PART B: ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

B1. ANALYSIS OF PERFORMANCE

The Group's revenue of RM19.6 million for the third quarter of 2013 was RM2.2 million lower than the RM21.8 million reported in the corresponding quarter of the previous year. Revenue for the financial year-to-date under review was RM57.9 million, RM7.6 million lower than the RM65.5 million recorded in the same period of the preceding year.

The revenue of RM14.1 million from the webbings, yarn and furniture components segment for the current quarter was RM2.5 million lower than the RM16.6 million recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2012. The segment's revenue for the financial year-to-date of RM42.8 million was also RM7.2 million lower than the RM50.0 million recorded in the same period of last year as the economies in the Group's key export markets, the US and Europe, continue to be slow and customers worldwide remain cautious in their purchasing policies.

The rubber strips and fabrics segment recorded revenue of RM5.4 million during the quarter under review, an increase of RM0.2 million compared to the RM5.2 million recorded in the corresponding quarter of the previous year as a result of encouraging rubber fabrics sales. The segment's revenue for the financial year-to-date of RM15.0 million was however RM0.4 million lower than the RM15.4 million recorded in the corresponding period of last year. Although revenue generated from rubber fabrics increased, the higher decline of revenue from rubber strips resulted in the overall segment reduction.

Despite the lower revenue, the Group's profit before tax of RM1.9 million for the third quarter of 2013 was RM0.7 million higher than the RM1.2 million recorded in corresponding quarter of the previous year. Profit before taxation for the current financial year-to-date of RM4.7 million was also RM1.2 million higher than the RM3.5 million reported for the corresponding period of 2012. This is mainly due to the improved performance of the rubber strips and fabrics segment as well as the stronger US Dollar against the Ringgit which resulted in net foreign exchange gains.

Profit before tax recorded by the webbings, yarn and furniture components segment during the quarter under review was RM1.5 million, RM0.1 million lower than the RM1.6 million reported for the corresponding quarter of last year. The segment's profit before taxation of RM4.3 million for the financial year-to-date was also RM0.4 million lower than the RM4.7 million recorded for the same period of last year. Apart from registering lower revenue, the soft global economy has also prompted competitors to reduce prices in order to sustain market shares. This has resulted in the Group having to reduce margins

to remain competitive and maintain its market position. The impact is slightly lessened by the favourable US Dollar-Ringgit exchange rates which resulted in higher net foreign exchange gains.

The rubber strips and fabrics segment reported a profit before tax of RM0.3 million for the quarter under review compared to a loss of RM0.2 million recorded in the corresponding quarter of the previous year. The segment also recorded a profit before tax of RM0.2 million for the financial year-to-date against the loss of RM0.9 million recorded during the same period of the previous financial year. The relatively stable rubber prices and the encouraging rubber fabrics sales contributed to the improved performance in the segment.

B2. VARIATION OF RESULTS AGAINST PRECEDING QUARTER

The Group's revenue of RM19.6 million for the current quarter was a marginal RM0.5 million higher than the RM19.1 million reported for the second quarter of 2013 as the global economy remain slow.

The Group's profit before tax for the current quarter of RM1.9 million was however RM0.2 million lower than the RM2.1 million recorded in the previous quarter mainly due to the difference in products mix and lower net foreign exchange gains.

B3. PROSPECTS

The sustained slowdown in the economies of the Group's major export markets in the US and Europe will continue to affect the Group's performance for 2013. While the recovery to the US economy is forecasted to gather pace from the middle of next year, the Eurozone is still expected to remain sluggish with only modest growth being predicted for 2014.

The Group will strive to protect its market position by staying focused behind our core business strategies and at the same time actively seek opportunities for growth. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group's performance for 2013 is expected to be satisfactory.

We should also be mindful that any significant movement in the exchange rate between the Ringgit and the US Dollar will result in foreign exchange gains or losses which will affect the Group's results as the Group derives a substantial amount of its revenue in US Dollars.
