prospects of the Group

a) Tin Manufacturing Industry

Tin manufacturing industry will remain challenging due to an increasingly competitive market. Raw material price is seen to be on the upward trend in the near future and this will put additional pressure in the industry. This segment will continue to be profitable.

b) F&B Industry

Demand is expected to remain strong although we foresee a very competitive market. This segment will continue to be profitable despite volatility in raw materials prices and uncertainties in global economies.

Able Dairies Sdn Bhd formed a new subsidiary, namely Able Dairies Marketing Sdn Bhd, with a controlling interest of 51% of the total paid-up share capital. This new subsidiary will mainly be focusing on domestic market's distributions of our own product brands. We are expecting the operations will start by 3rd quarter of this year.

This is not applicable to the Group for the current financial reporting period under review.
